Dear Sir or Madam,

As a registered victim with the Connecticut Department of Correction Victim Services Unit, we are hereby notifying you of a Supreme Court decision that took effect on June 5, 2019. This decision will impact the end of sentence date, community release review date and may impact the parole eligibility date for the offender which you are receiving notifications for.

Attached is the memo which was distributed to those inmates affected by the ruling. Grant v. Commissioner of Correction No. CV164007926S. This memo states any inmate who's offense date was on or after July 1, 2011 but prior to October 1, 2015 will be granted RREC (Risk Reduction Earned Credit) days in the form of a lump sum for the time they were not eligible to earn. Moving forward they will be eligible to earn addional days of RREC time which will further impact the above dates.
