

The Cost of Smoking in Connecticut

The price of cigarettes in the state of Connecticut is the eighth highest in the US. Currently, smokers in CT pay approximately \$9.30 per pack of cigarettes. Based upon that average, this table identifies how much a person spends on cigarettes if they smoke the following amount per day (CPD = Cigarettes Per Day)
