

## Disabled Veteran (DV) Plates (class code 01 only)

Disabled Veteran Plates are available to veterans who have a service-connected disability certified by the Veterans Administration (450 Main St Hartford). Plates are available in passenger class code 01 only. These plates have the designation of "DV" and a number (ie: DV123).

There is no additional fee for this plate, and the registrant must pay all applicable fees such as registration, tax and title. There are no special privileges with this plate other than the recognition that disabled veterans are deserving of.

To apply for the Disabled Veteran Plates:

- The veteran must submit a letter from the Veteran Administration certifying the service-connected disability. A letter from the Disabled Veterans Association would also be acceptable. The letter will be specific for this purpose and will say that the veteran is entitled to a disabled veteran plate.
- Initial requests for DV plates are available in the Wethersfield office only, however, transfers and renewals may be processed in any DMV office.

A disabled veteran may apply for a special request disabled veteran plate by submitting an M22 form (Special Order Plate Application) and pay the applicable fee. Plates in this category will be printed as DAV###. (not DV)

Note: These plates should not be confused with the special No Fee class code 14 Veterans plates, which have the VET designation.
