- 1. Welcome: Commissioner Hurlburt called the meeting to order at 10:05 AM.
- 2. **Approval of New England Dairy Q1 payment**: Jaime Foster made a motion to approve. Seth Bahler seconded. All in favor, motion passed.
- 3. **Dairy Day at Hartford Yard Goats**: Rebecca Eddy provided update regarding June 7 event due to COVID-19. Will keep board informed of updates
- 4. **Public Comment**: Discussion ensued regarding dumping of milk. Paul Miller asked about available funds to promote dairy consumption. Discussion on the CT Grown Map and highlighting SNAP/EBT locations. Amanda Freund discussed ways to promote dairy and move product. Discussion ensued on advocating for grocery stores to not impose limits on purchase of dairy for SNAP/EBT participants. Request for letter from Commissioner Hurlburt to CT grocery association re: dairy. Further discussion on how to facilitate movement of milk to those in need. Paul Miller motioned to contribute a total of \$40,000 to Connecticut Food Bank and Foodshare (\$5,000 per county) for the purchase of dairy with the request to match to DFA and Agri-Mark. Seth Bahler seconded. Jaime Foster abstained. Motion adopted.
