**Current Open Grant Years:** FY 2019, FY 2020, FY 2021

**Eligible Recipients:** The Five DEMHS Regions – Managed by the Regional Fiduciaries and various State Agencies

**Purpose:** Support Planning, Training, Equipment, and Exercise activities with a Terrorism (including Cyber Terrorism) Nexus

**Range of Eligible Projects:** Personal Protective Equipment, Incident Management Training Special Team Training, Bomb Squad training and equipment, Hazardous Materials Team training and equipment, Shelter supplies, Variable message signs, light towers, Cyber Security training, Citizen Corps Program Funding, and more

**Grant Best Practices/FAQ:** Guidance obtained from the Homeland Security Working Group

**Source:** Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency

**Funds available:** appx \$4,000,000.00 each year for Statewide projects

**Annual Cycle/ Deadlines:** Spring each year Homeland Security Working Group Meets determines priorities – Regions begin working on applications in May/June for September submission – Funds available or about October 1<sup>st</sup>
