NOTICE AND ORDER

SUBJECT OF ORDER (ITEMS AFFECTED):

The following items with due dates or expiration dates between **AUGUST 1 AND SEPTEMBER 30, 2020:**

- Operator's licenses, permits and identity cards
- Disability placards
- Motor vehicle and boat registrations
- Emissions tests or retests
- Business licenses
- Flashing light permits
- School bus proficiency tests

ACTION BEING TAKEN:

Extension for **NINETY (90) DAYS** from due date or date of expiration

REASON FOR ACTION:


The undersigned is ordering these extensions because offices of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) closed on March 18, 2020, and subsequently reopened on a limited basis by appointment only. The DMV is required to limit the number of customers in order to maintain social distancing during in-person DMV transactions. Extensions are necessary in order to serve all customers who could not access a DMV office and are unable to obtain a timely appointment.

ORDER:

Under the authority of section 14-5c of the Connecticut General Statutes and with the approval of the Governor of the State of Connecticut, Ned Lamont, the undersigned orders a **NINETY (90) DAY** extension for all items listed above that have due dates or expiration dates from **AUGUST 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2020**. Each affected customer will have ninety (90) days after his or her expiration or due date to renew without penalty. All late fees that normally would be associated with a late renewal will be waived during the time period of the extension for qualifying items.

Law enforcement personnel will be notified of this order.
