

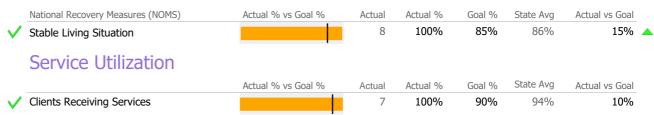

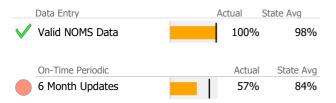






Data Submission Quality
