Updated Guidelines for Social Visits are as follows:

- Visiting cut-off is a half hour prior to the visiting session.*Visitors must arrive prior to the cut-off to be allowed to visit.
- Visits are 45 min.
- Each inmate is allowed:
 - two (2) in-person visits and
 - one (1) video visit per week
- Contact Visits - 3 Approved Visitors are allowed at a time (children count as a visitor)
- Loss of visits and non-contact policies remain the same
- Visiting schedule runs Monday thru Sunday
- Visitors are allowed to visit both weekend days if no other in-person visits have happened that week
- An inmate may **not** receive the same visitor more than once in the same day
- **Identification.** All visitors age 18 or above will be required to provide appropriate photo identification prior to admission to the visit.
 - i. Children age 18 or above shall be required to present a photo identification prior to each visit. Adults supervising children under the age of 18 shall be required to present a birth certificate and one other document with the child's name on it (e.g., social security card, report card, etc.) prior to each visit.
 - 1. If the child (ren) under the age of 18 is being brought to a correctional facility to visit an inmate by an adult who is not their parent or legal guardian, then the adult who is visiting shall have and present to correctional staff a notarized letter from the child's parent or legal guardian granting permission for the child (ren) to be allowed to be brought in for a visit. ***Note, this does not apply to DCF Visits.** DCF Visits require documentation from the court and proper staff identification to enter the facility.
