ABOUT US

Since 2008, the <u>CT Children with Incarcerated Parents Initiative (CTCIP)</u>, located at CCSU's Institute for Municipal and Regional Policy, which identifies and provides funding for programs and services specifically for children with incarcerated parents. We have recently expanded our work to improve the quality of supports for CIP through research in order to recommend better-informed public policy and practice through various data and knowledge we gain. We also serve as Connecticut's primary resource center and think-tank for information on and for CIP.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Our Scholarship aims to assist full-time Central CT State University (CCSU) students who have been impacted by parental or familial incarceration. The number of awards given will be based on available funds. The scholarship offers a \$1,500.00 award for each semester (up to 6 semesters in total) as long as full-time status and a GPA of 2.6 or higher is maintained. Students may apply for the scholarship by completing the Scholarship Application form and submitting all requested documents. Applications will be reviewed in November/December 2019 by the CIP Scholarship Review Committee. The awards will be disbursed January 2020.
