## Asian American Pacific Islander (AAPI) Ambassador Initiative

The AAPI Ambassador Initiative began in 2016 and is a collaboration between the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, Problem Gambling Services, and Amplify, the Region 4 Behavioral Health Action Organization. Previous partners included the former Commission on Equity and Opportunity and the Connecticut Council on Problem Gambling.

*This initiative supports the Asian American and Pacific Islander populations with unique challenges and risk factors related to problem gambling.* 

> (1) The identification and training of representatives of the AAPI communities in Connecticut (AAPI "Ambassadors") in gambling awareness and an evidence-based community conversation model

(2) Technical assistance and support of the Ambassadors as they develop, plan, and deliver a series of "community conversations" engaging their community members

(3) Evaluation of the community conversations and initiative. *Long term goals* of the AAPI Ambassador Initiative include (1) development of an action plan for the replication of the AAPI in other regions of Connecticut; and (2) replication of this Ambassador model with other underserved populations in Connecticut
