On April 19, 2016 the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) published a Notice of Scoping in the *Environmental Monitor* to solicit comments for the subject project. The scoping period concluded on May 20, 2016. During this time, CTDOT received comments from the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CTDEEP), and from the Connecticut Office of Policy and Management (OPM). No comments were received from the general public during the scoping period, and a public scoping meeting was not held for this project.

Based on the comments received, and the analysis documented in the attached Environmental Checklist, CTDOT does not recommend the preparation of an Environmental Impact Evaluation under the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act. Comments and recommendations received were reviewed in conjunction with the preparation of the Environmental Checklist and addressed within the checklist, as appropriate.
