**Subject:** DMHAS COVID-19 Staff Update #10

Yesterday, the President announced that he would be extending the federal social distancing guidelines through April 30. Public health experts also anticipate seeing a peak in COVID-19 activity over the next two weeks. DMHAS has taken significant steps to prepare for a rise in COVID-19 cases:

- Identified spaces in all state-operated facilities to be used for the isolation of patients suspected of or who been confirmed to have COVID-19;
- Distributed personal protective equipment (PPE) including n95 masks, surgical masks, gowns, gloves and hand sanitizer to all state-operated facilities; and,
- Developed quarantine and isolation protocols for patients and staff that have been reviewed and approved by the Department of Public Health.

As the country braces for an anticipated surge of cases, many of us may feel a rise in our own anxiety and stress levels. Now, perhaps more than ever before, it's important that we all pay attention to our own mental health and practice self-care.
