The Federal Highway Administration Connecticut Division (FHWA-CT) has been informed by the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) of your interest in becoming a consulting party for the purposes of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act for State Project Number 158-214, potentially impacting the William F. Cribari Memorial Bridge in Westport, Connecticut.
