Upcoming Radiological Emergency Preparedness Rehearsal and Federally Evaluated Exercises

(Middletown CT) — A federally evaluated Millstone Station Radiological Exercise is scheduled for **Tuesday November 1, 2022**, with a full rehearsal on **Tuesday September 27, 2022**. These exercises are coordinated by the Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEMHS) Radiological Emergency Preparedness Unit in collaboration with the Department of Energy and Environmental (DEEP) Radiation Division, Dominion Energy, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and municipalities within the 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) around Millstone. The towns within the EPZ include Waterford, East Lyme, Lyme, Old Lyme, Groton Town, Groton City, Montville, Ledyard, and New London.

The exercises are designed to establish a learning environment for participants to exercise their plans and procedures for responding to a radiological emergency at Millstone Station in Waterford, Connecticut. The intent of this exercise is to focus on communication and coordination of the power plant with local offsite first responders. **We do not anticipate the activation of sirens or the movement of equipment during this exercise.**
