NOTIFICATION OF TERMINATION OF COMMISSIONER'S ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OUT OF STATE LICENSEES INCLUDING TELEHEALTH PROVIDERS

In accord with Special Act 22-1, the Commissioner of Public Health's authority under Conn. Gen. Stat. [§ 19a-131j\(a\)](#) to temporarily suspend for a period not to exceed sixty consecutive days, the requirements for licensure, certification or registration ends on April 15, 2022. The Commissioner's [order](#) of February 15, 2022, suspending the requirements for licensure, certification or registration for the following practitioners who are appropriately licensed, certified or registered in another state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia terminates on April 15, 2022:

- physicians
- physician assistants
- registered and licensed practical nurses, advance practice registered nurses, nurse midwives, nurse anesthetists,
- respiratory care practitioners
- psychologists
- marital and family therapists
- clinical social workers and master social workers
- professional counselors

Practitioners of said professions including those who provide telehealth services must be licensed to practice in Connecticut on and after April 15, 2022.



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
