## **Attention Visitors:**

Please be advised this <u>dress code and restrictions applies to ALL Visitors, Including</u>
<a href="Mailto:Children">Children</a>. It is important to ensure appropriate dress and rules while visiting. The following items are <u>not allowed in the Visiting Room</u> unless specified otherwise:

- Hats or Headwear of any kinds (Except for Religious Head Dress, which must pass through metal detector inspections)
- Bobby pins
- Sunglasses
- Jackets (Except for Suit Jackets)
- Sweatshirts with Pockets inside or outside or Hoods of any type of material
- Halters, Tube Tops, or Shirts with Spaghetti Straps
- Half Shirts/blouses or low cut shirts in the front revealing breast
- Any article of clothing that may be considered revealing (sheer/see through) or offensive
- Cut off Tee Shirts and/or Tee Shirts with offensive suggested phrases or images
- Shawls, Scarves or Blankets
- Pajamas Tops or Bottoms
- Mini-Skirts
- Shorts (no higher than 2 inches above the knees)
- Inappropriate Leggings, Jeggings, Spandex or Tight Pants
- Jeans or other clothing with rips or holes exposing skin
- Clothing that exposes undergarments
- Wallets, Purses or Bags, to include currency
- No Smart watches or electronic/wireless communication devices
- Food (including gum and candy) or Drinks of any kinds
- NO Cell Phones
- Profanity in any language shall result in the visitor(s) removal from the facility
