

NOTICE TO OSBORN CI INMATE POPULATION

TESTING FOR COVID-19 VIRUS STARTING 05/13/2020

Department wide testing for the COVID-19 virus of all offenders will start on Wednesday, May 13, 2020 at the Osborn Correctional Institution.

Testing of all offenders, and staff, is critical to keeping you healthy while preventing the further spread of the coronavirus.

If you test positive for the virus, you will be monitored for a minimum of 14 days, while you receive medical attention. During that time, you must be fever and symptom free for a 72-hour period before being medically cleared to leave isolation. Those who test positive will likely remain at the Osborn facility throughout the monitoring period.

For your own wellbeing, it is strongly recommended that you take the test. Anyone refusing to be tested will have to sign an opt out form.

Details regarding the time and location of the testing will be provided by correctional staff.

Of the approximately 525 offenders who have tested positive, more than 415 have already recovered from the virus.

Testing will take place at each Department of Correction facility once the testing at Osborn CI has been completed.
