PROPOSED SERVICE CHANGES

Effective on or after July 1, 2022

Bradley-Union Connector

Weekdays, Saturdays & Sundays

The Bradley-Union Connector is a new limited-stop local bus route that will connect Hartford Union Station and Bradley Int'l Airport. Bradley-Union Connector buses will be timed to meet all CT*rail* & Amtrak trains to/from New Haven & points south 7 days a week. Buses will wait as long as necessary for delayed trains and will depart 9 minutes after the train arrives at the station.

Bradley-Union Connector buses will operate express between Hartford Union Station and Bradley Int'l Airport and will make no intermediate stops. Local fares will be in effect (\$1.75 one-way, 85¢ for seniors and the disabled).

24 – Windsor/Bradley Int'l Airport/Windsor Locks

Weekdays

Route 24 is a crosstown route that operates between Windsor RR Station, Bradley Int'l Airport and Windsor Locks RR Station on weekdays only. Route 24 also serves the Poquonock and Windsor Locks Park & Rides where connections are available with CT*transit* local, limited-stop and express services serving many surrounding communities including Hartford, East Windsor and Enfield.

Service on Route 24 will be increased to 37 trips each weekday. As a result, a bus connection to and from the airport will now be provided at Windsor Locks RR Station with all CT*rail* & Amtrak trains to/from Springfield & points north on weekdays.

282 – East Grand Avenue

Weekdays, Saturdays & Sundays

Route 282 (formerly the Grand Avenue Bus Bridge) will become a permanent route.

Buses will operate from Walmart on Route 80 via Quinnipiac Ave. to East Grand Ave., Russell St., Clifton St., Eastern St. and Bella Vista then back to Walmart via Eastern St. and Foxon Rd. Connections will be available with Routes 212 & 223 at Walmart and with Routes 213 & 215 on Foxon Blvd. for customers traveling to downtown New Haven and surrounding communities.

As a result of this change, buses on the 212 – Grand Avenue route will be permanently rerouted via Clinton Ave. and Middletown Ave, providing Route 212 customers traveling to Walmart, Foxon Rd. and Universal Dr. with faster travel times and improved service reliability.

512 – South Main Street

Weekdays

In order to provide customers with faster travel times during peak hours, Route 512 will adopt a new weekday schedule.

During the AM & PM peak periods, buses will travel either to Berlin Tpke. (512B) or Cromwell Walmart (512C). In addition, some trips on Route 512B will be extended to CTDOT. The AM & PM peak schedule for Route 512 also will be modified to provide improved connections at Berlin RR Station with Hartford Line service for customers traveling between New Haven & New Britain on weekdays.

Midday, night & weekend service will continue to operate under the same schedule, with buses serving both Cromwell Walmart and Berlin Tpke.

940 – Waterbury/Meriden Express

Weekdays

Route 940 is a new bus route that connects Waterbury and Meriden. The schedule for Route 940 is timed to meet Waterbury Branch trains from Bridgeport at Waterbury RR Station and Hartford Line trains from New Haven at Meriden RR Station. Route 940 is operated with over-the-road style coach buses and charges a two-zone express fare (\$3.20 one-way, \$1.60 for seniors and the disabled).

Connections are also available in downtown Waterbury and at the Meriden Transit Center with CT*transit* and MAT local and express bus service to Hartford, New Haven and Middletown.
