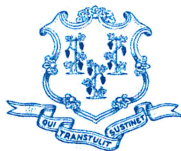

The Department of Public Health (DPH) Drinking Water Section (DWS) Source Assessment and Protection Unit has reviewed the above referenced Notice of Scoping. The proposed concept work area falls within the Level A Aquifer Protection Area of the Fairfield Hills Wellfield, a source of public drinking water for the customers of the Newtown Water Department (PWSID# CT0970021) and the source water area of the public drinking water supply for Curtis Packaging (PWSID# CT0970372). The DPH offers the following recommendations to protect the purity and adequacy of the source of public drinking water for this manufacturing facility:

- The Owner and/or Environmental Manager of Curtis Packaging should be consulted to verify the location of the source of public water supply.
- The Department of Transportation must ensure that no sources of contamination pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies section 19-13-B51d are introduced into the sanitary radius of the public drinking water source of supply.
- Construction should adhere to the document: [General Construction Best Management Practices for Sites within a Public Drinking Water Supply Area](#)
