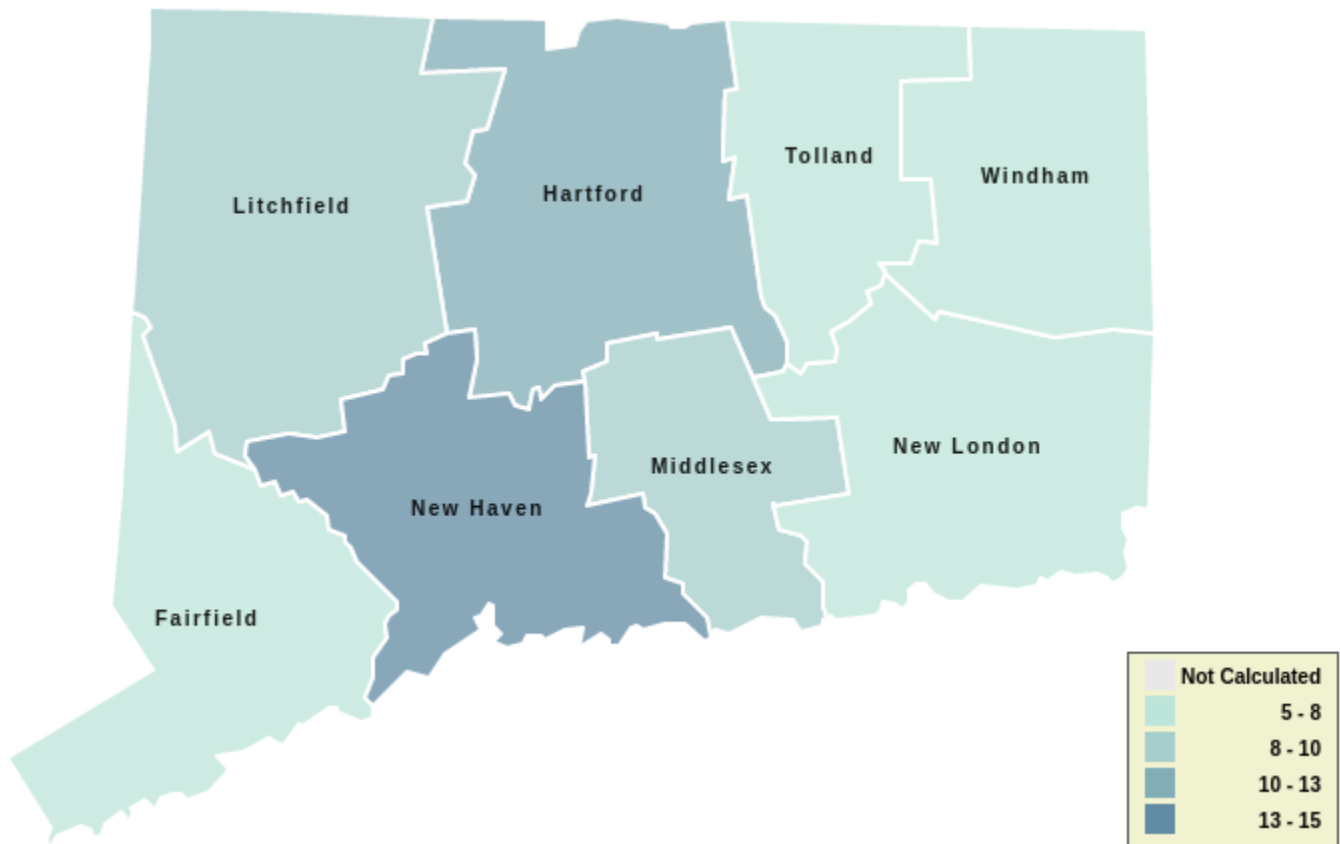

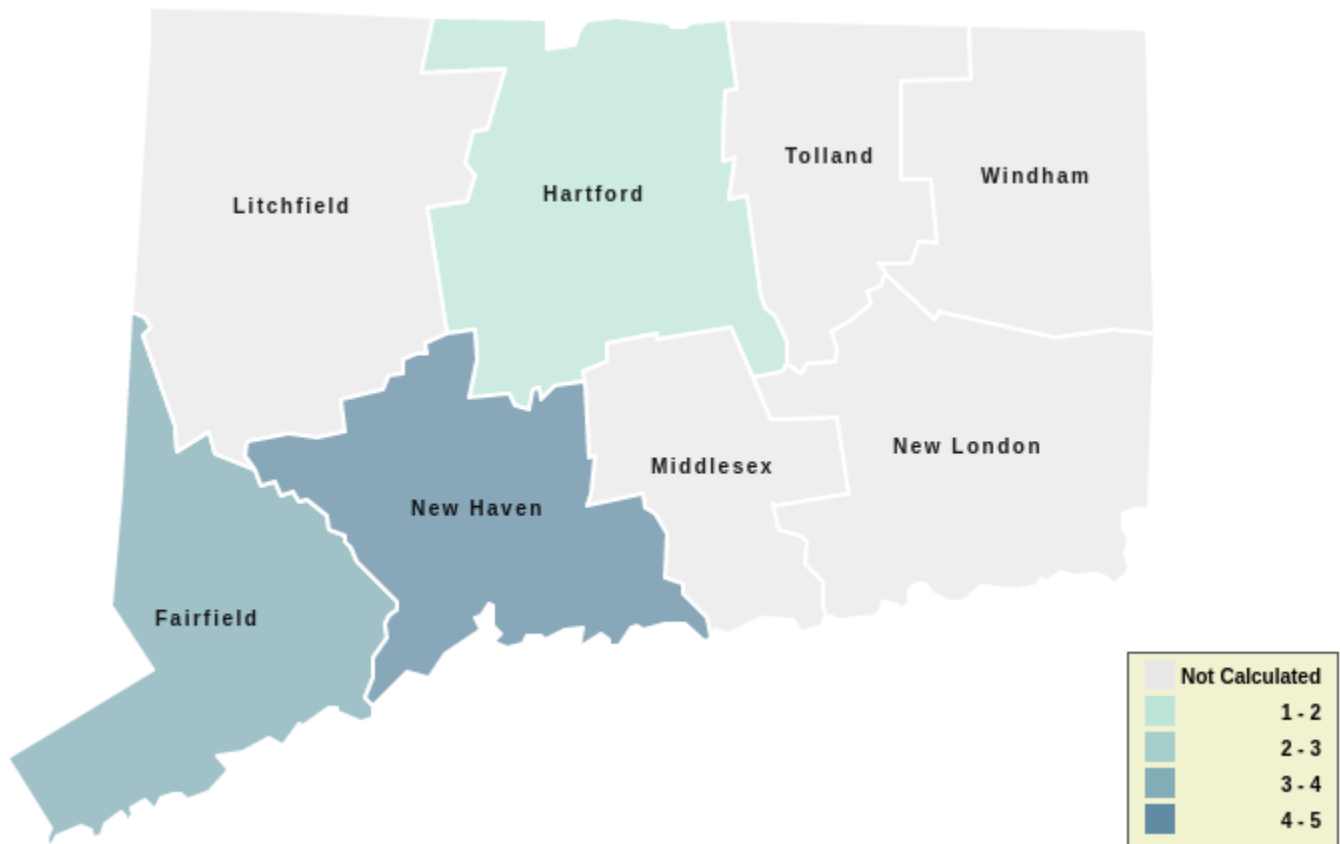

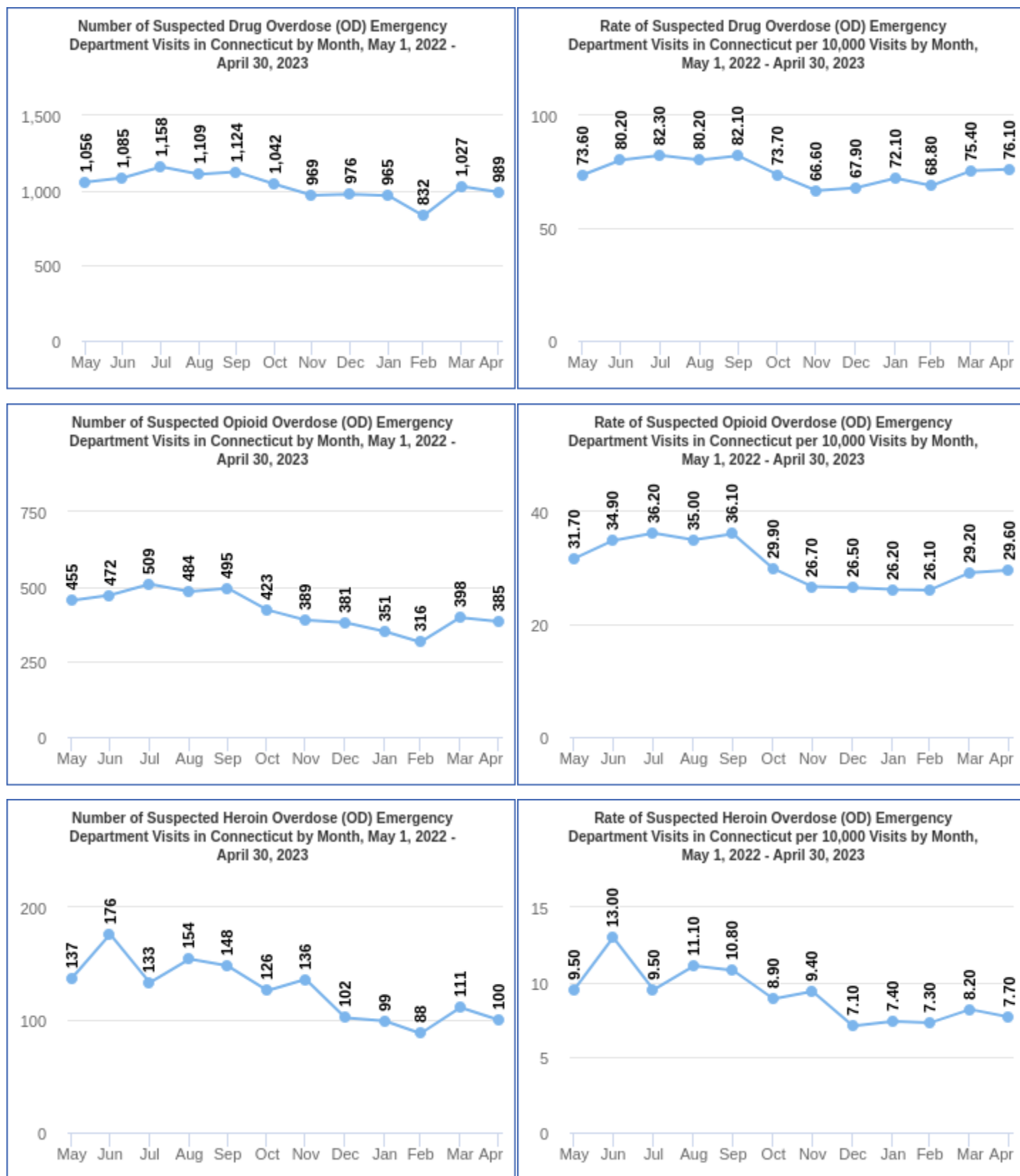

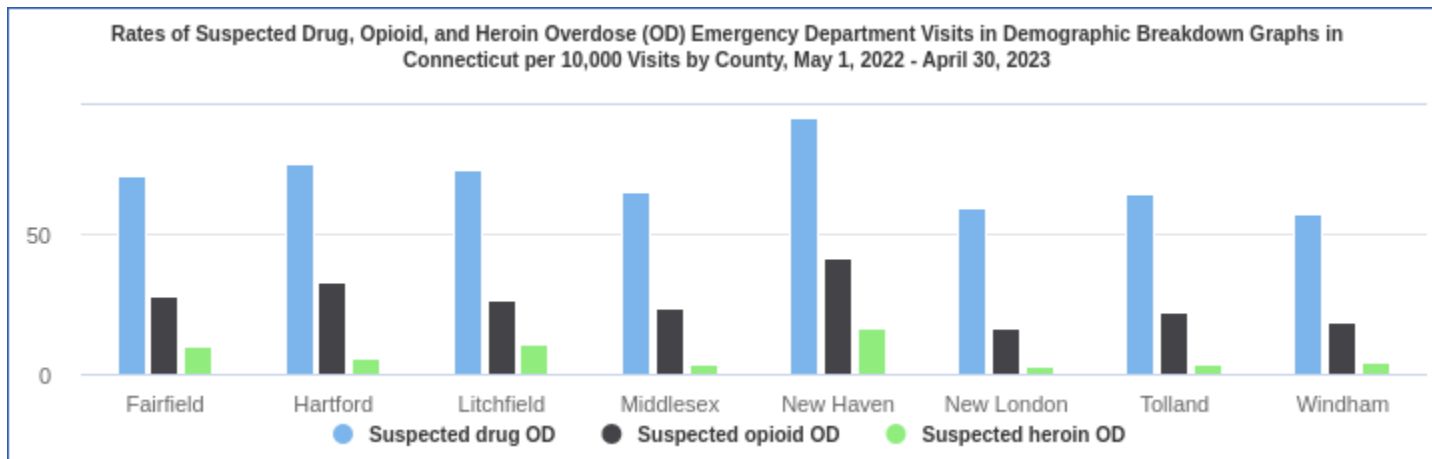

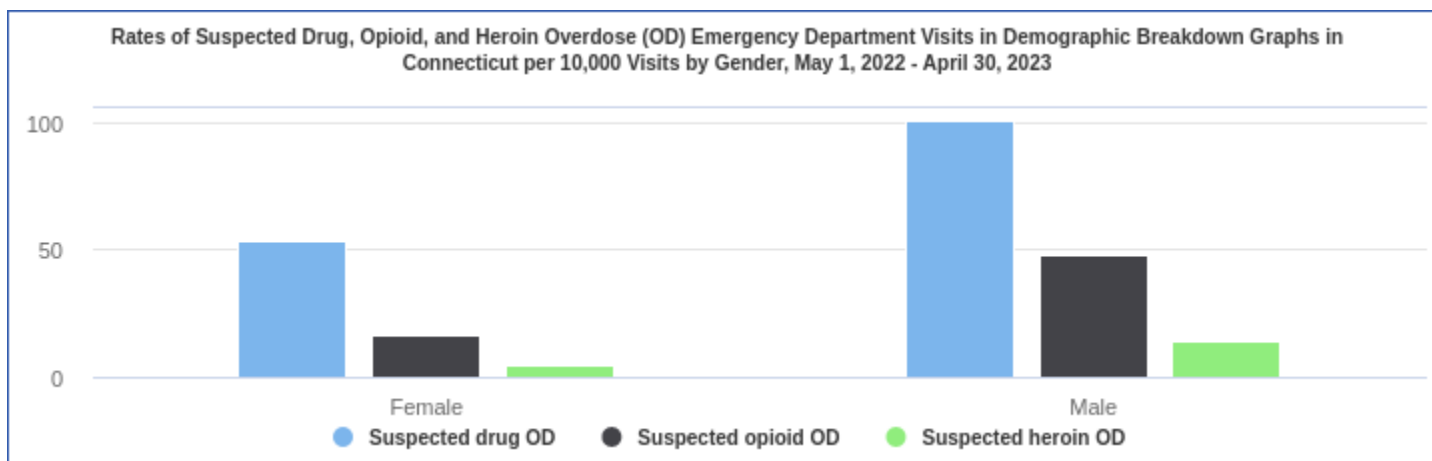

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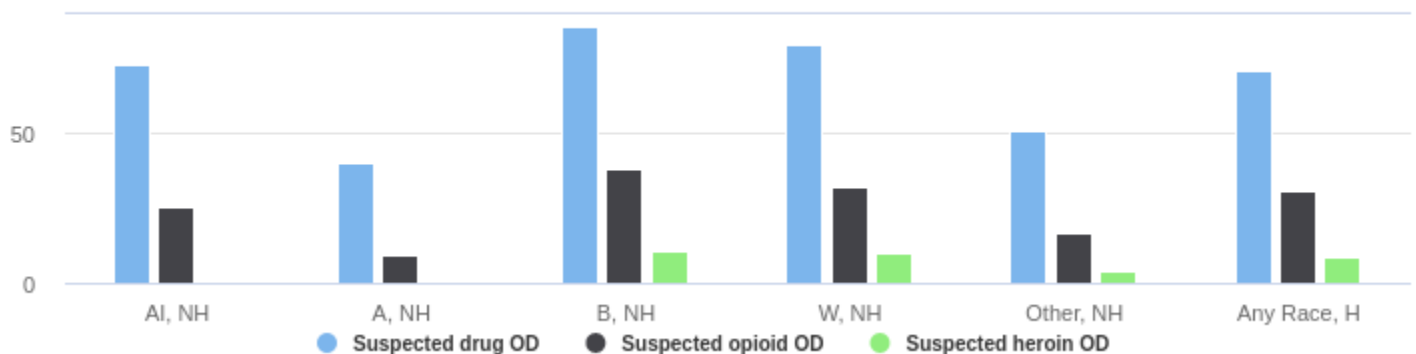

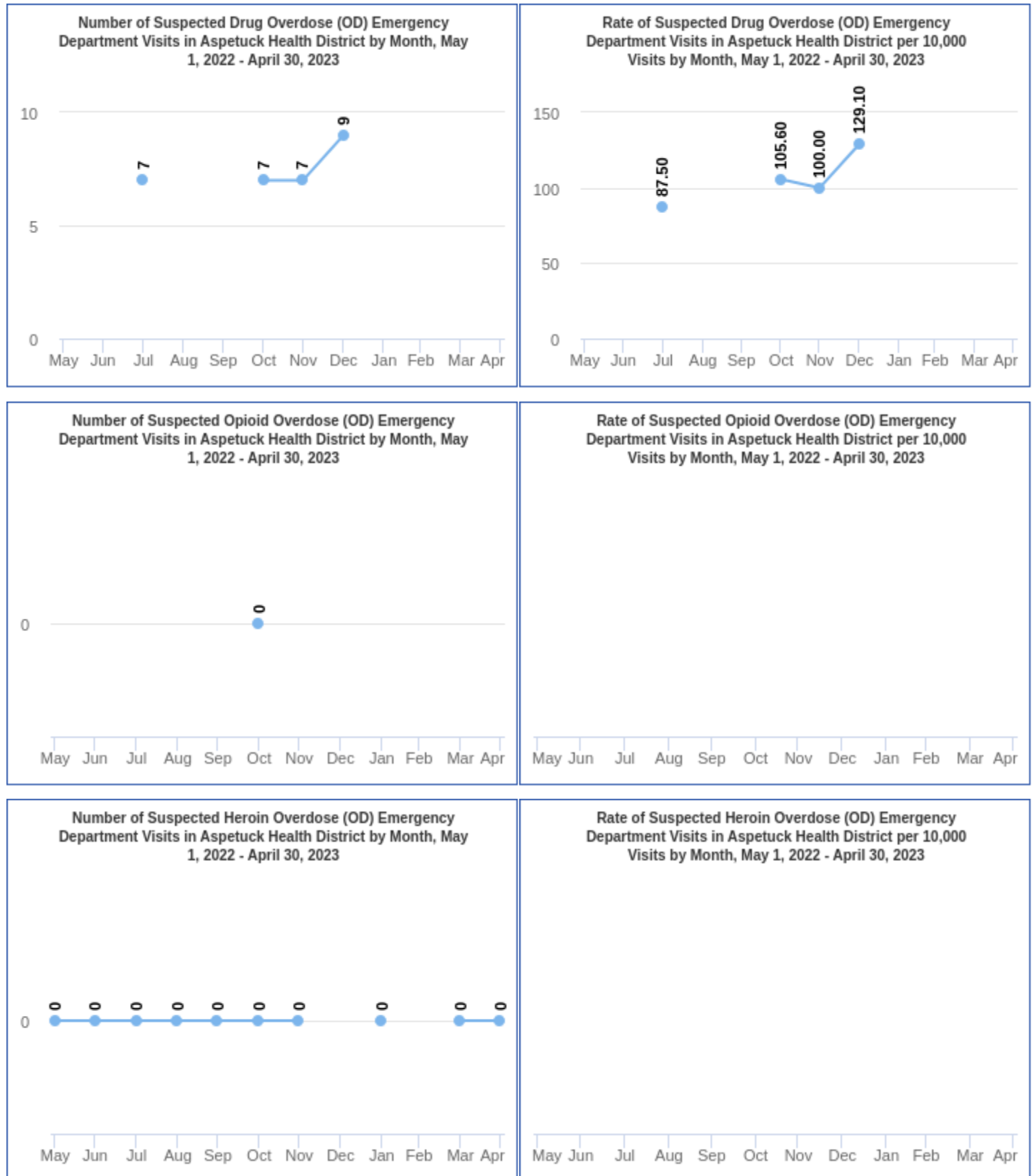

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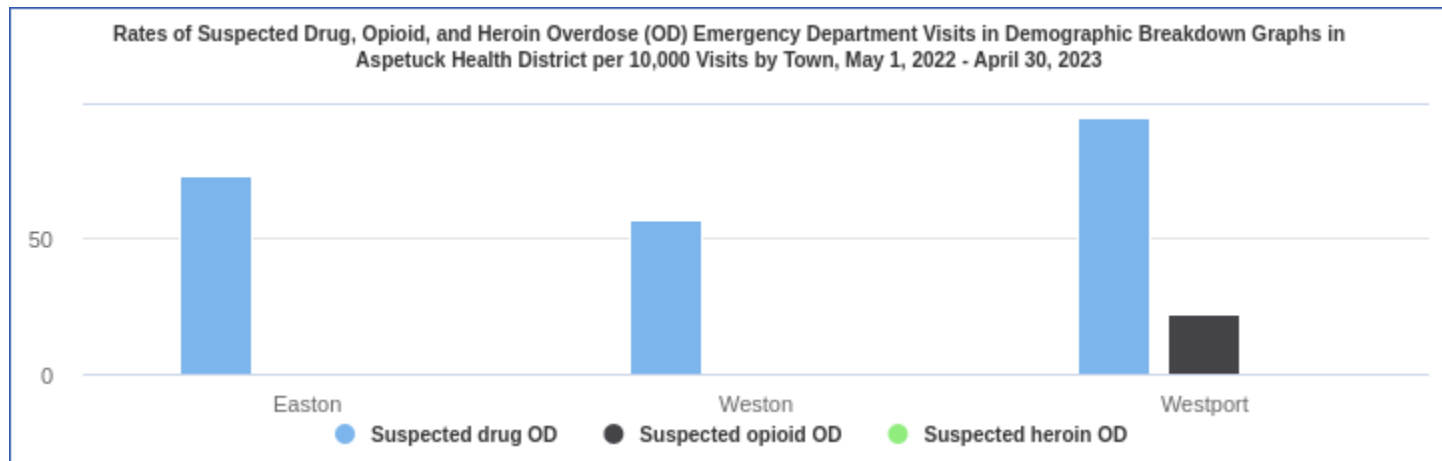

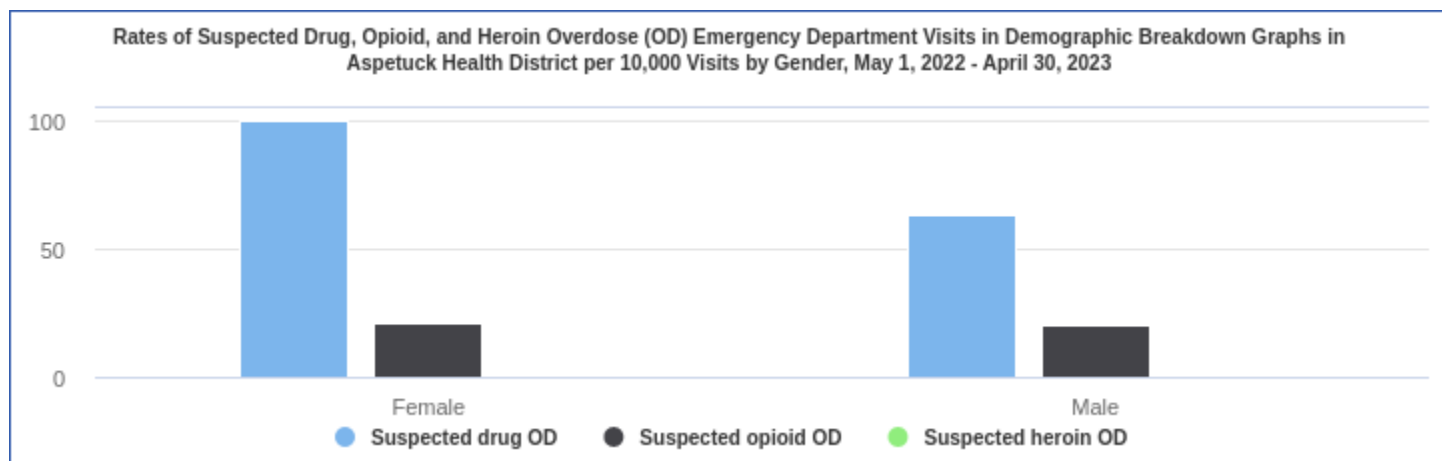

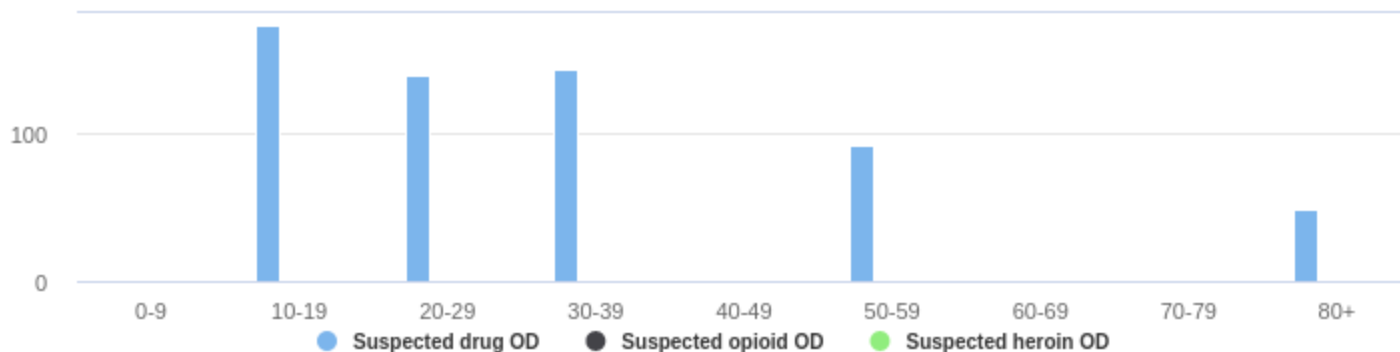

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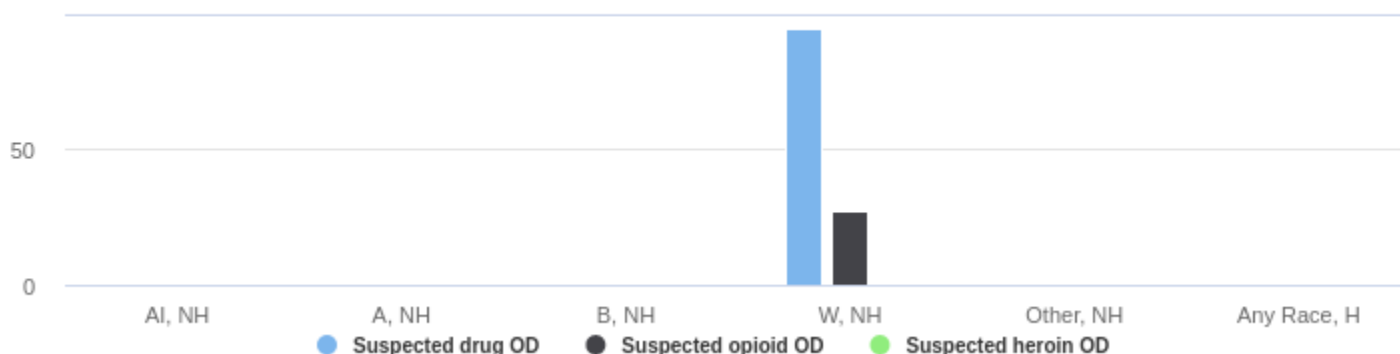

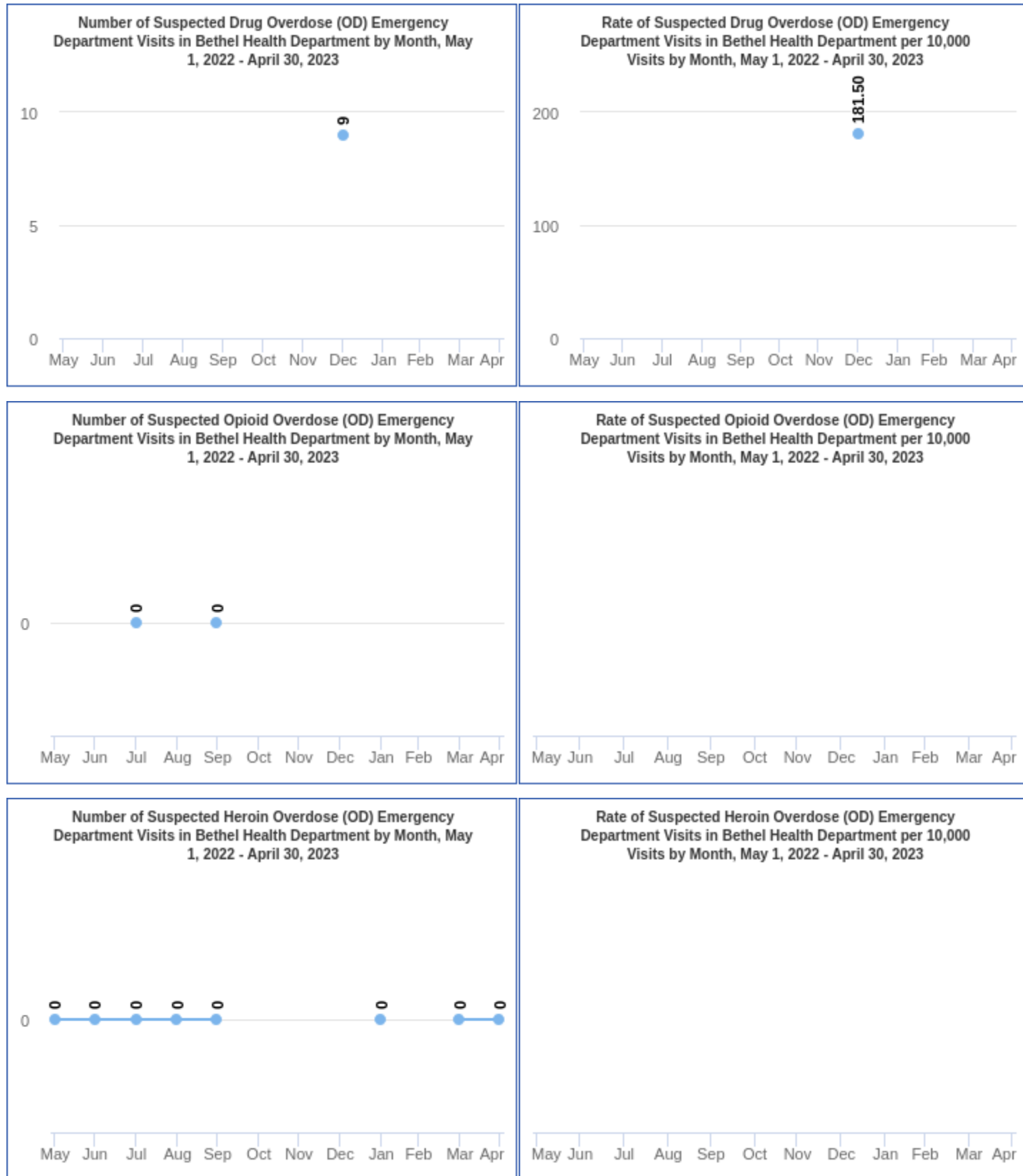

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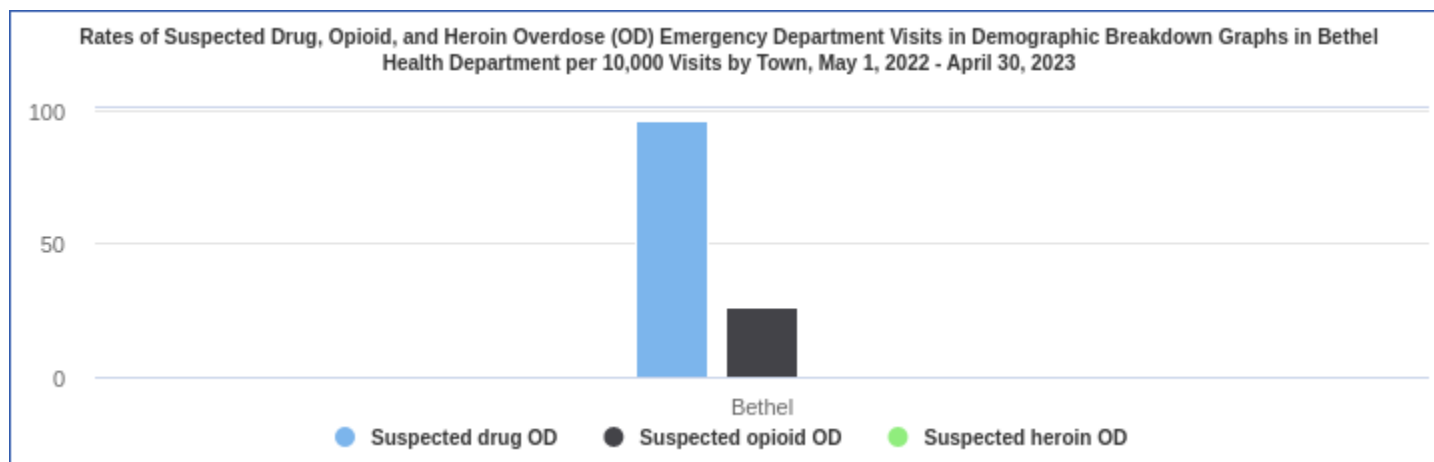

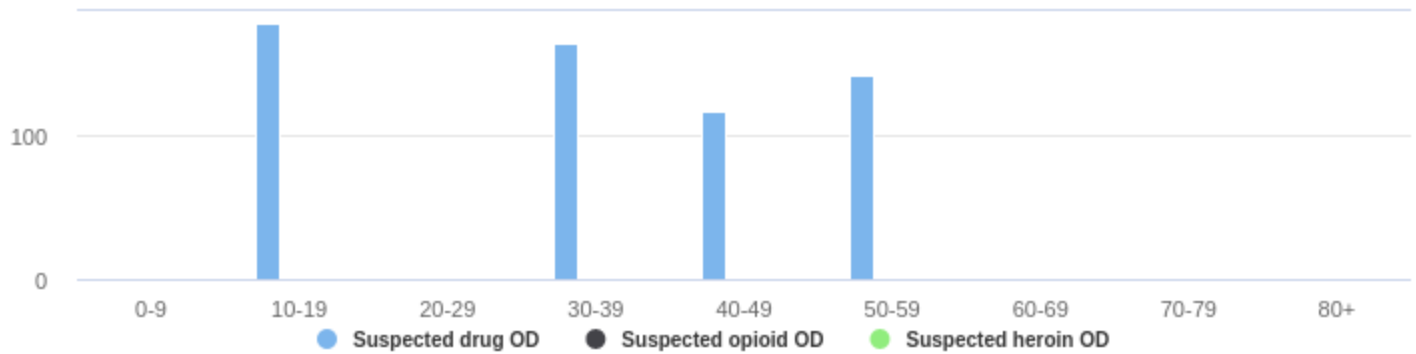

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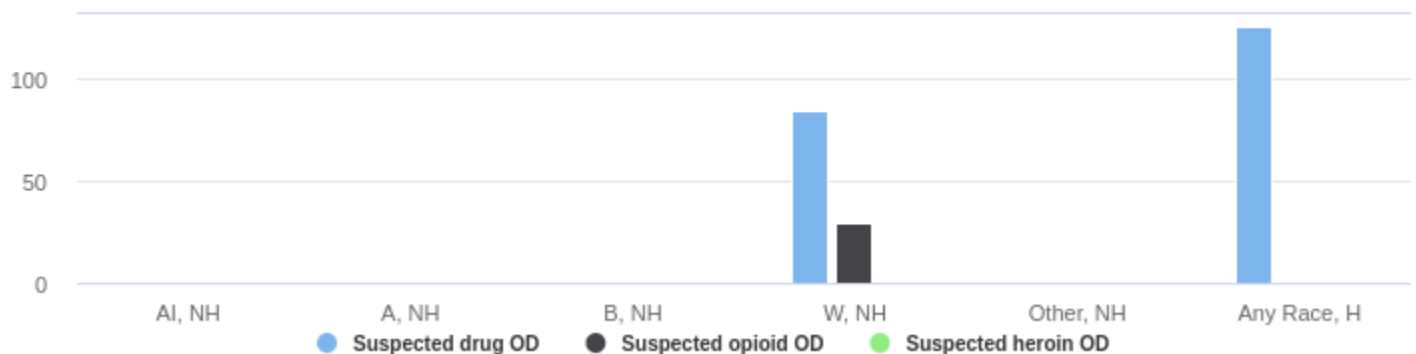

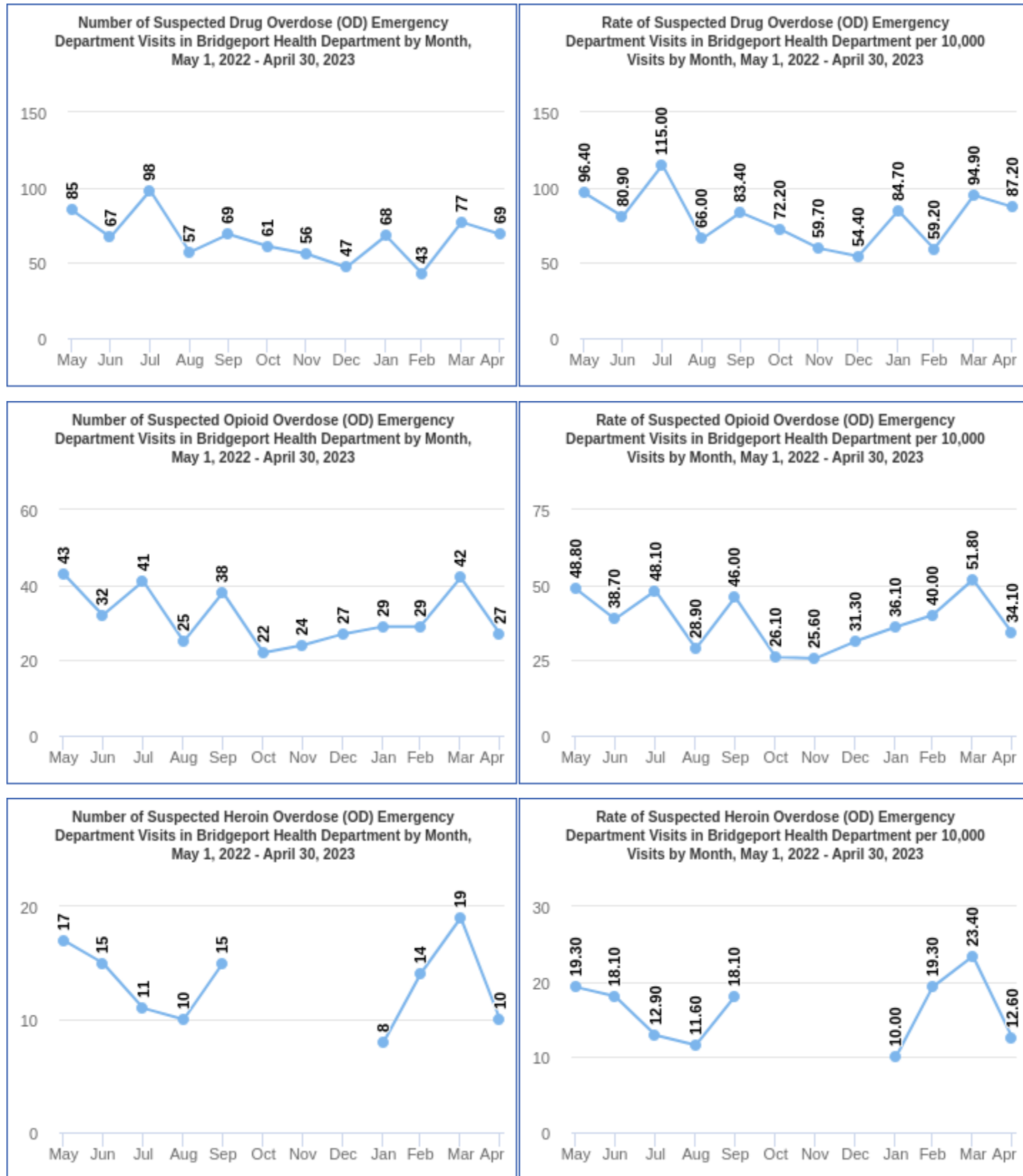

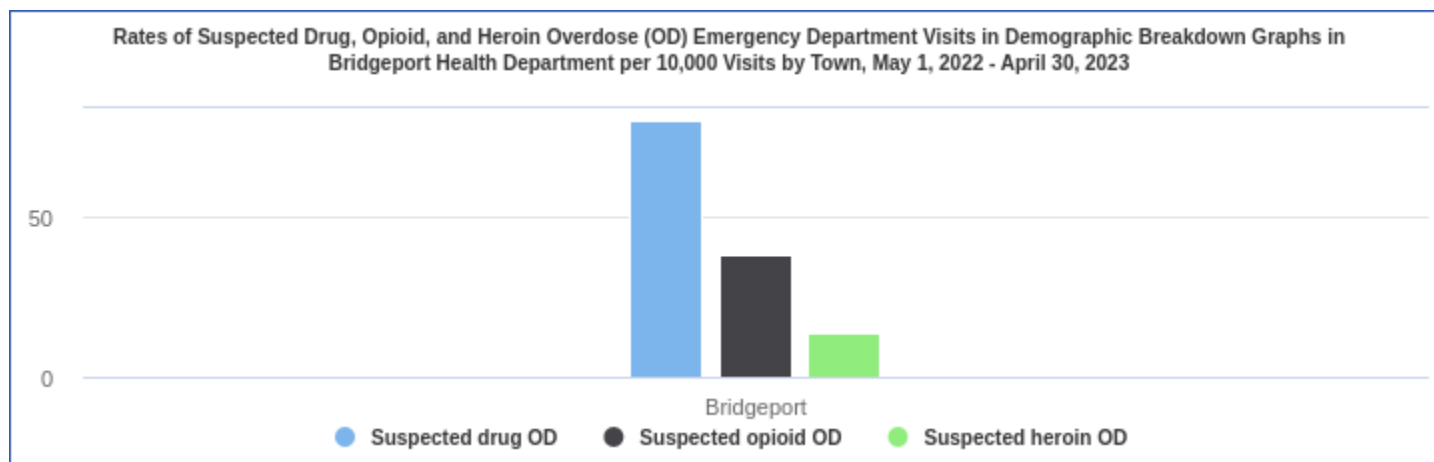

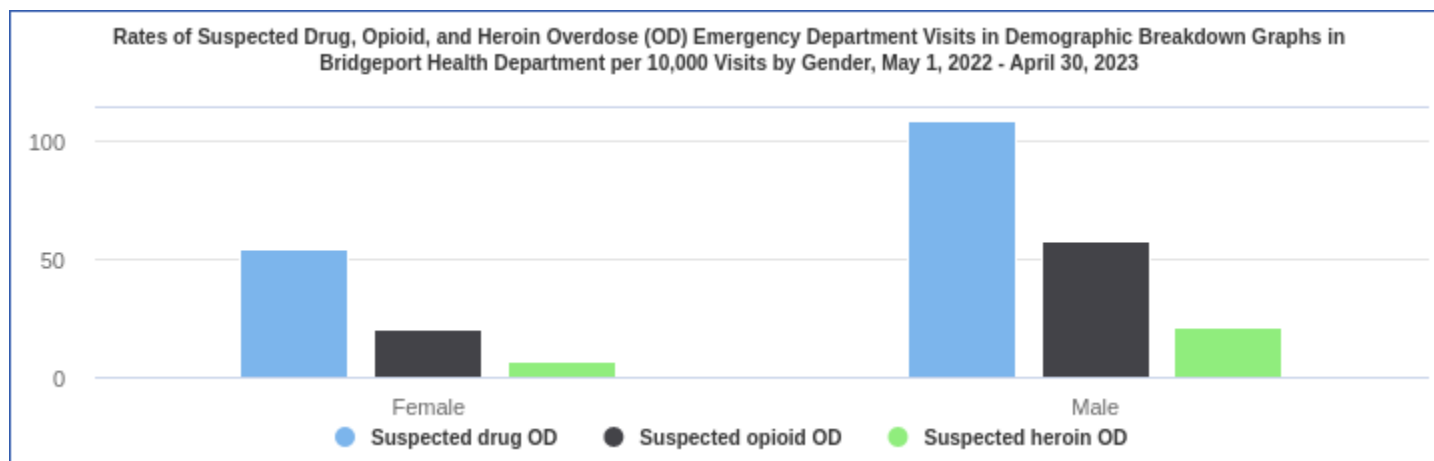

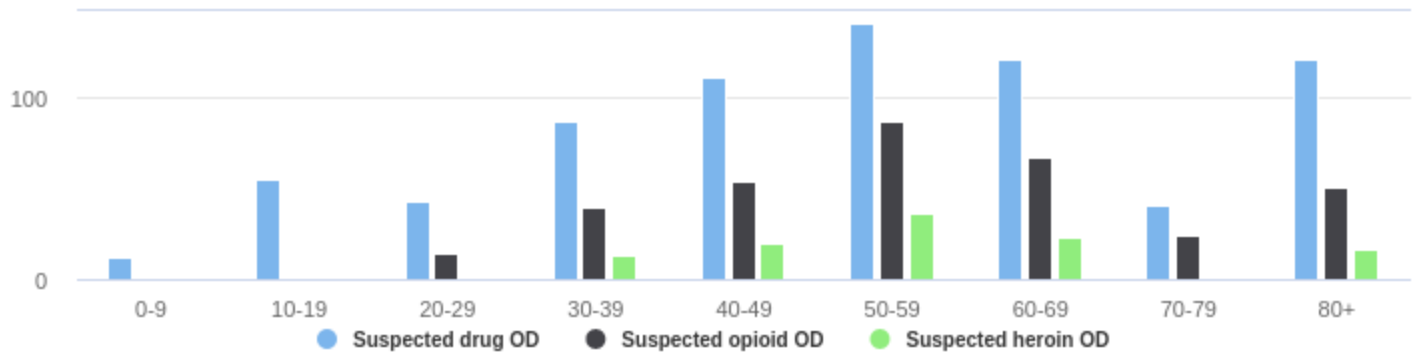

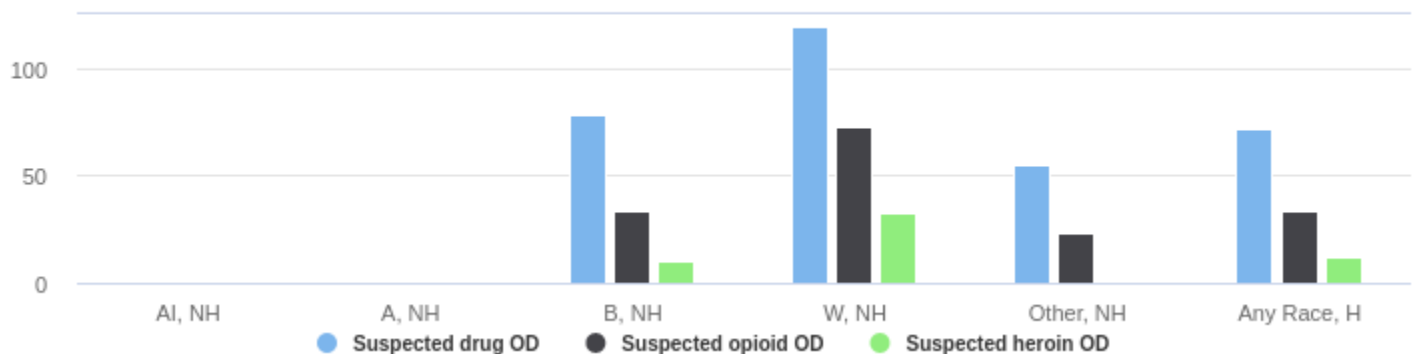

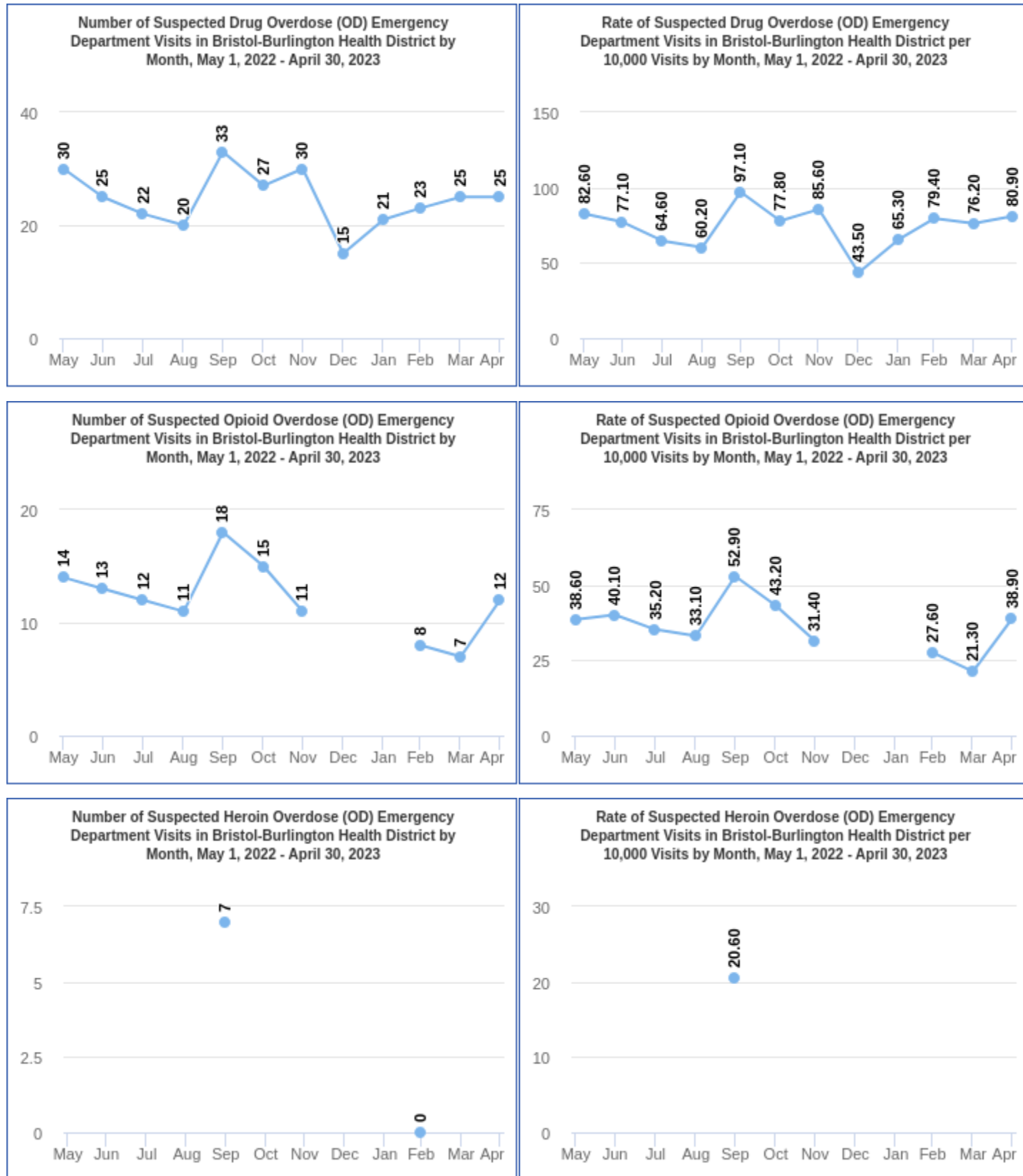

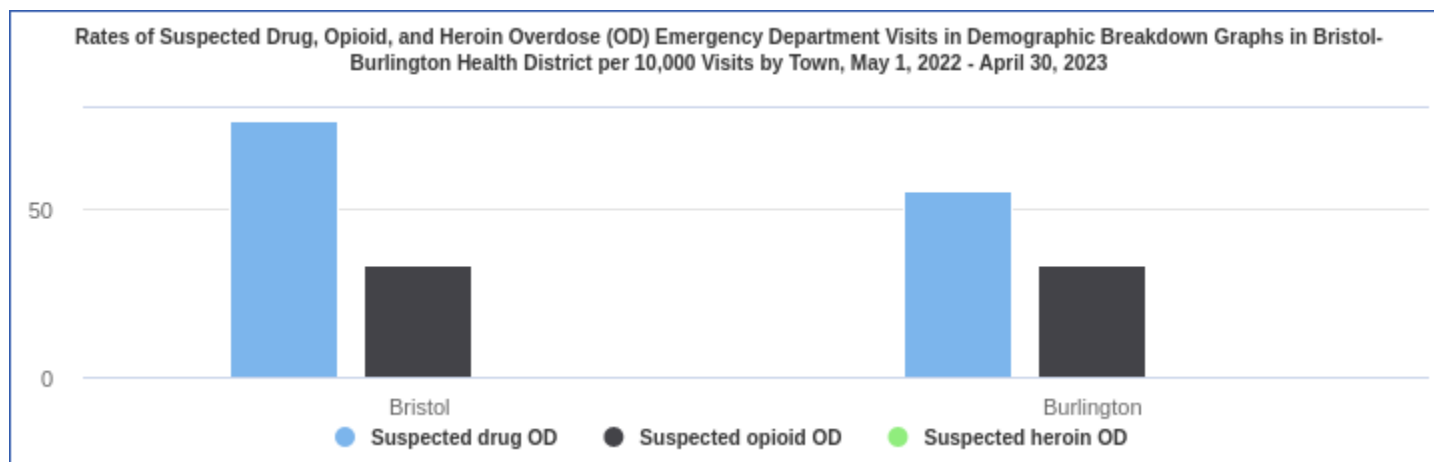

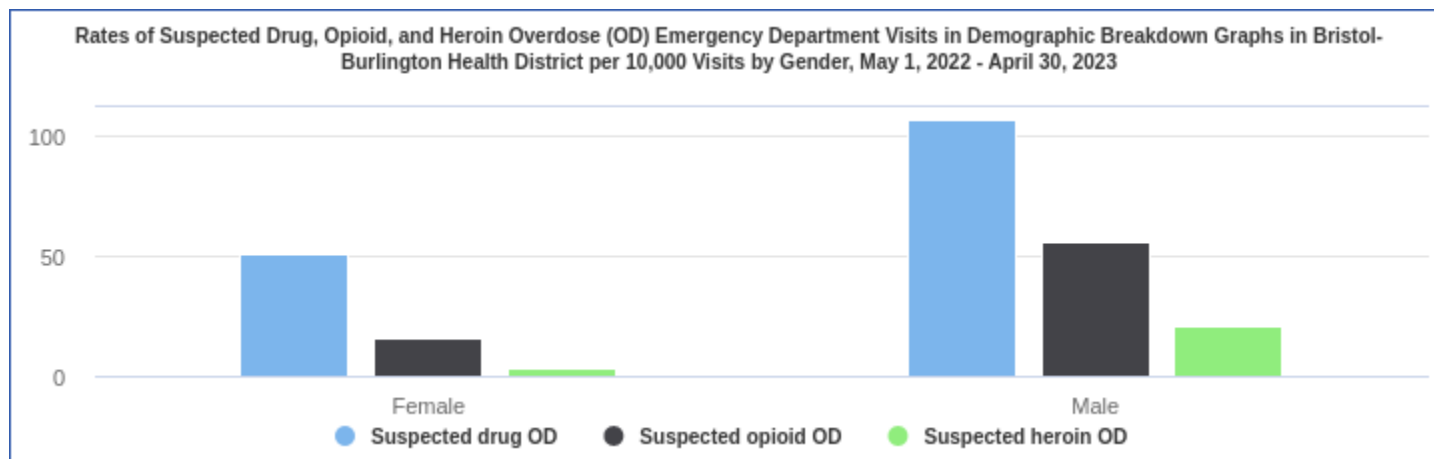

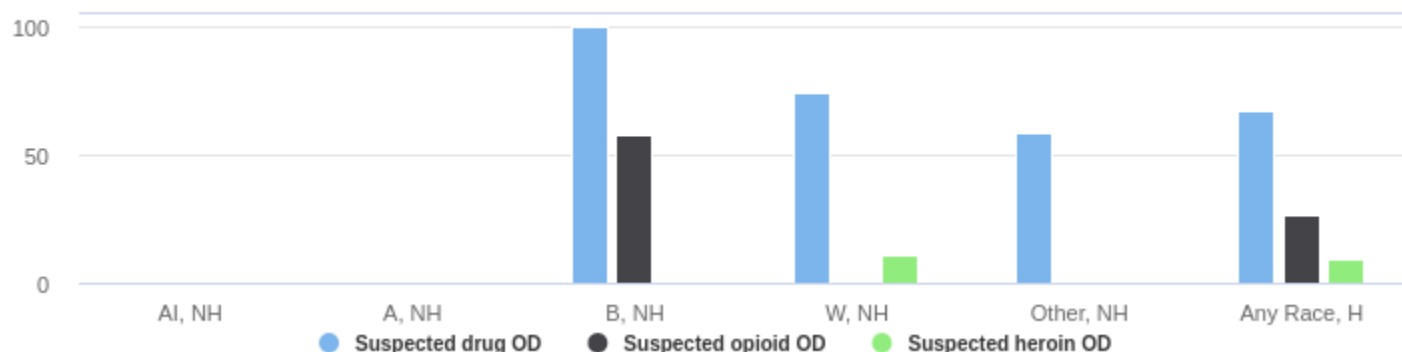

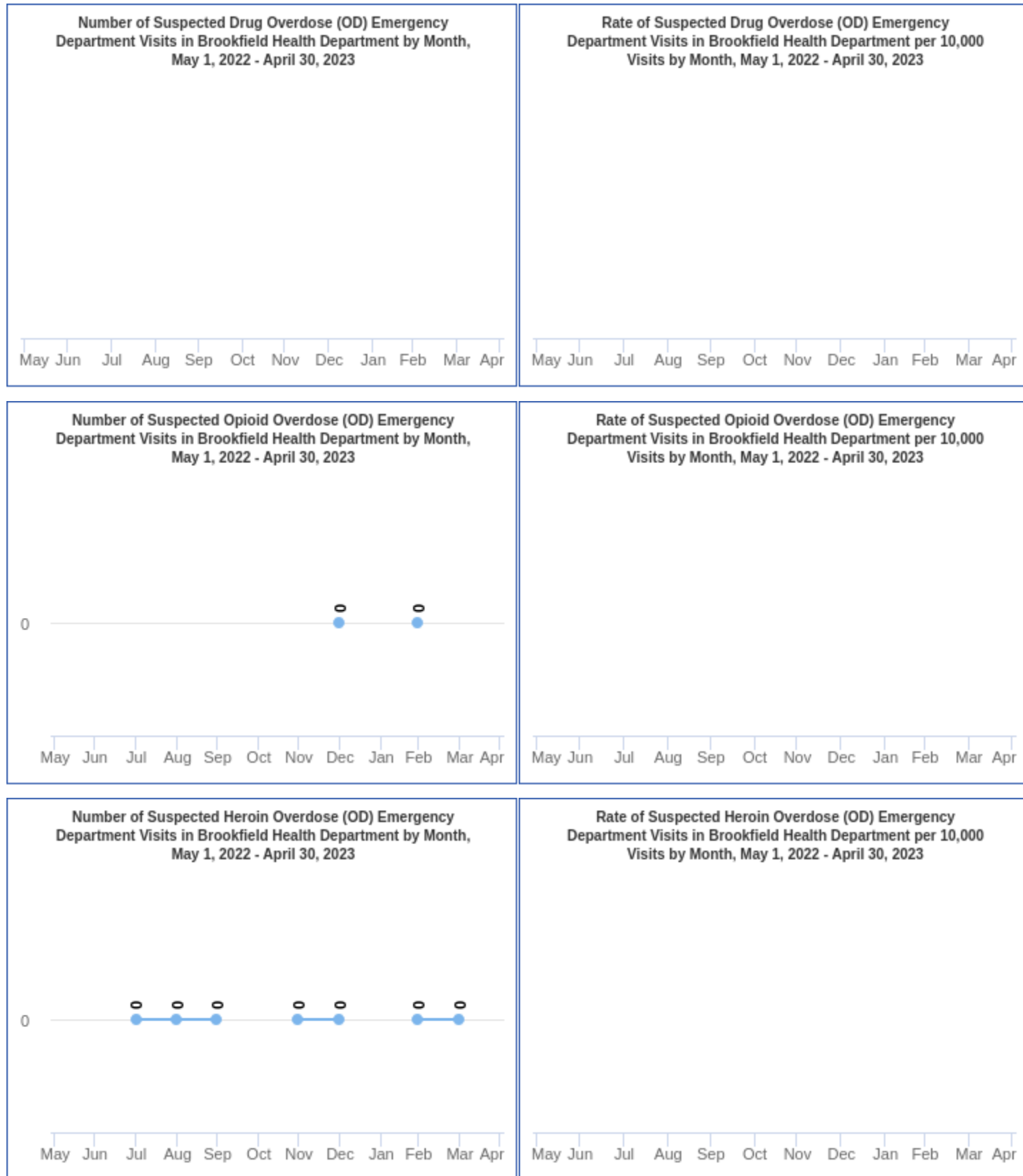

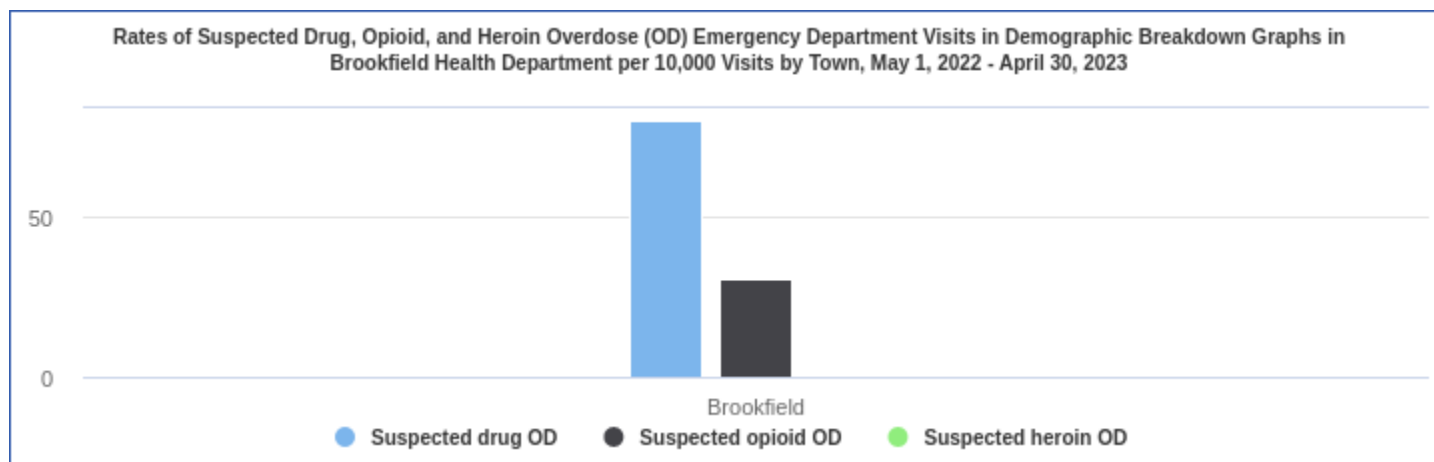

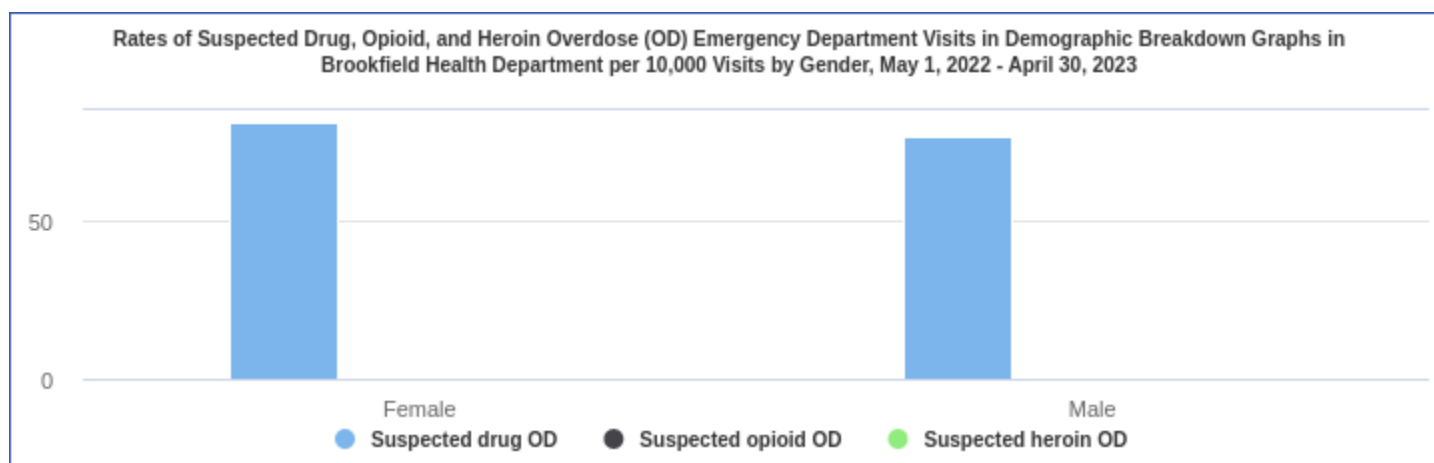

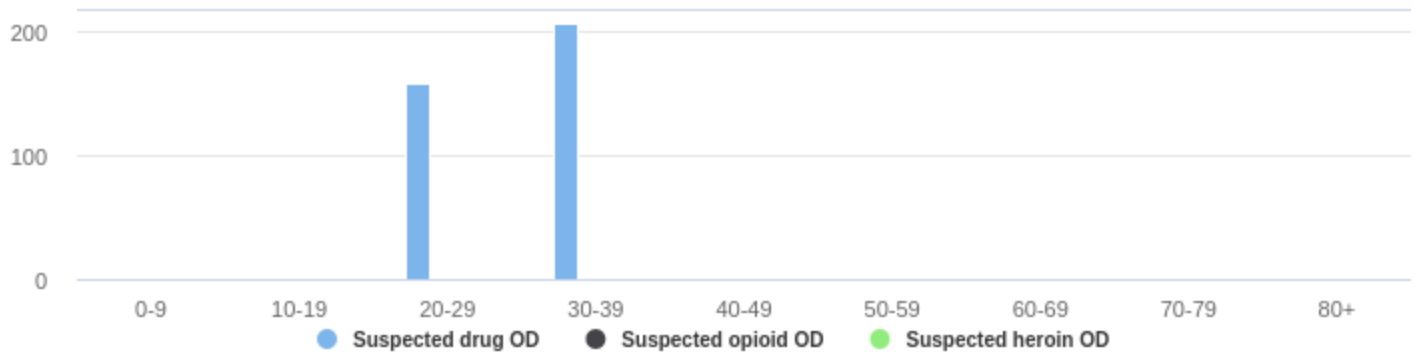

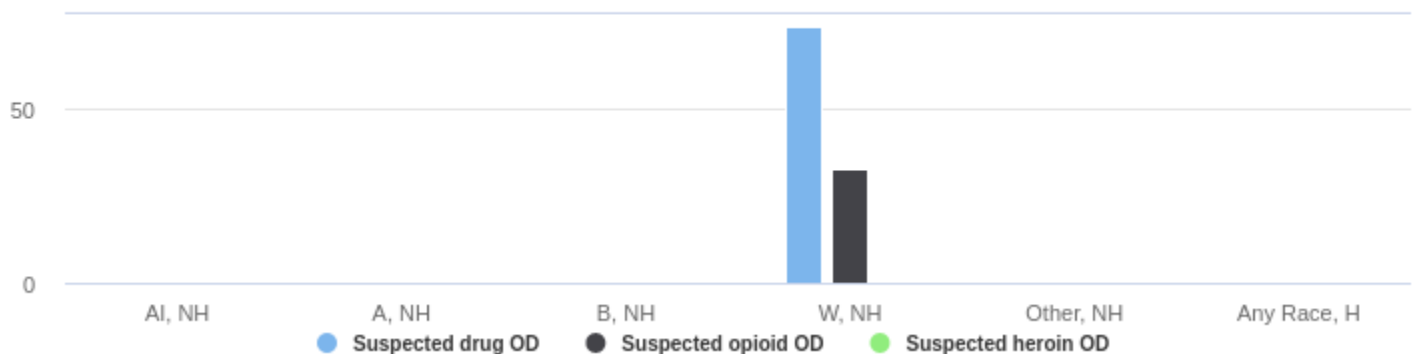

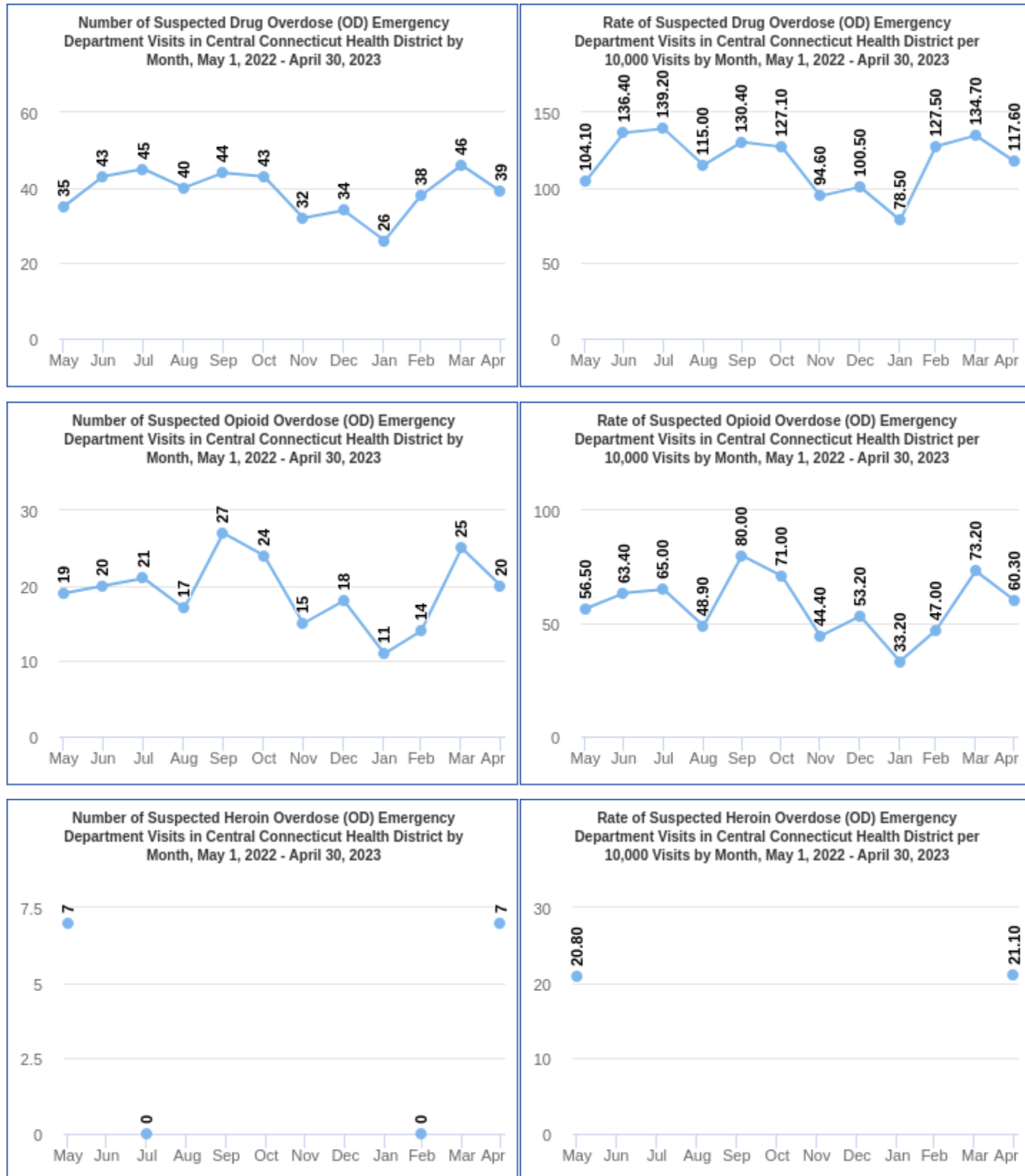

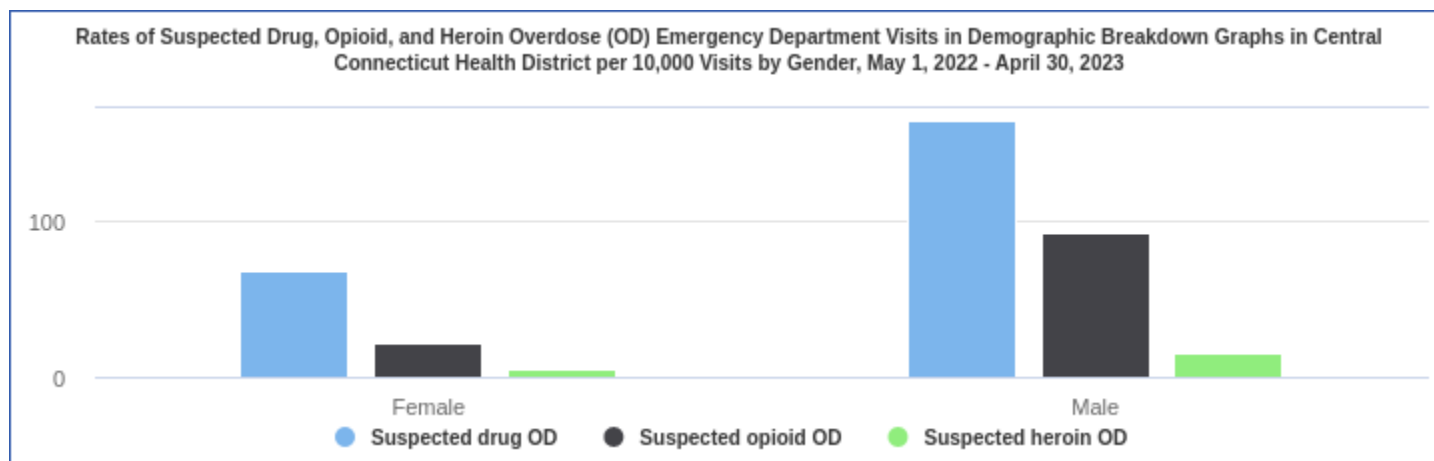

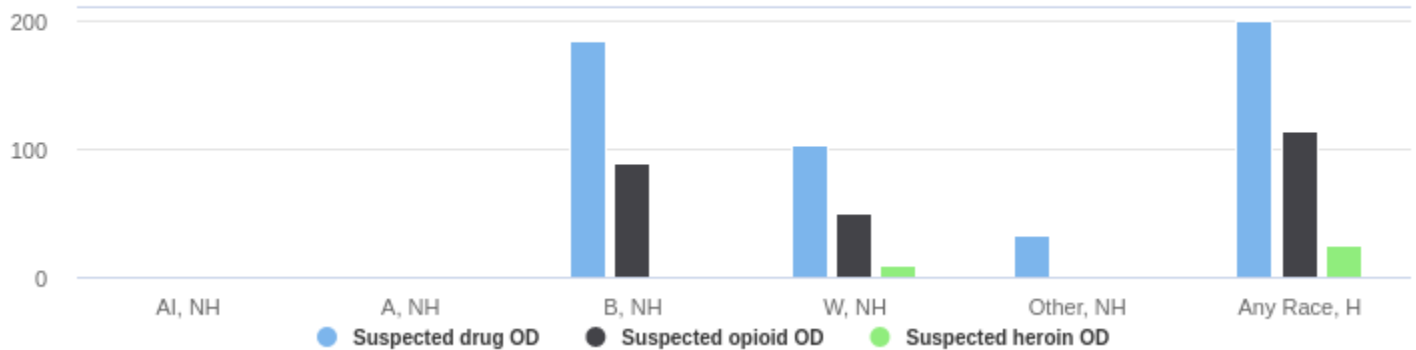

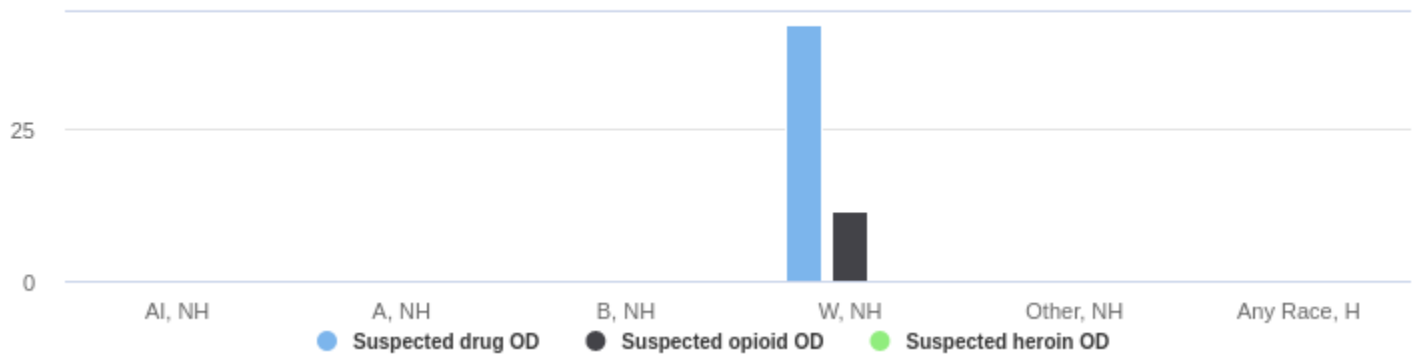

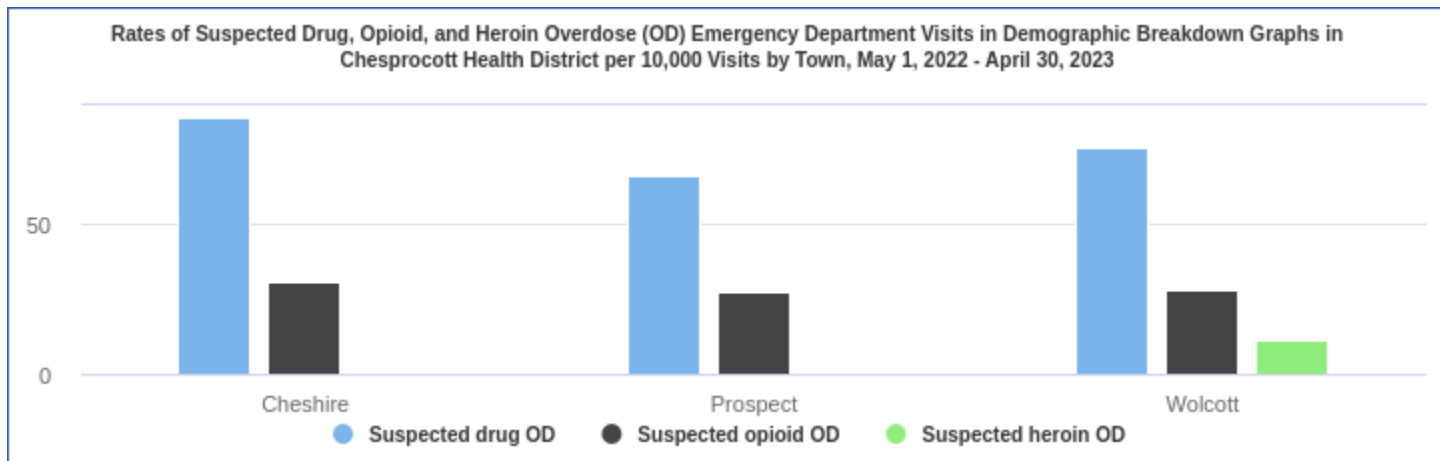

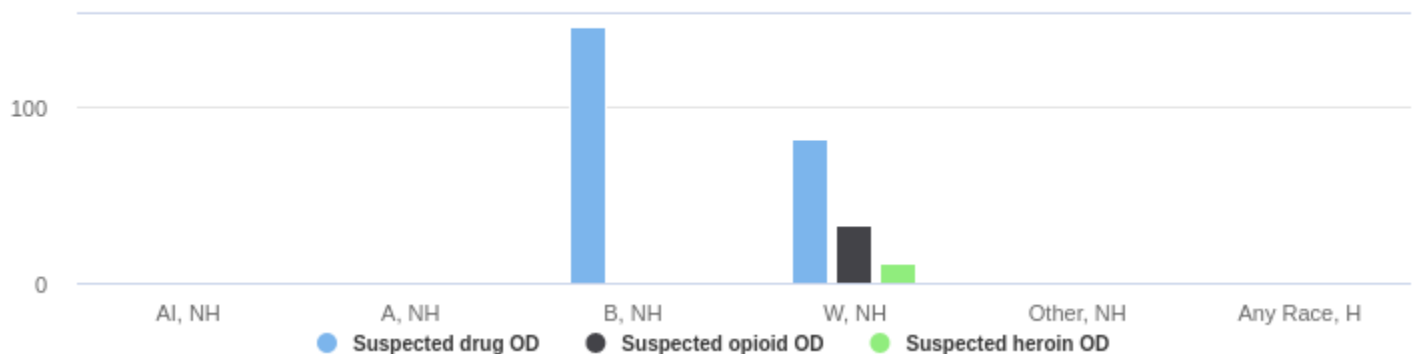

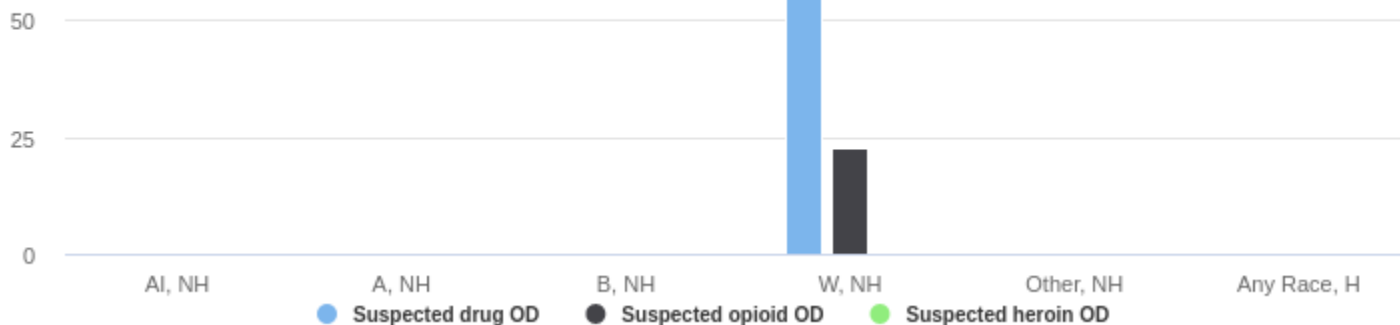

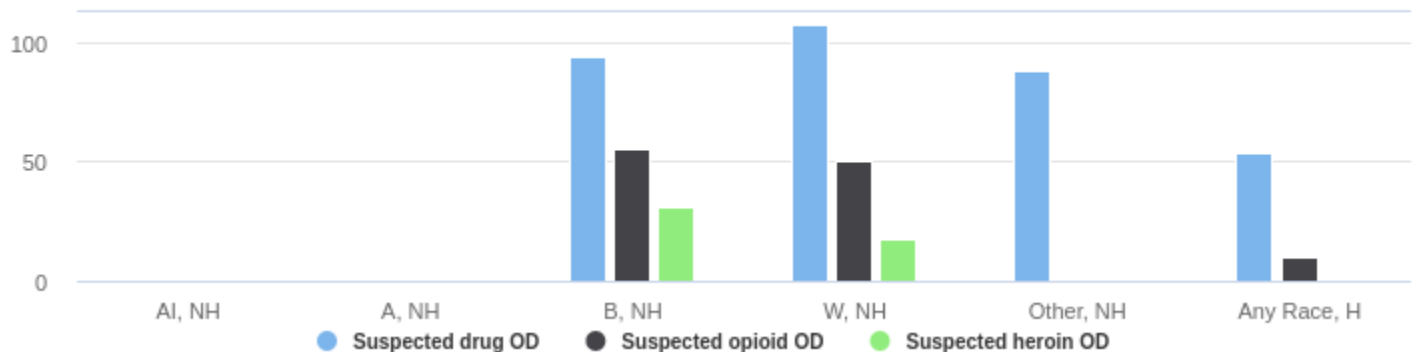

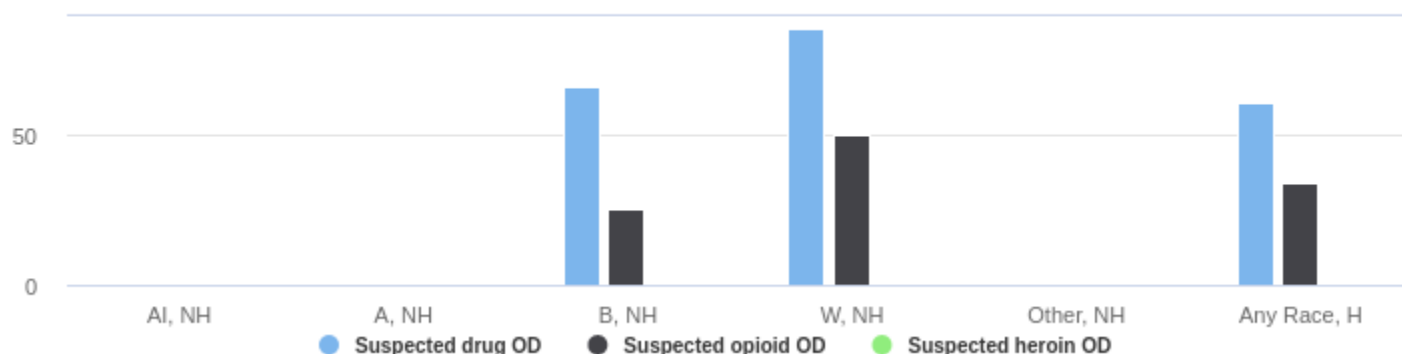

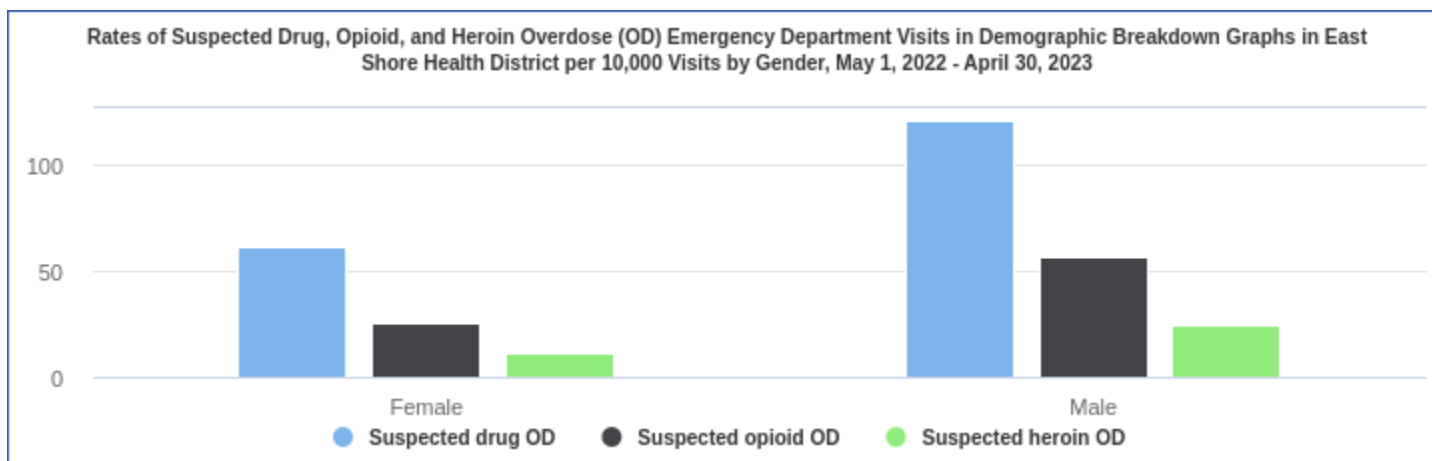

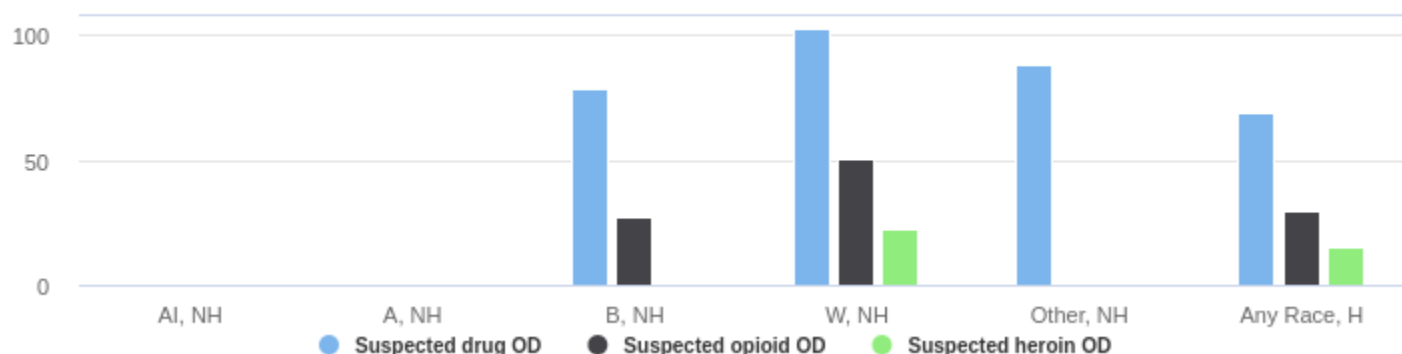

### Suspected Drug Overdose in Eastern Highlands Health District



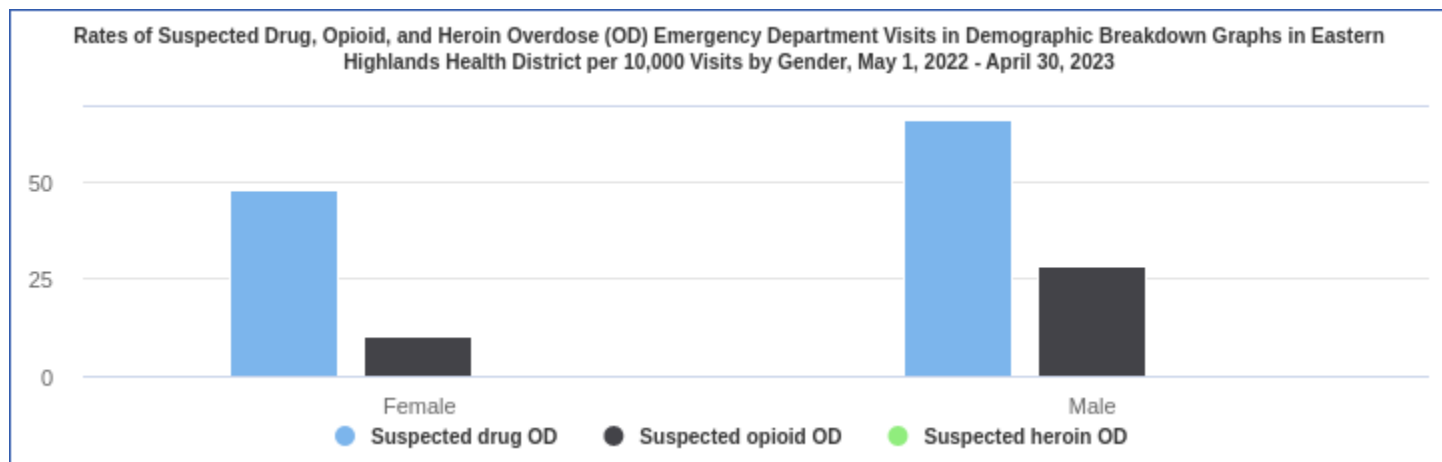

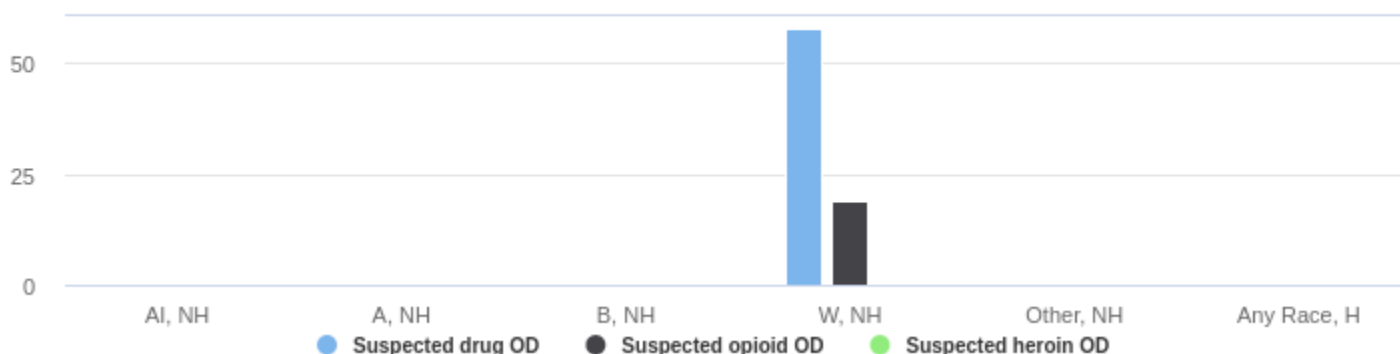

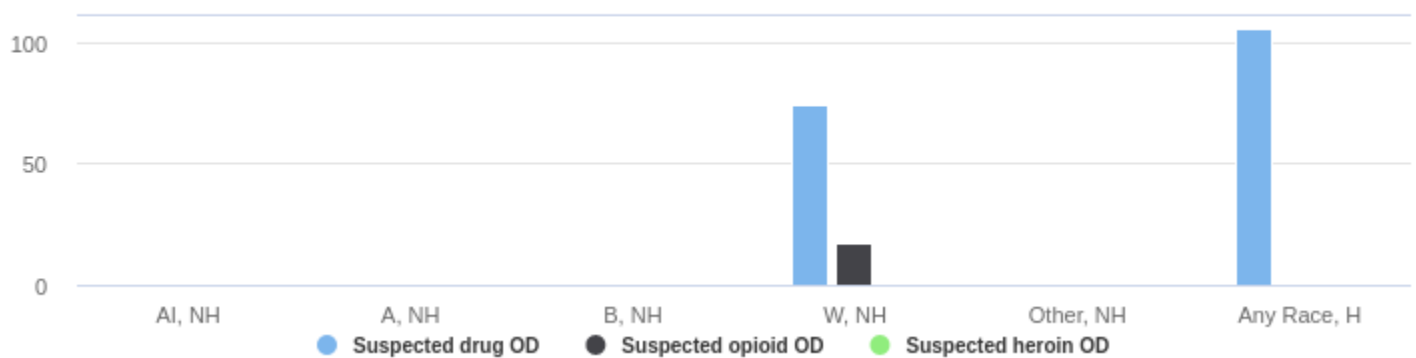

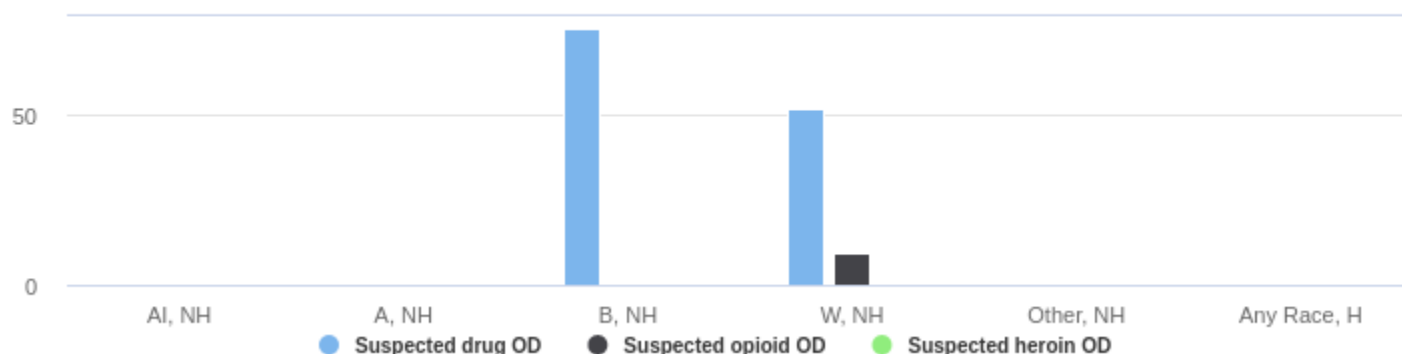

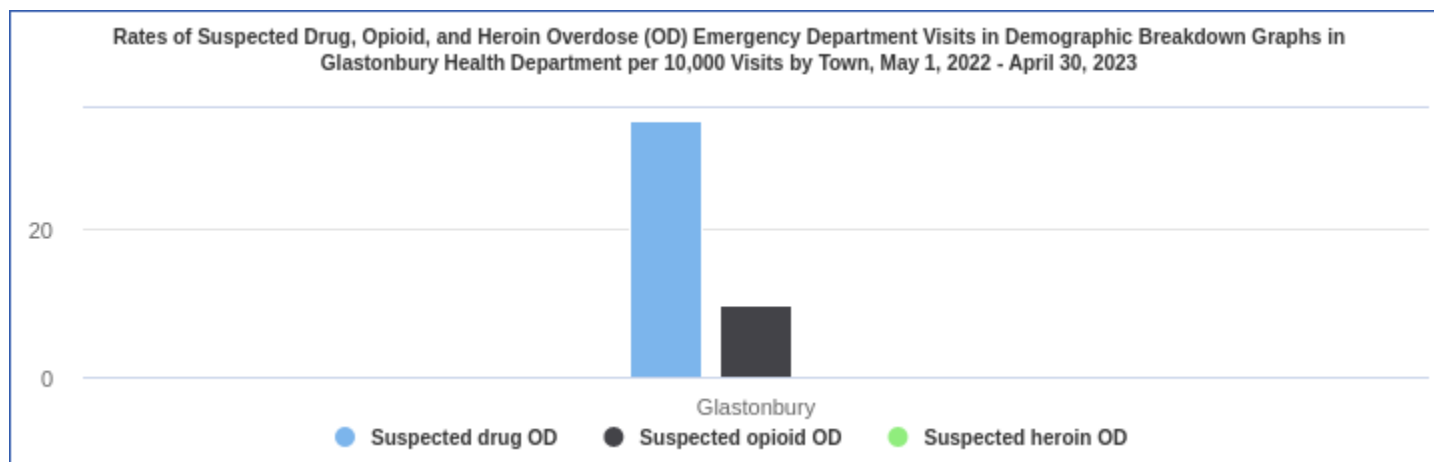

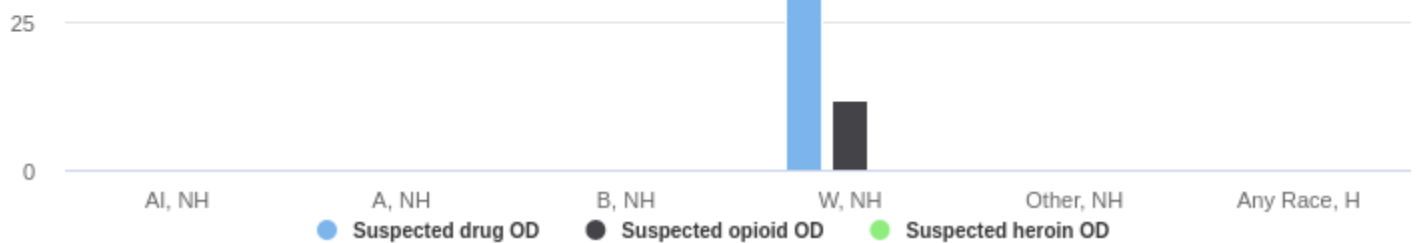

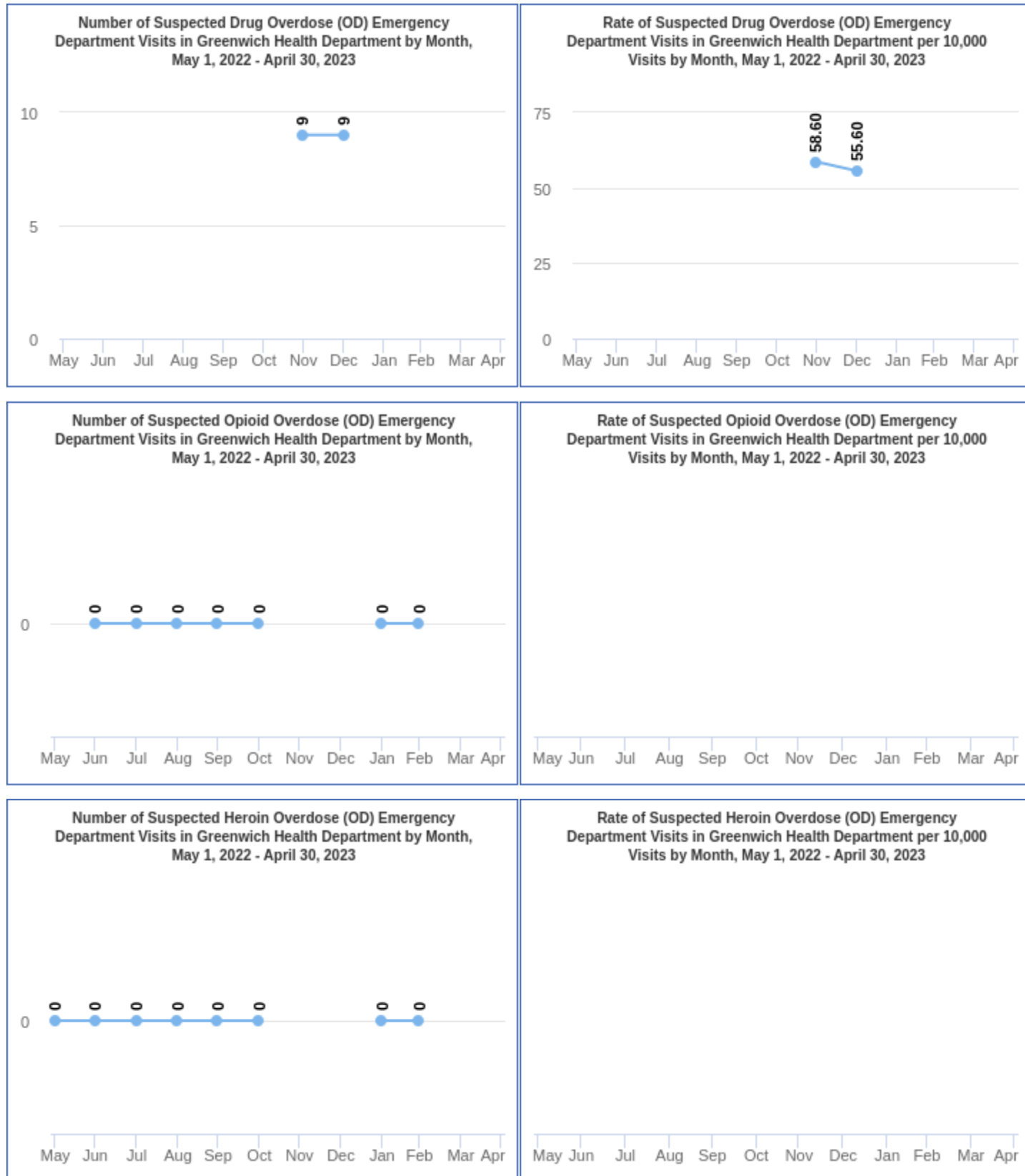

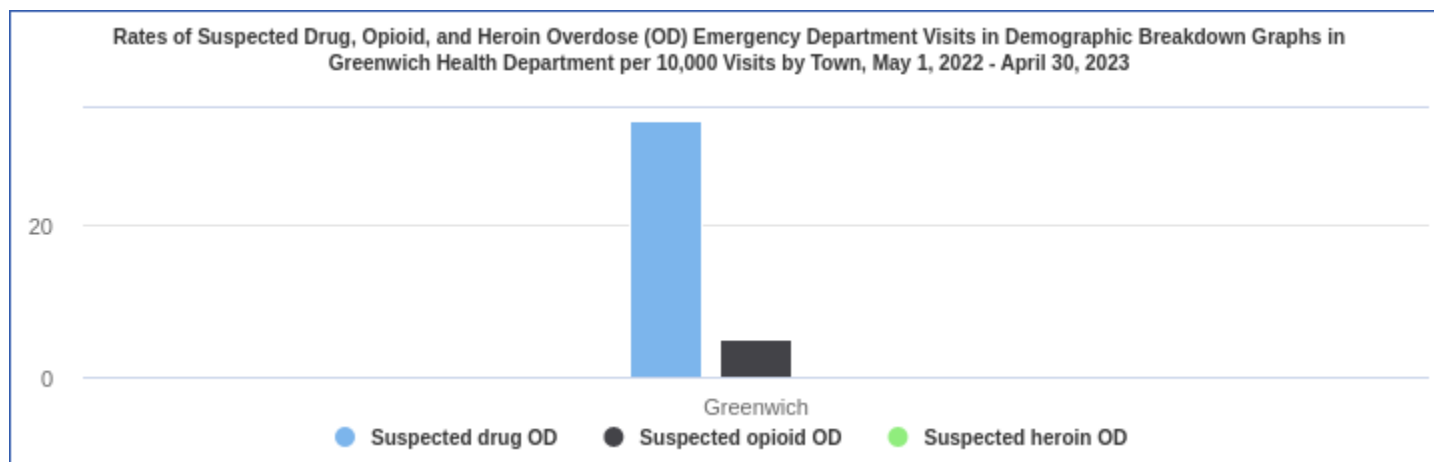

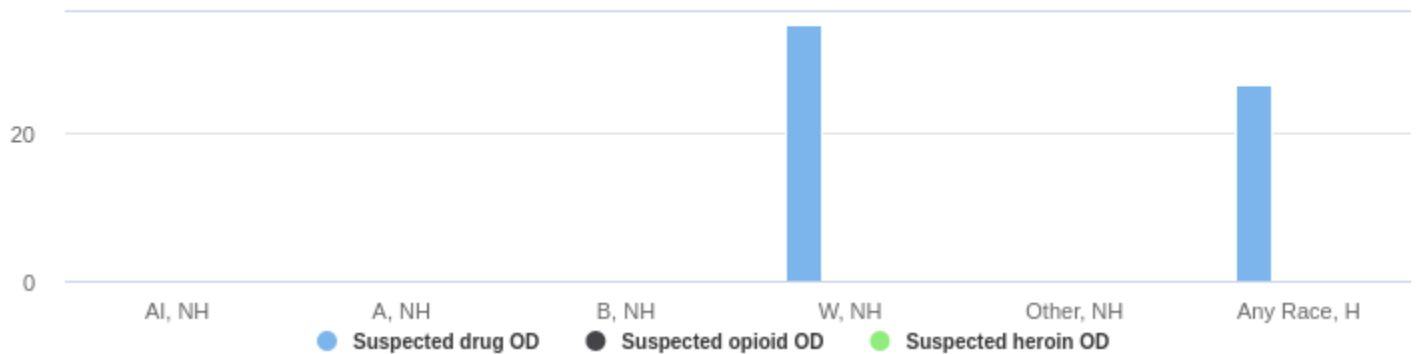

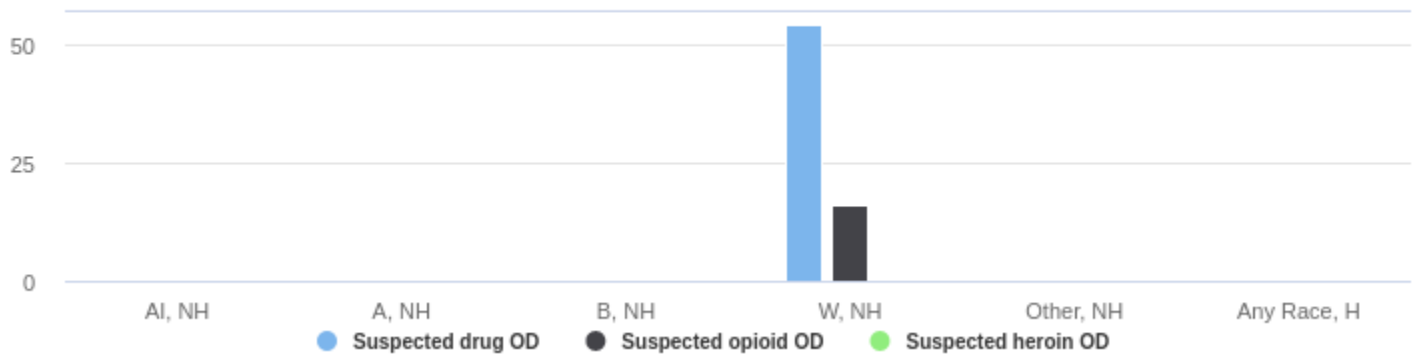

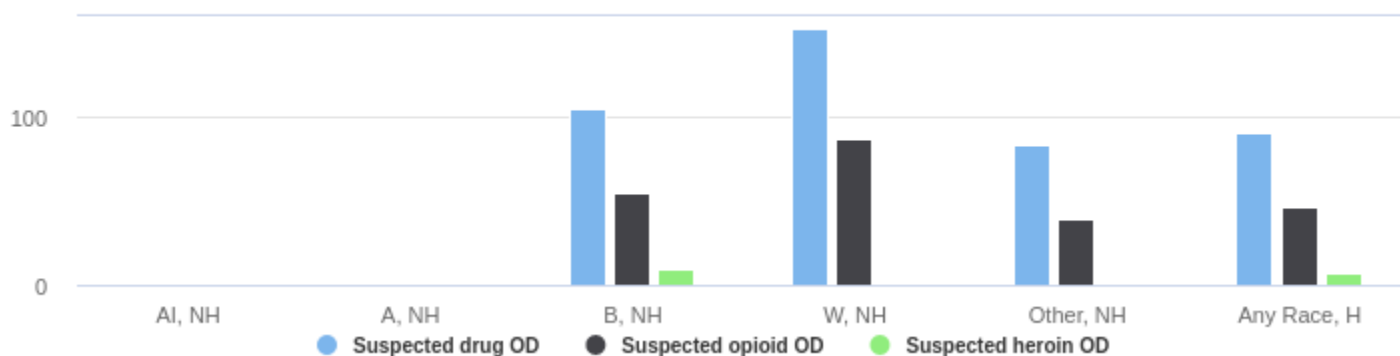

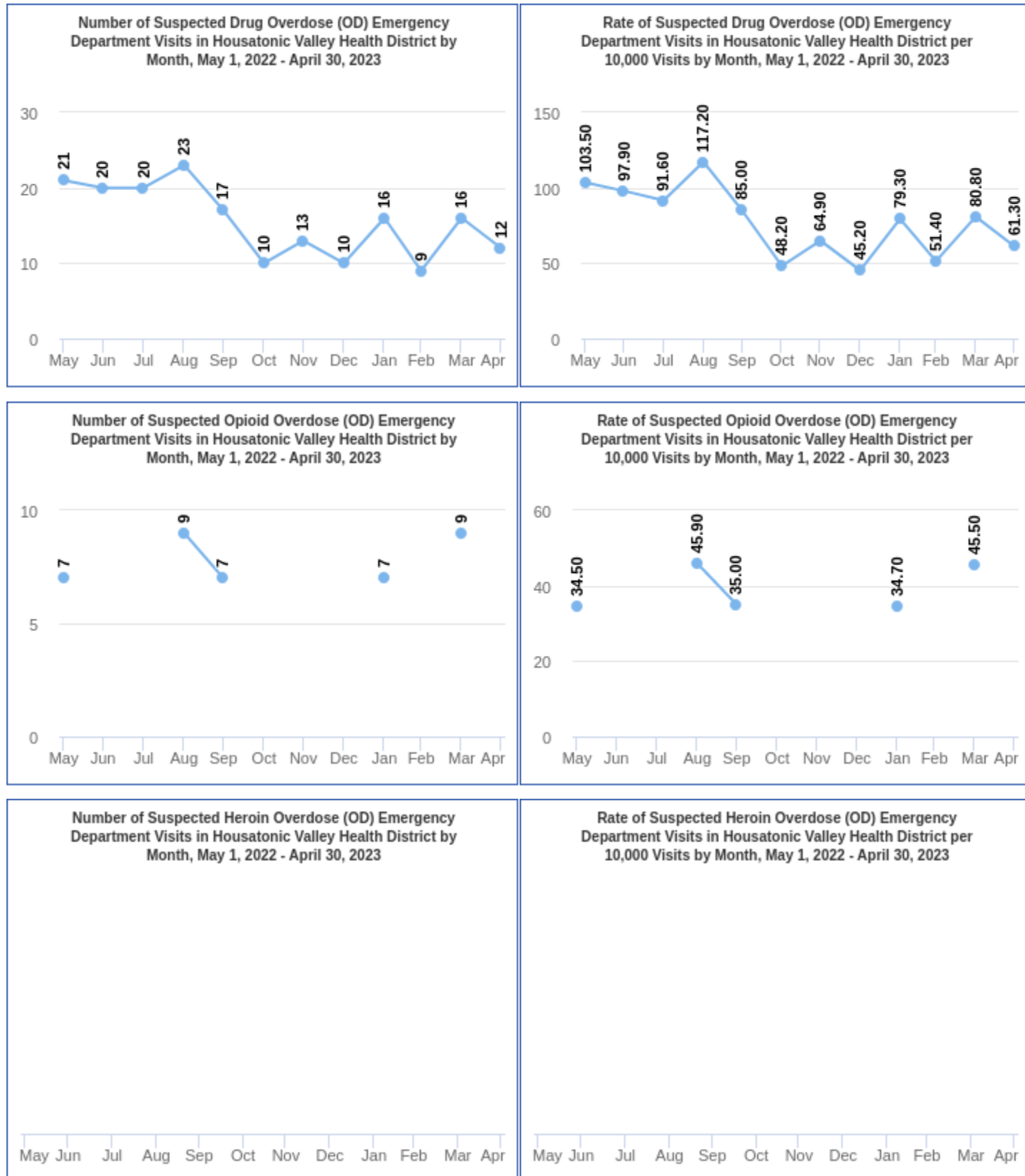

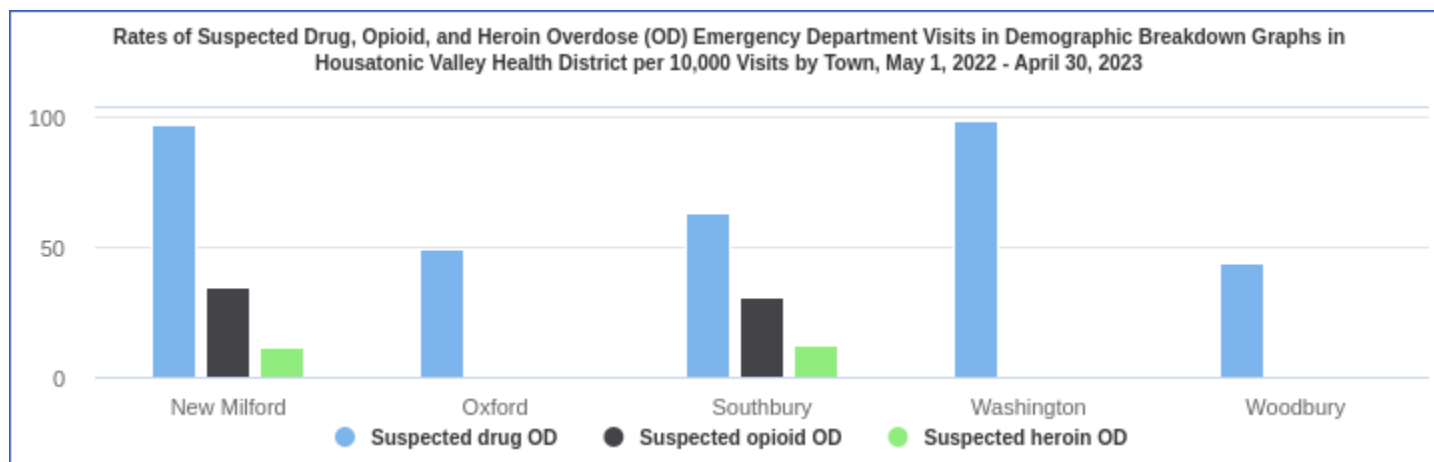

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Housatonic Valley Health District



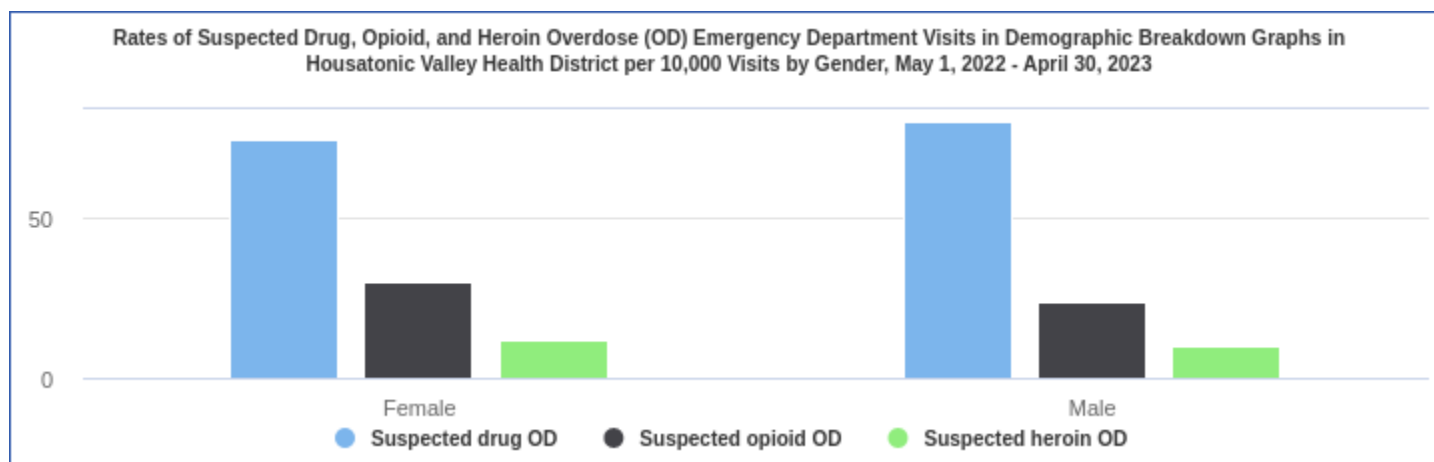

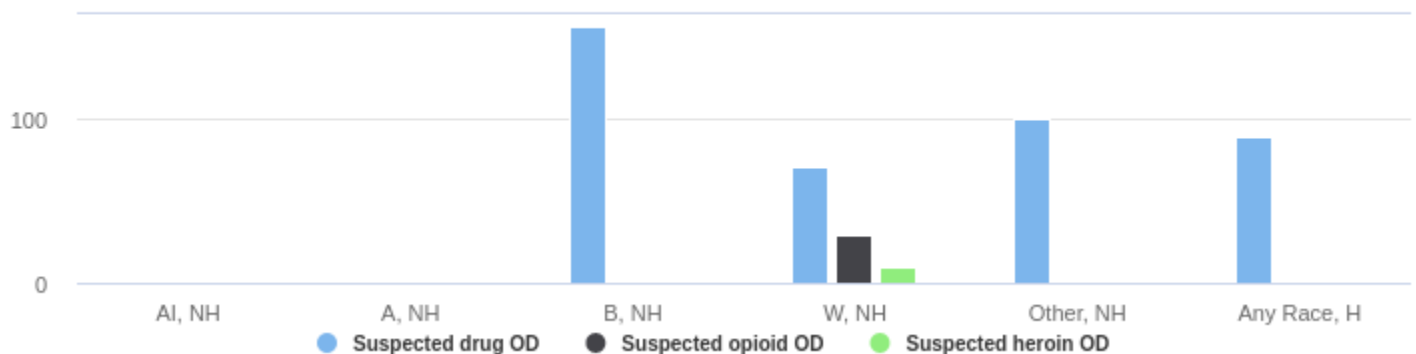

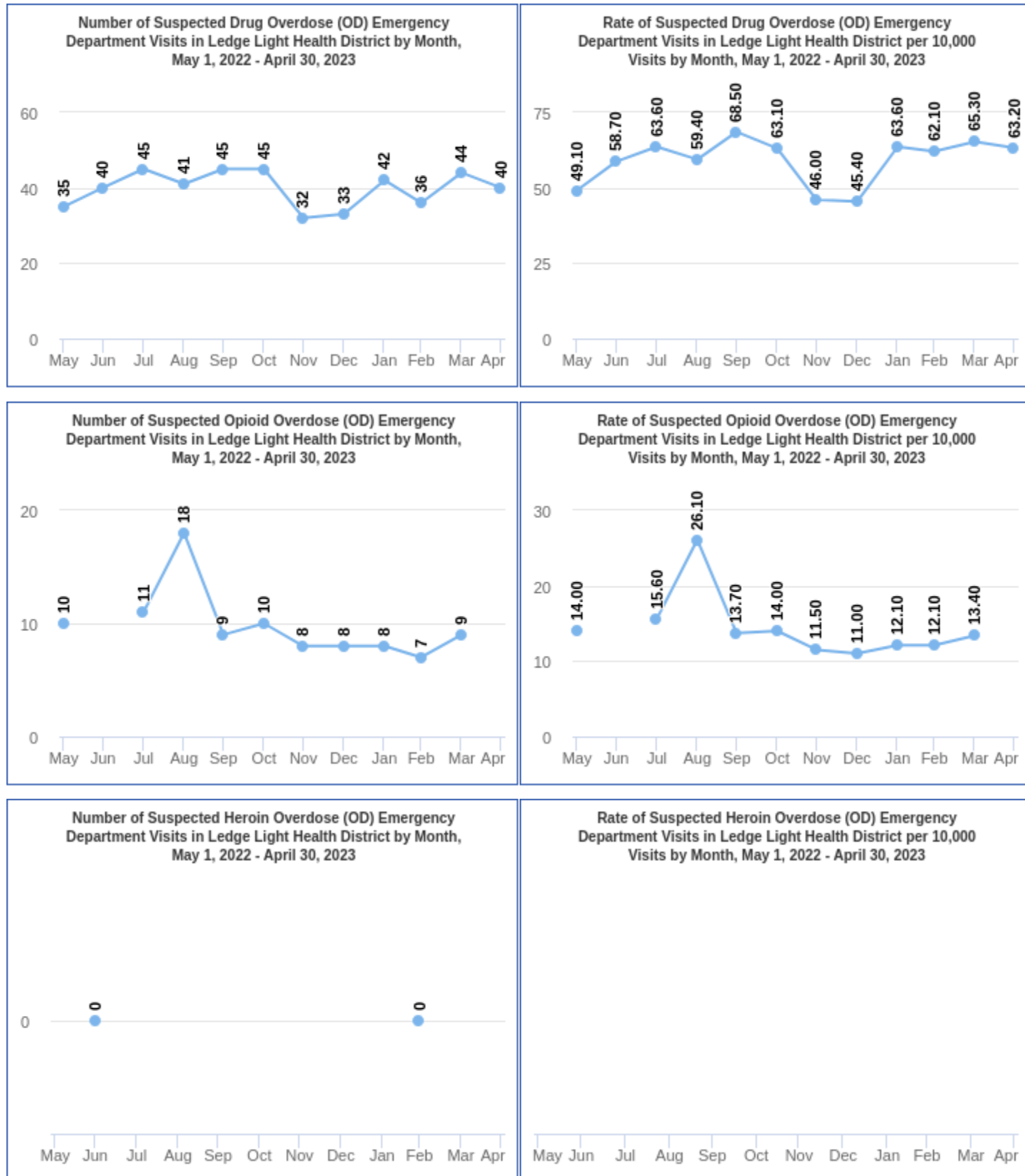

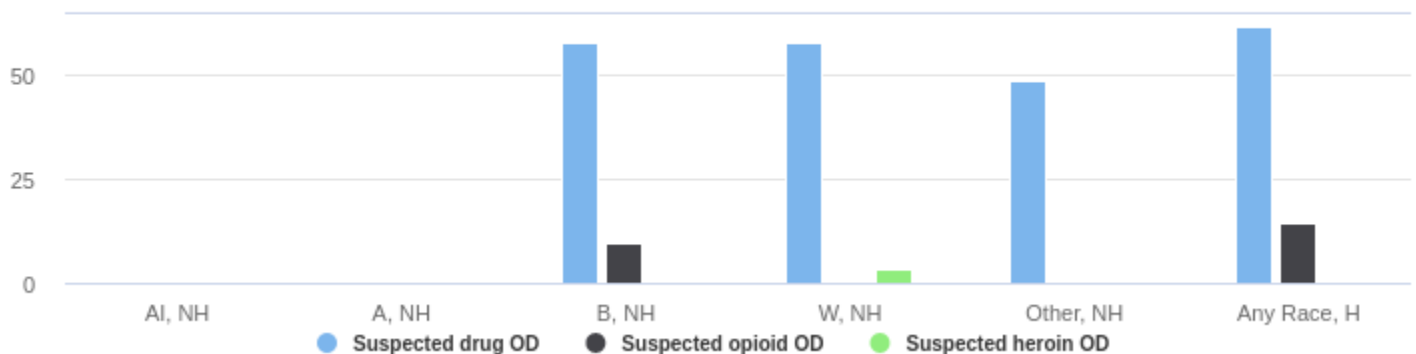

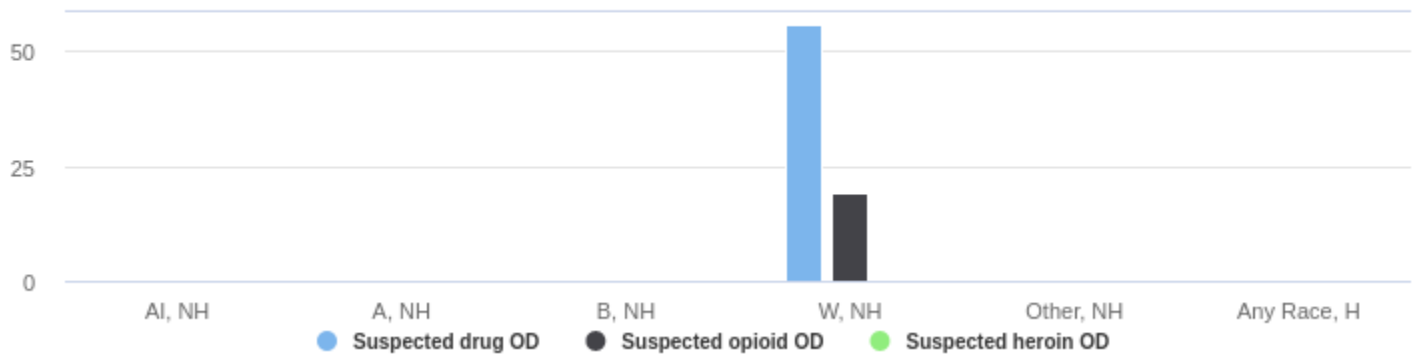

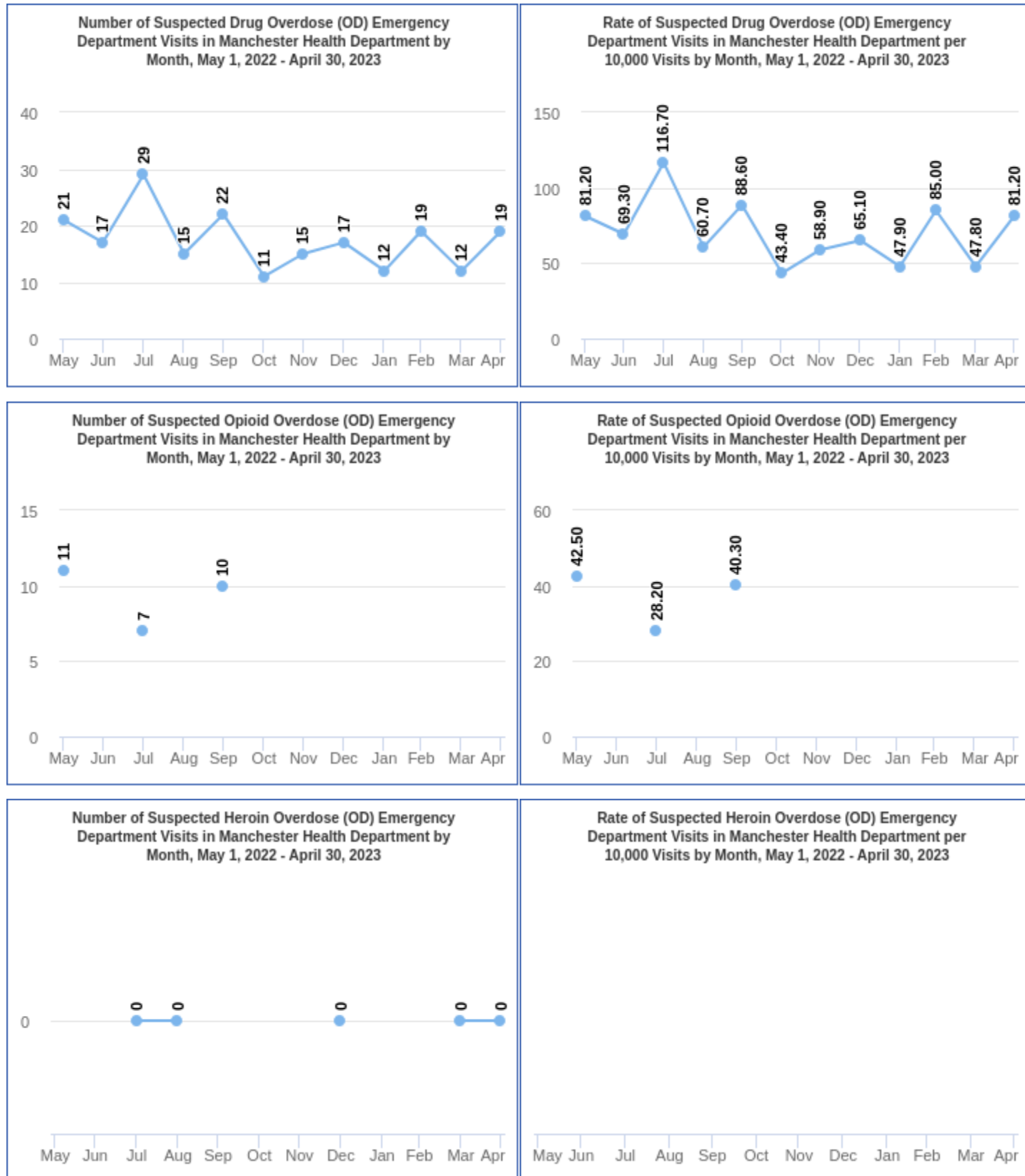

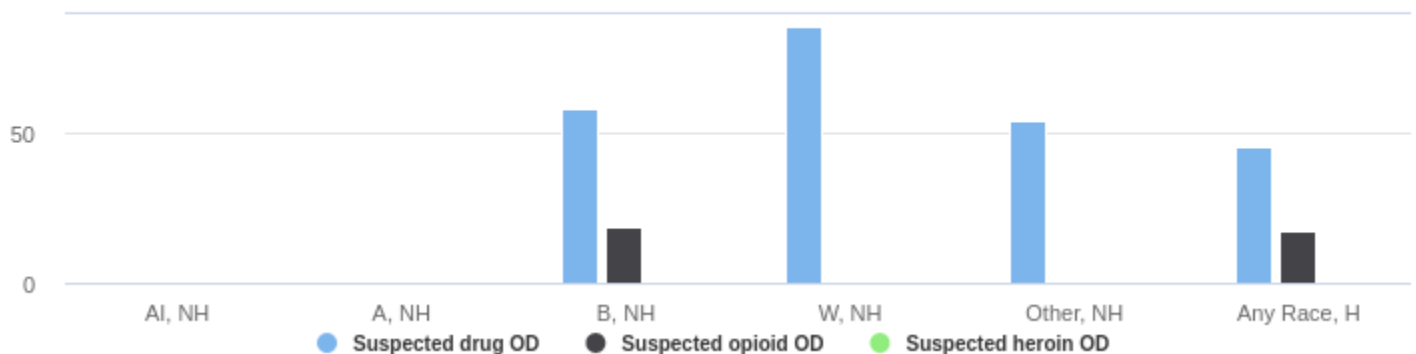

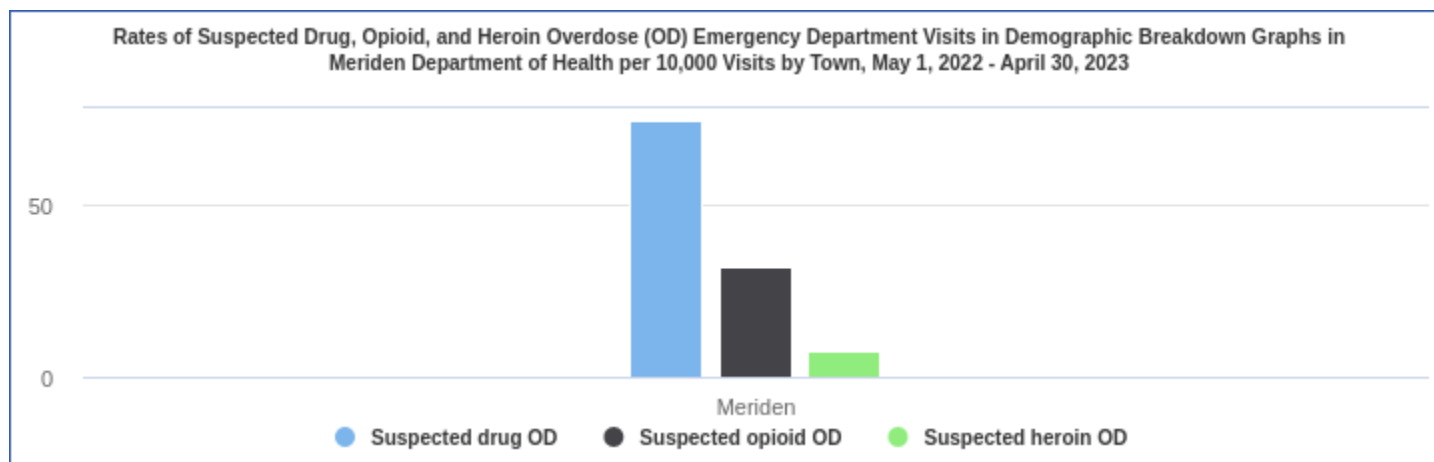

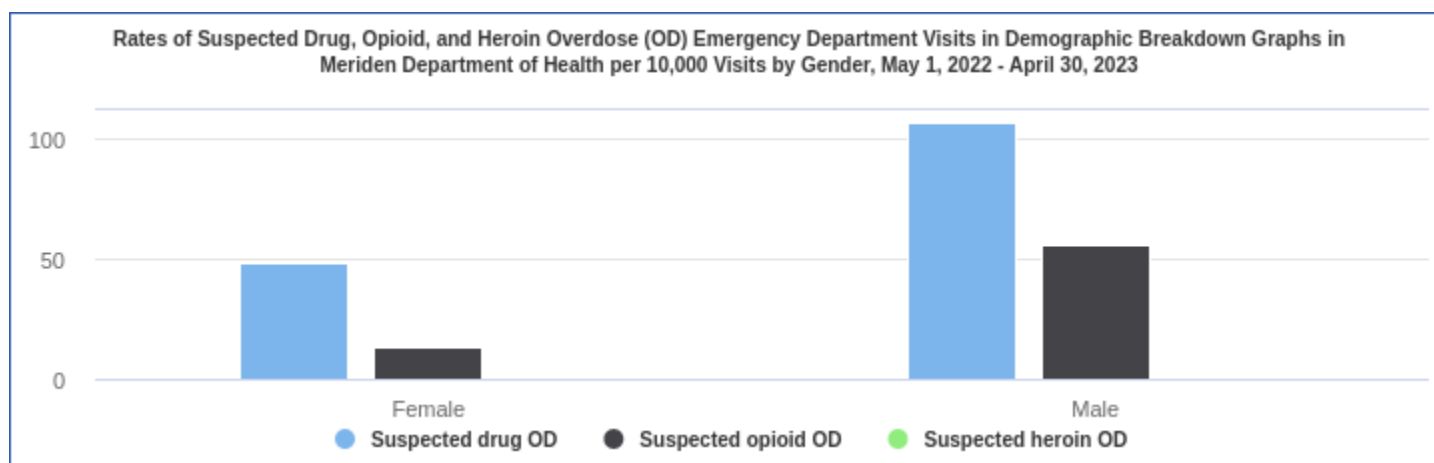

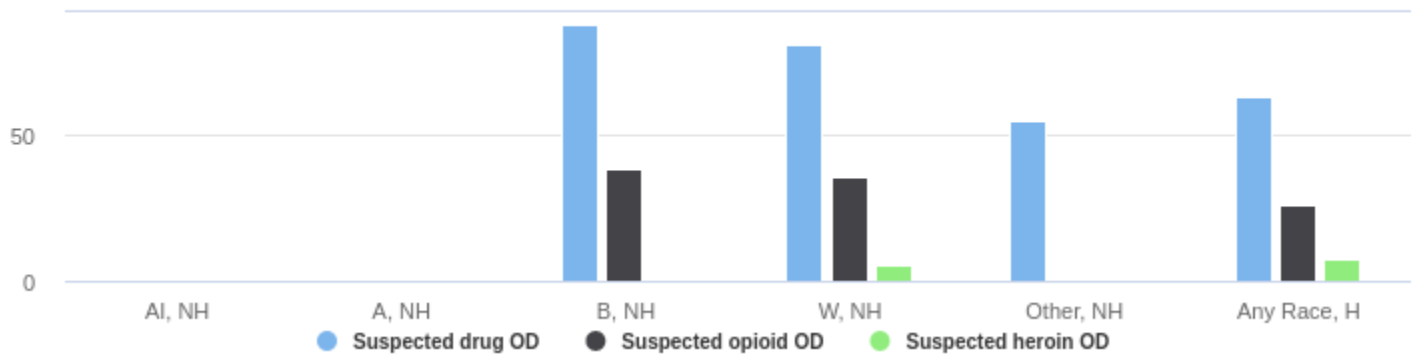

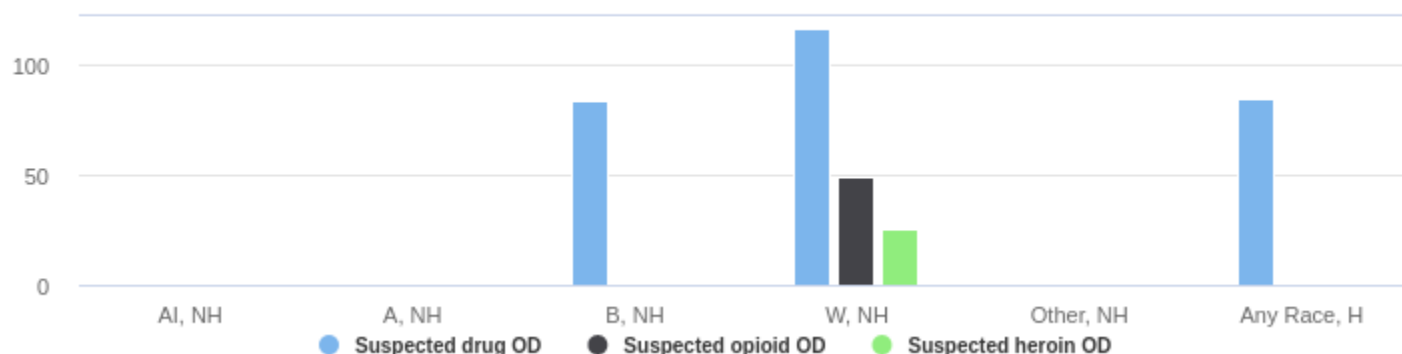

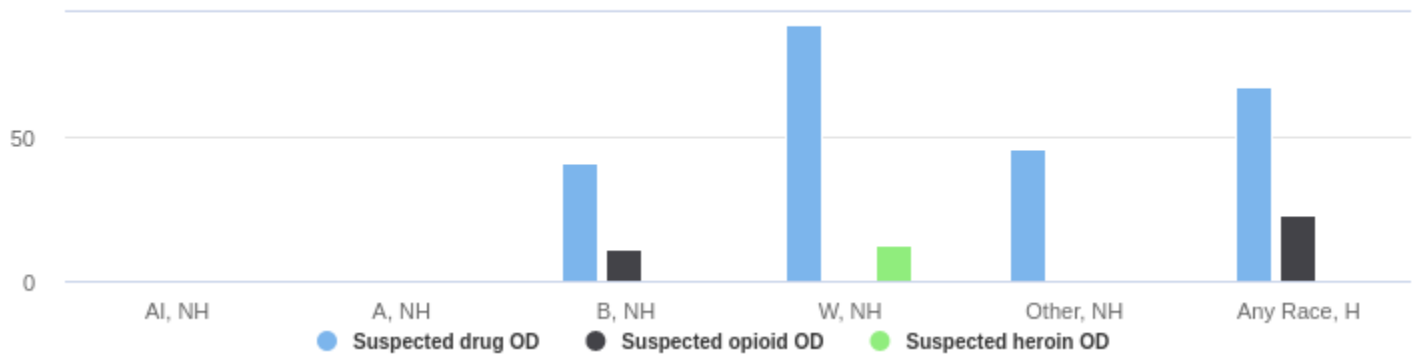

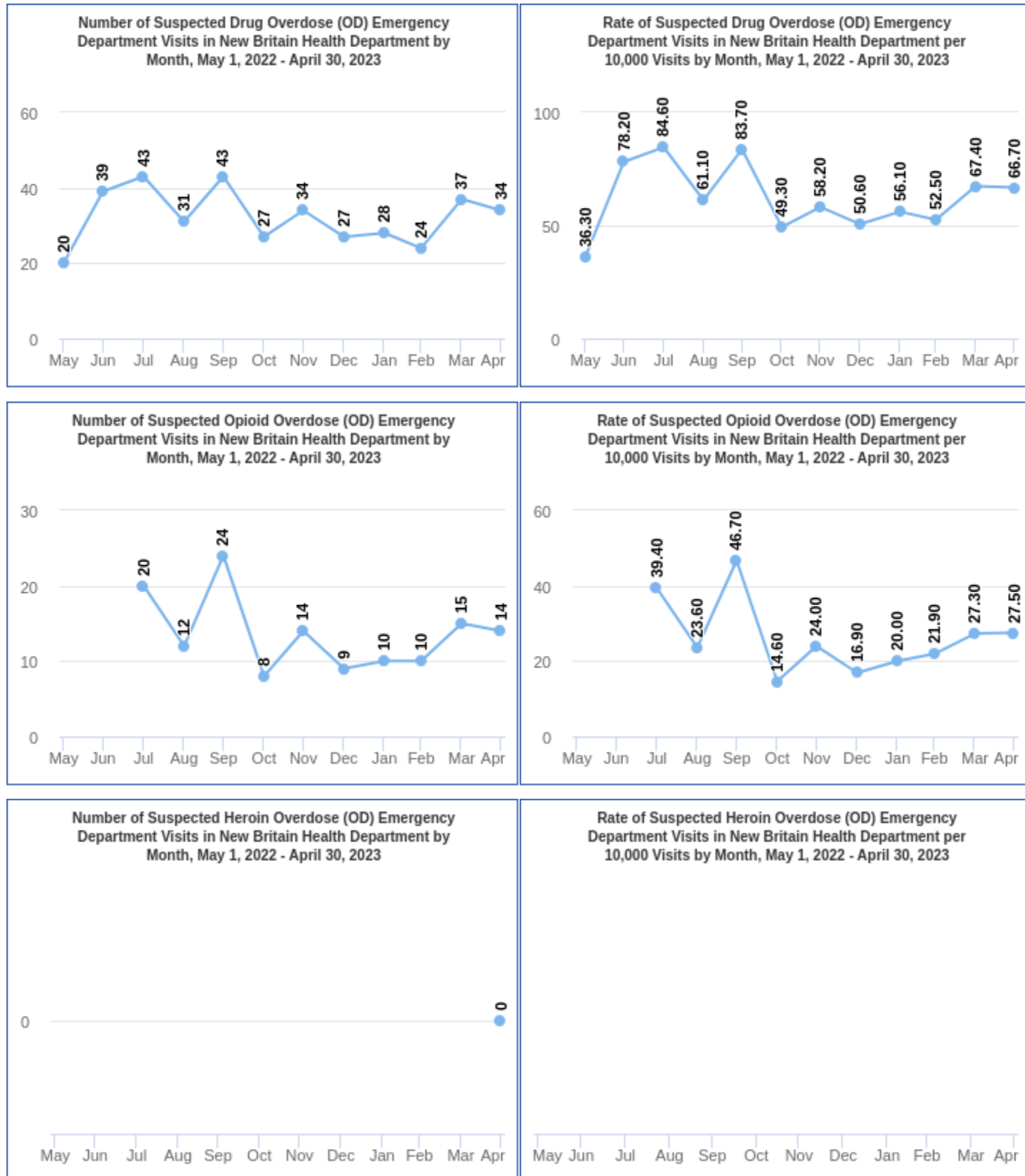

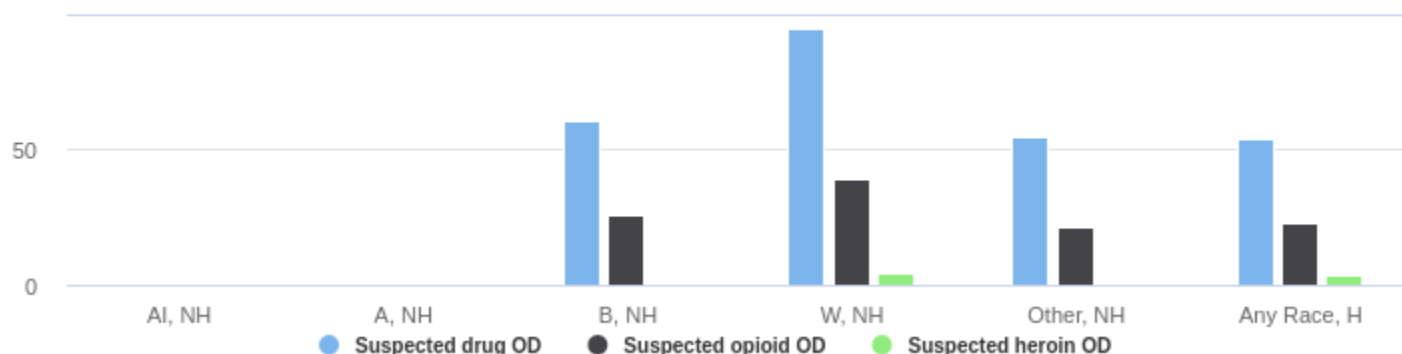

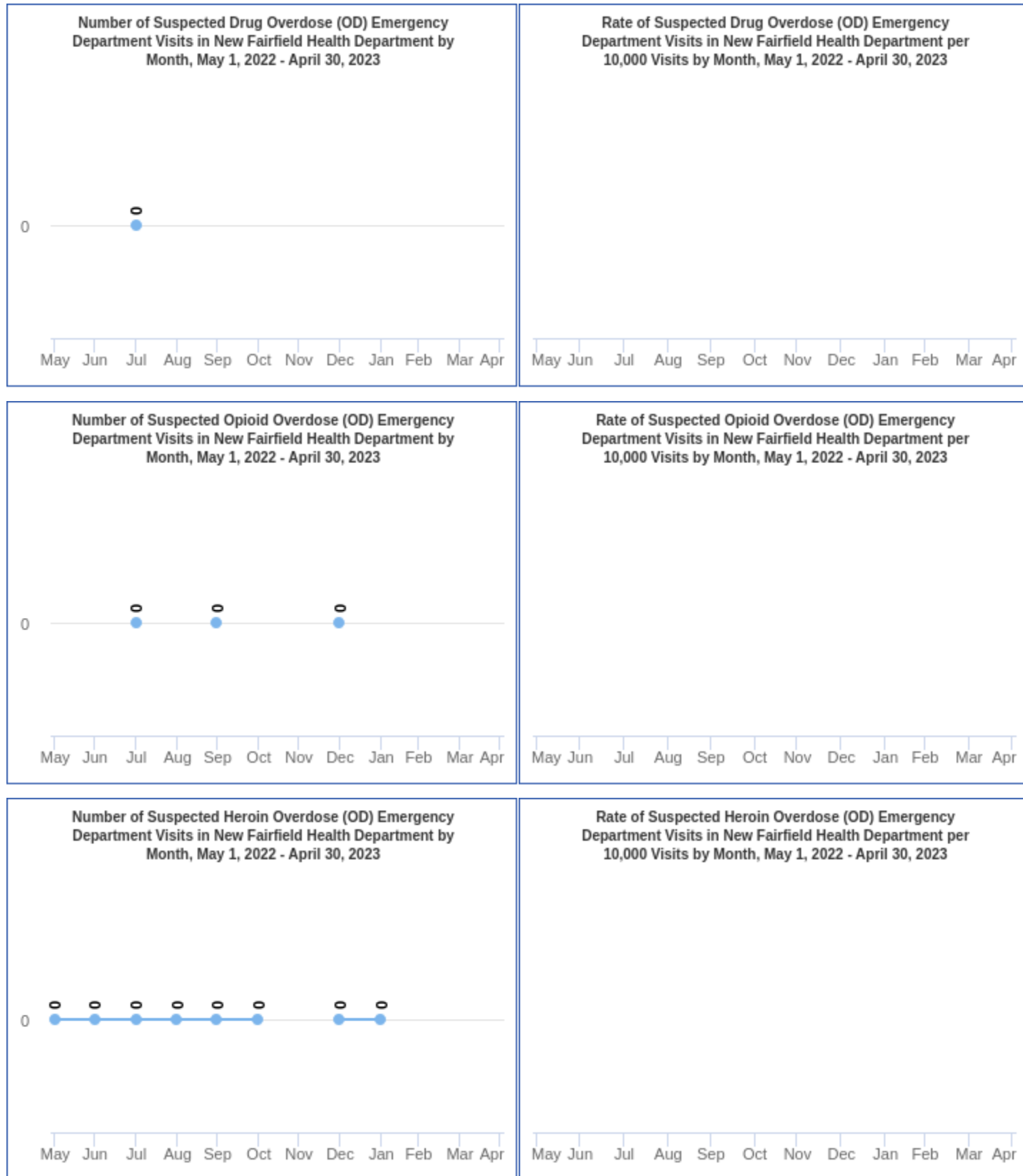

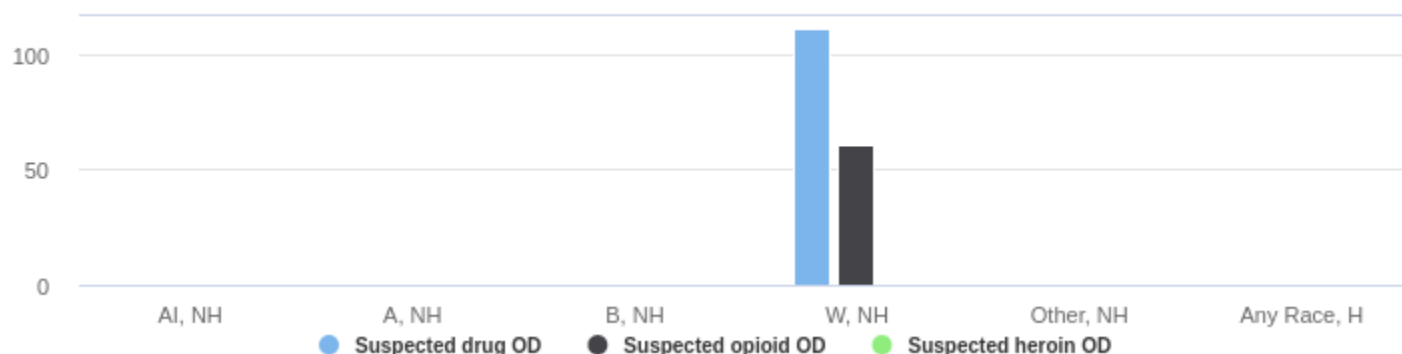

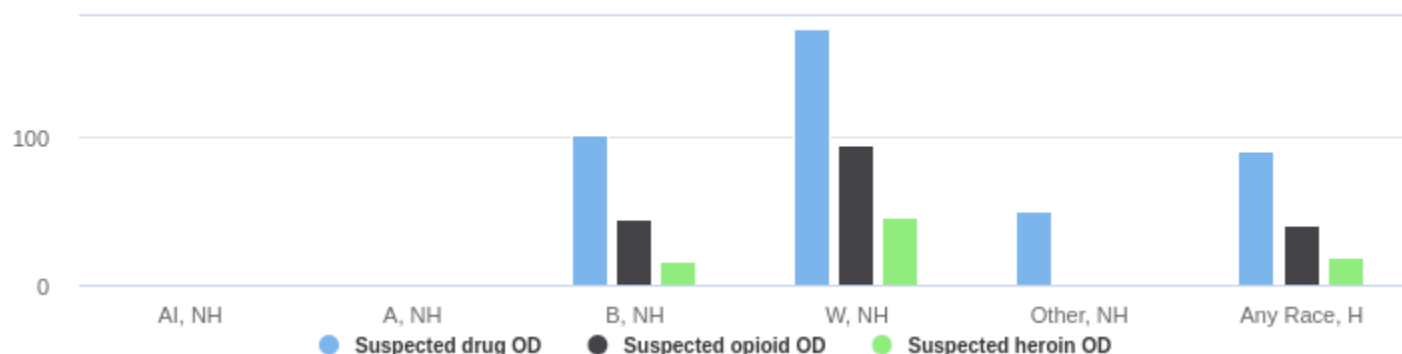

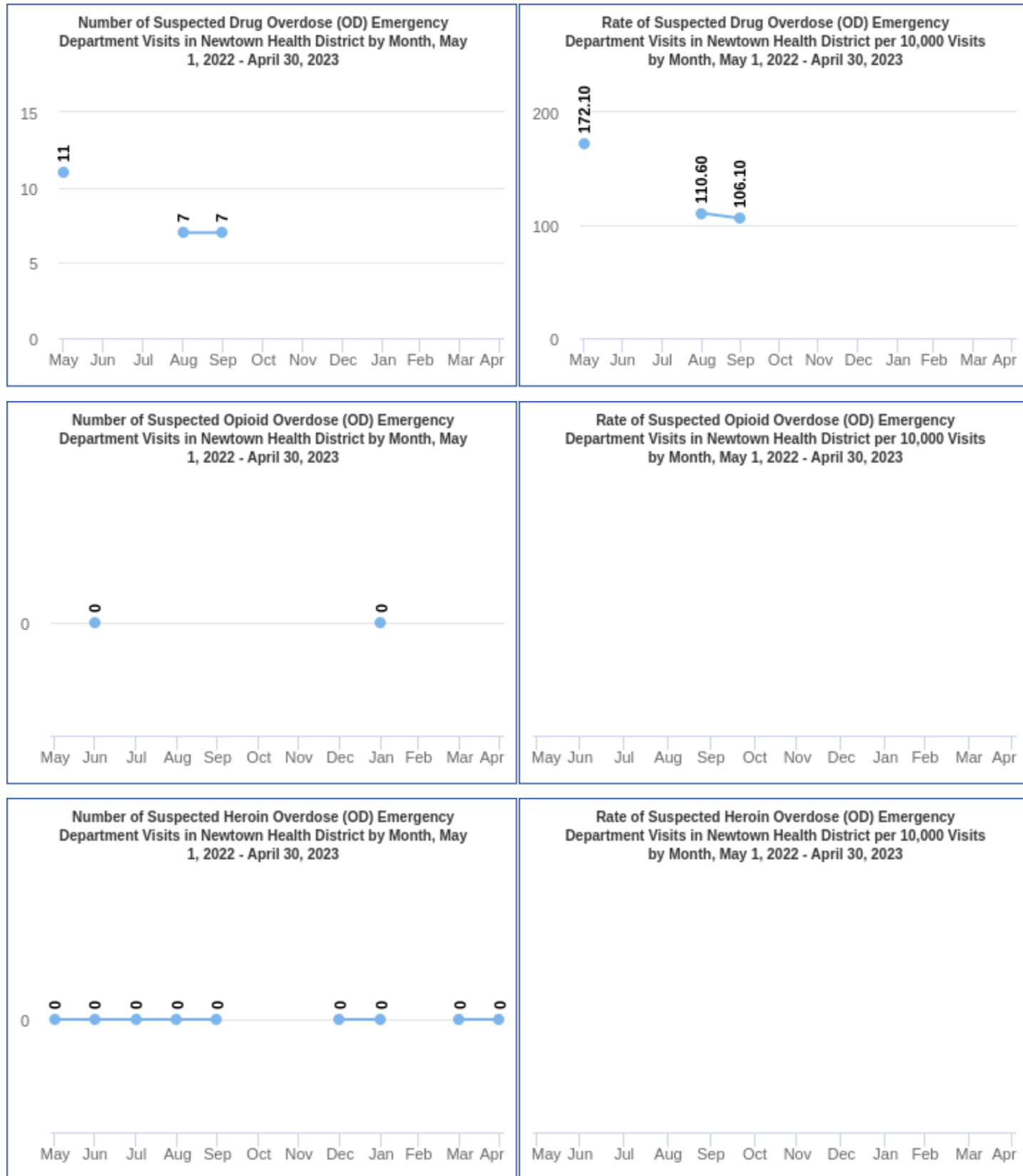

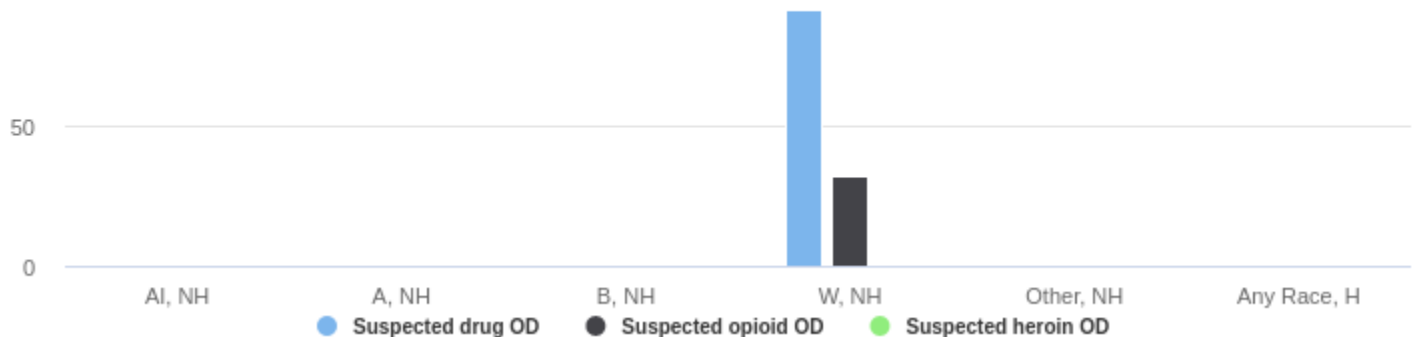

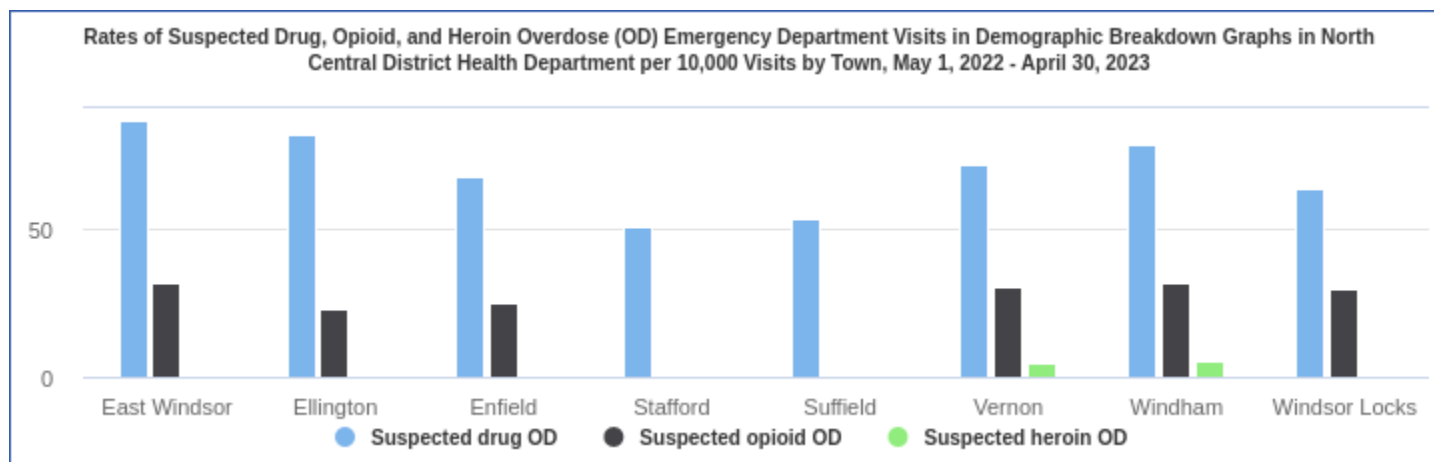
## Suspected Drug Overdose in North Central District Health Department

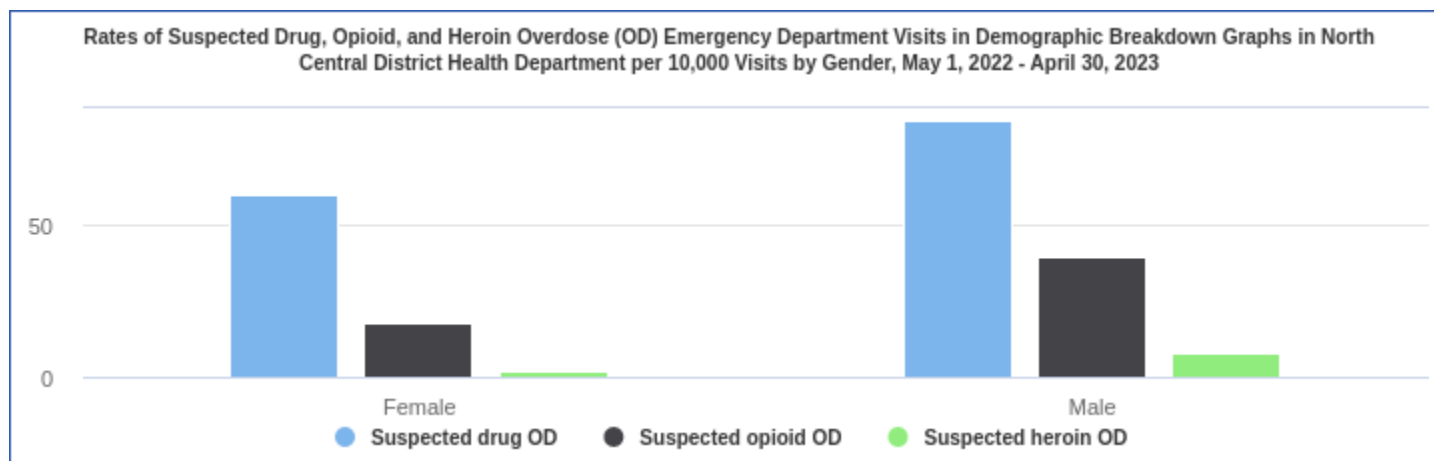

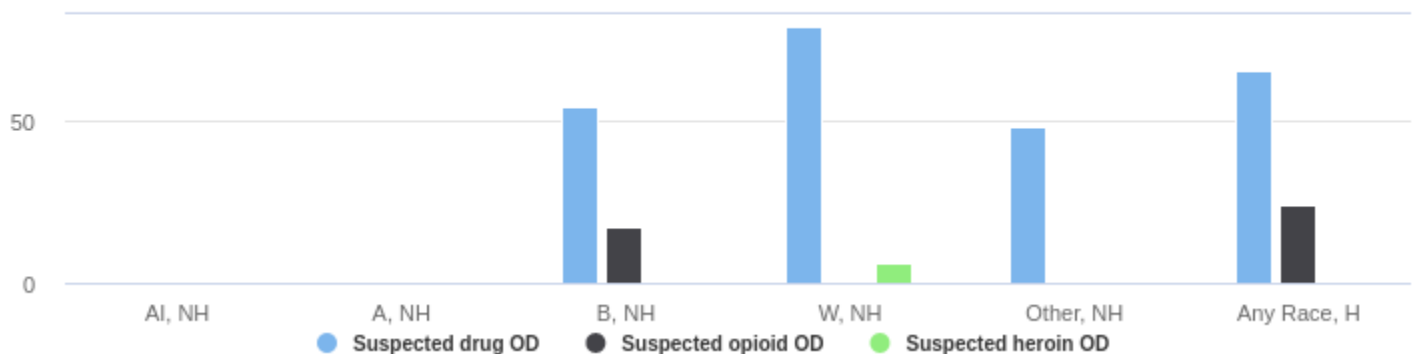

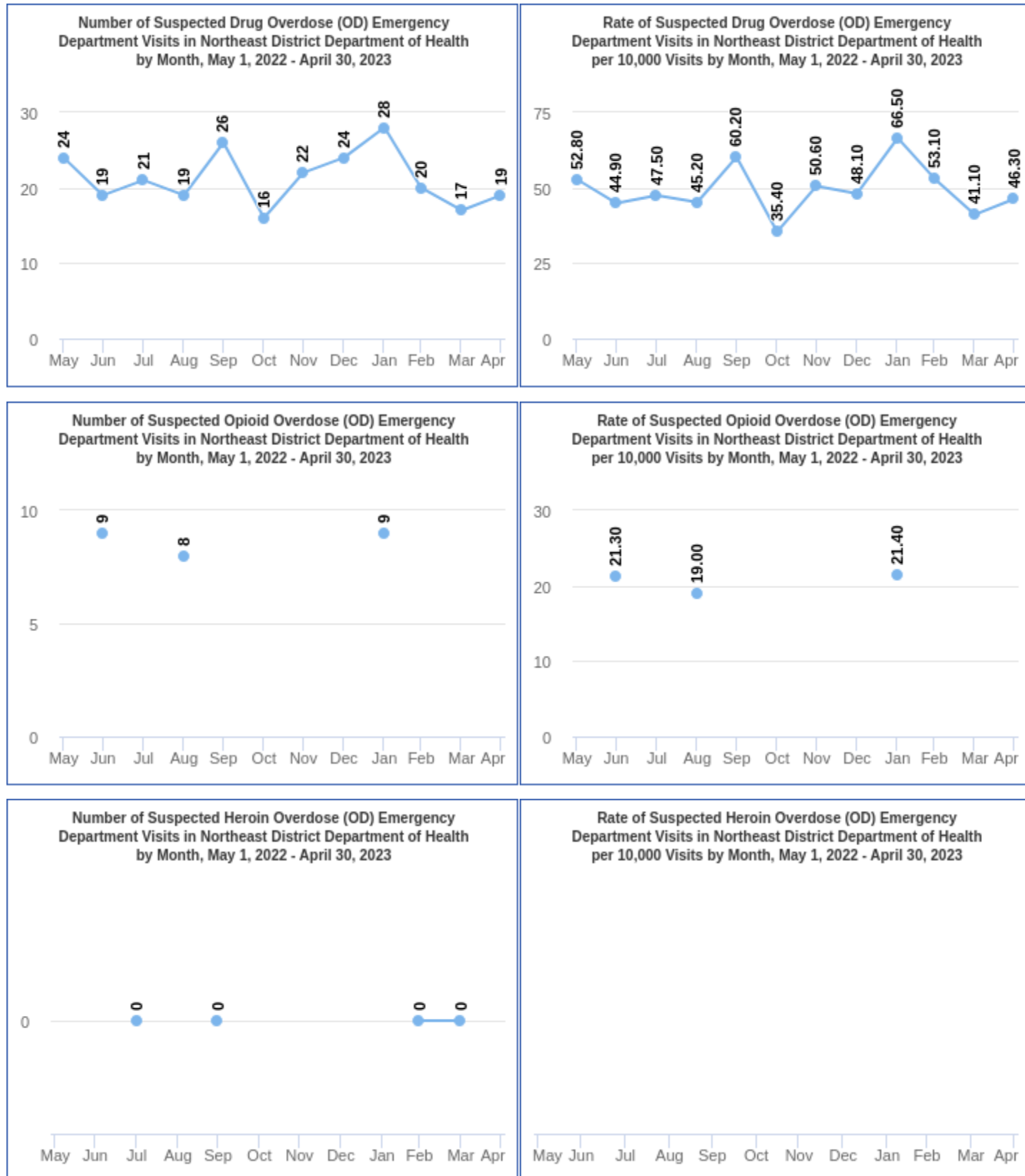

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Northeast District Department of Health



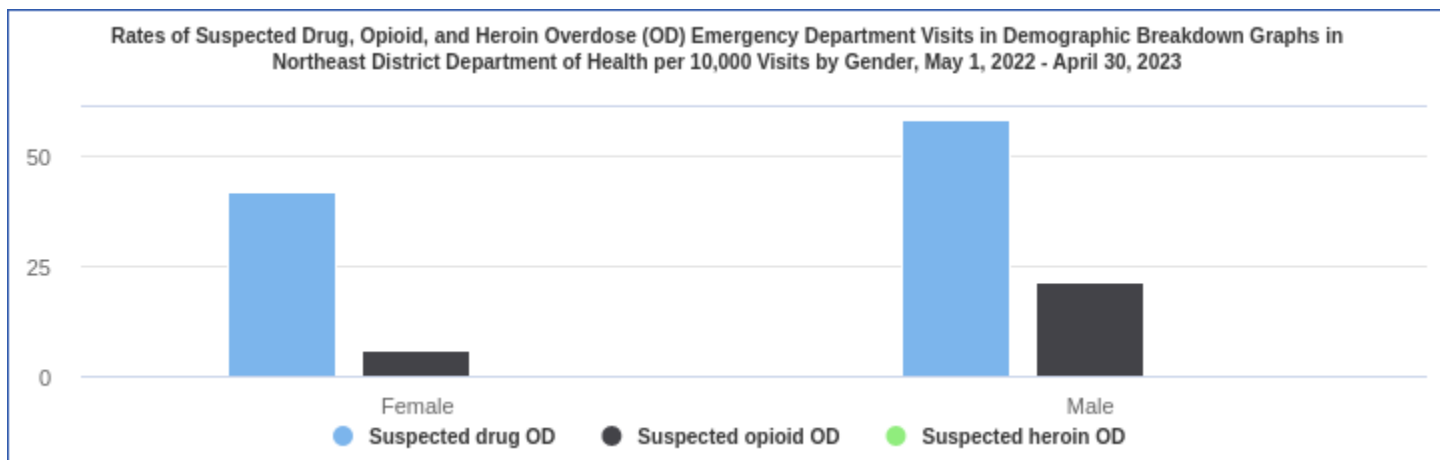

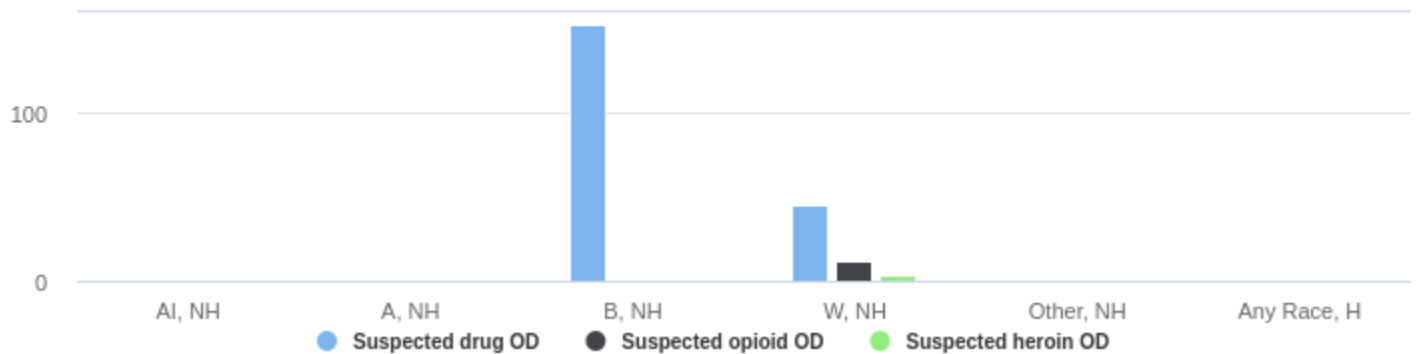

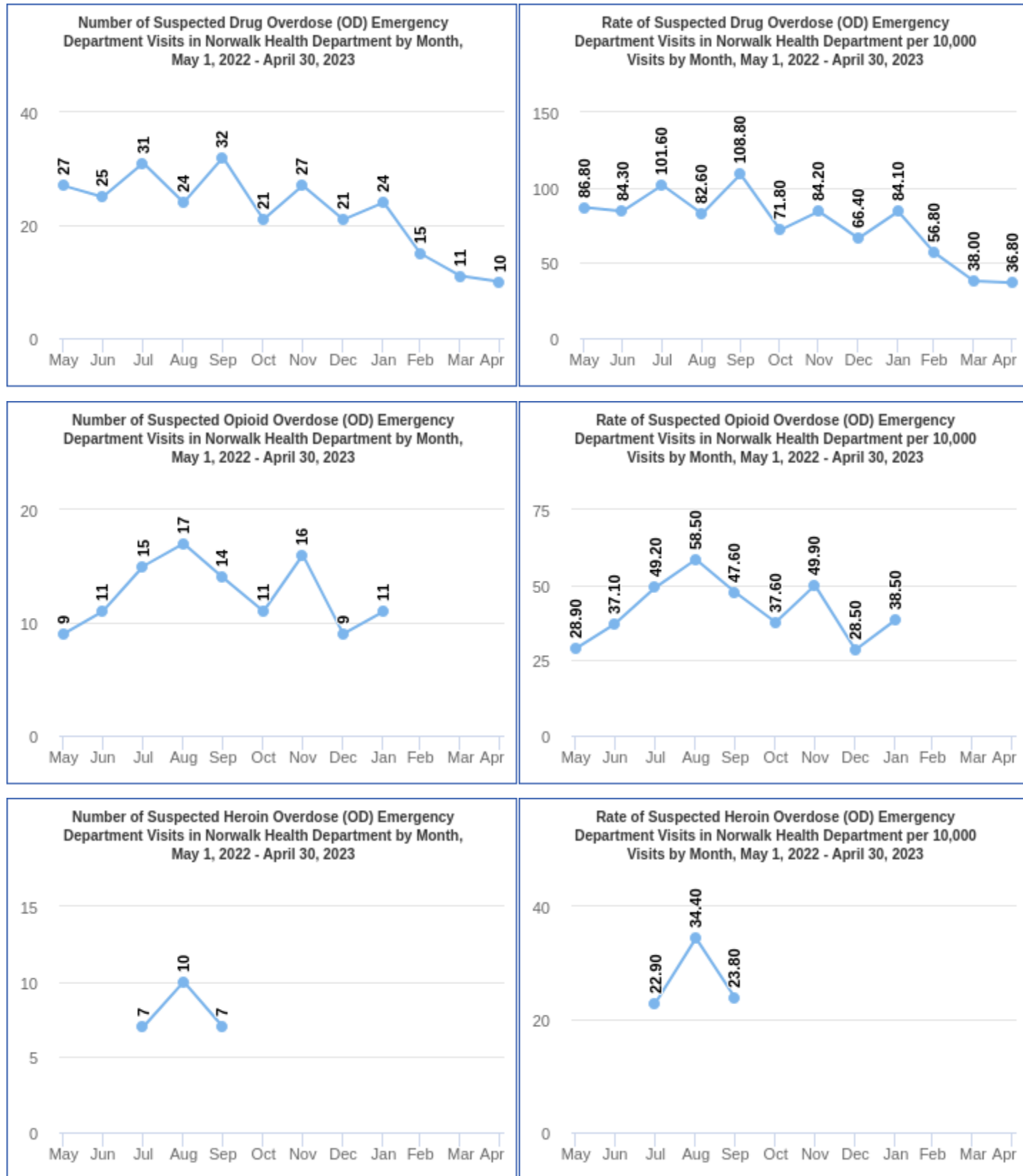

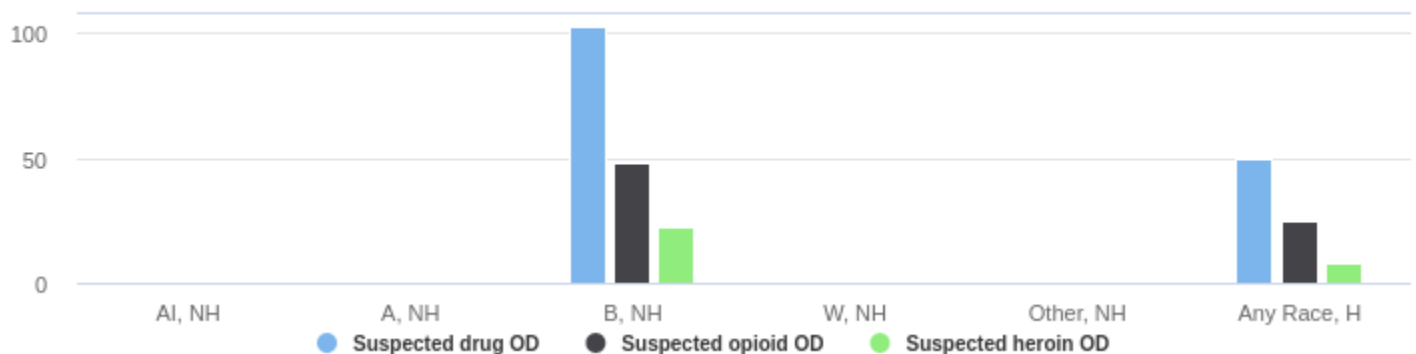

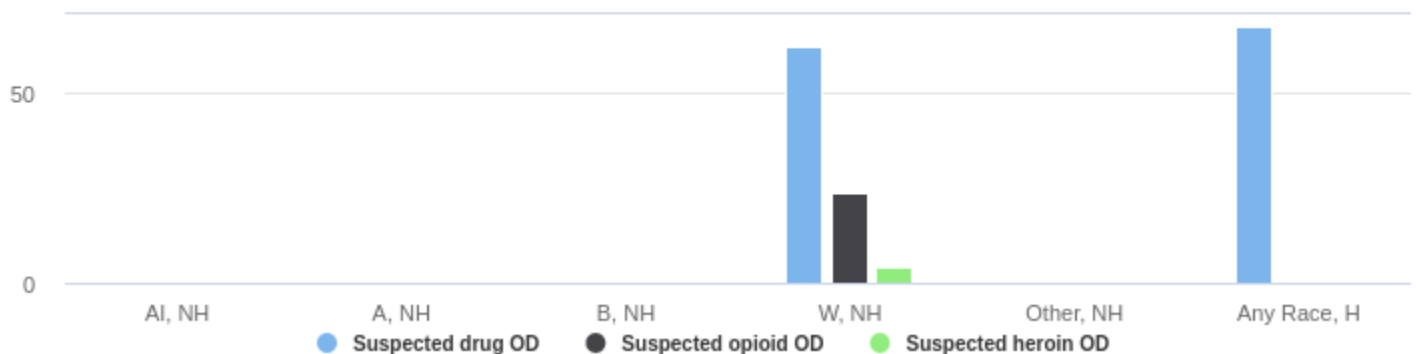

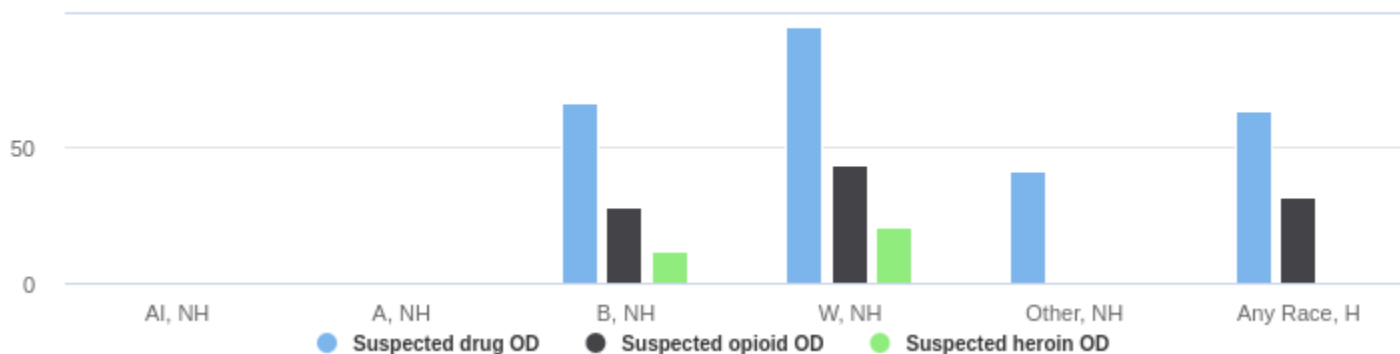

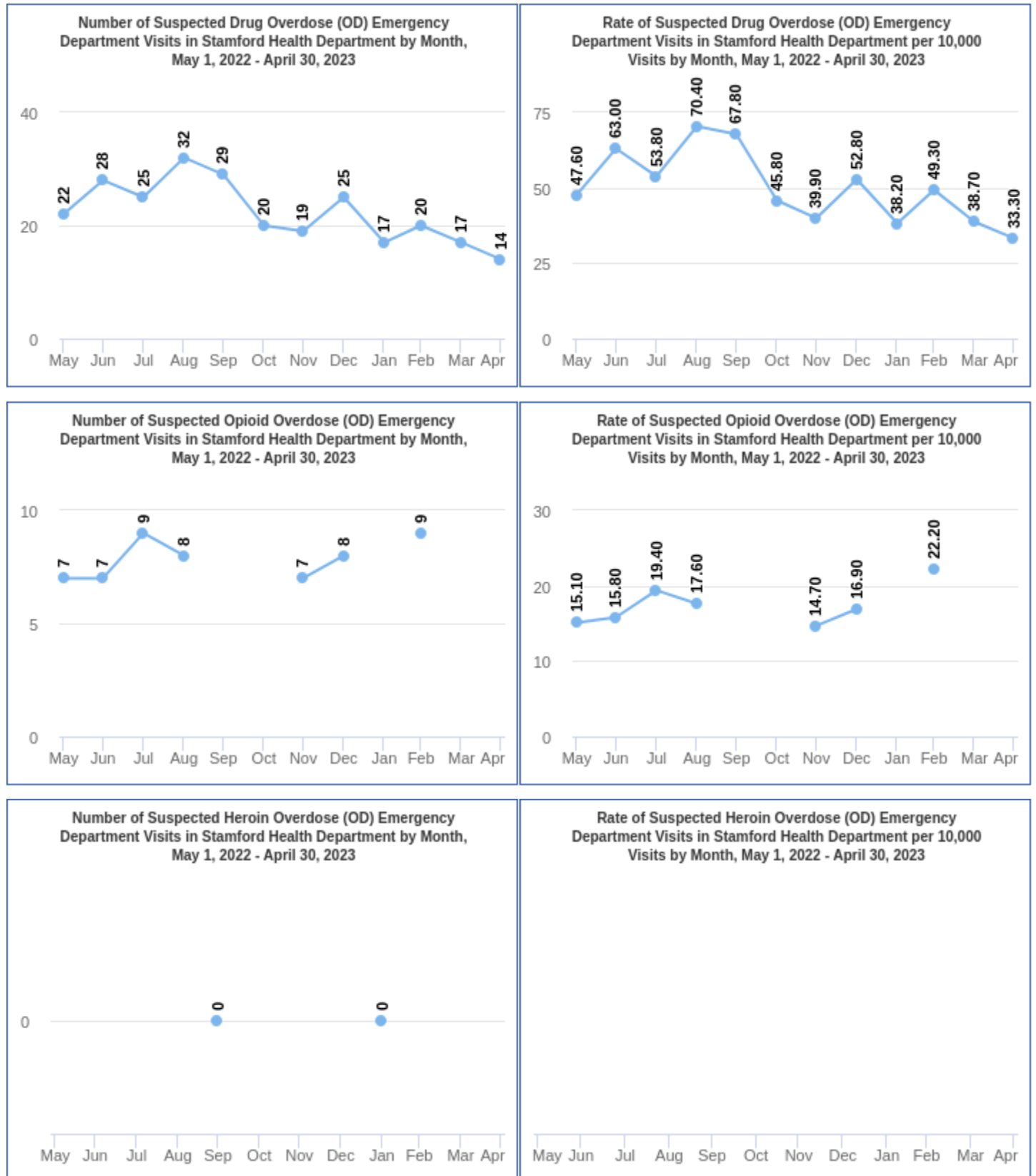

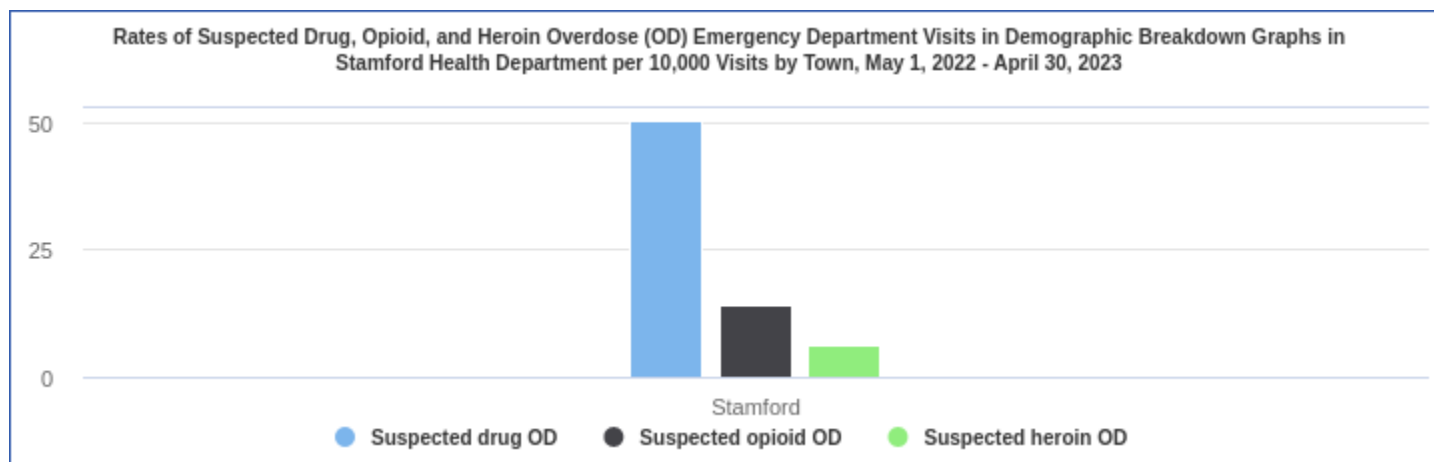

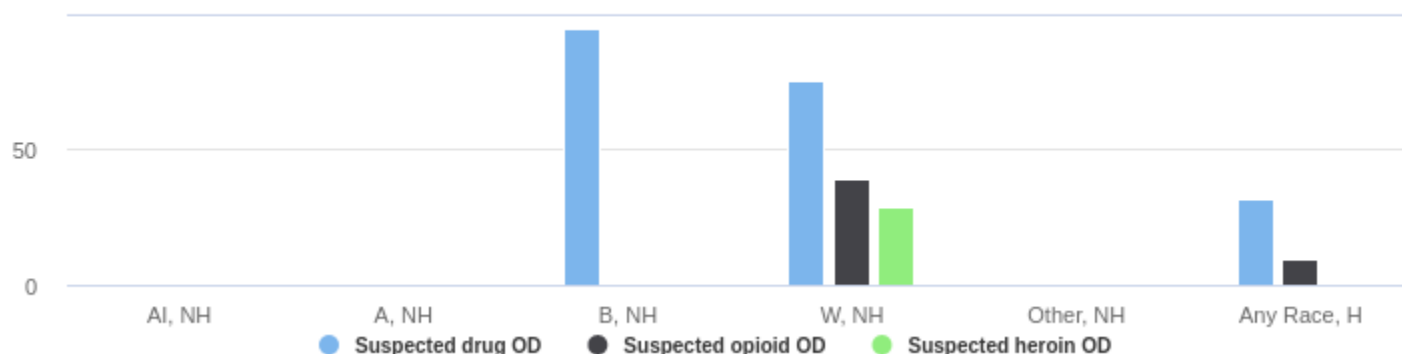

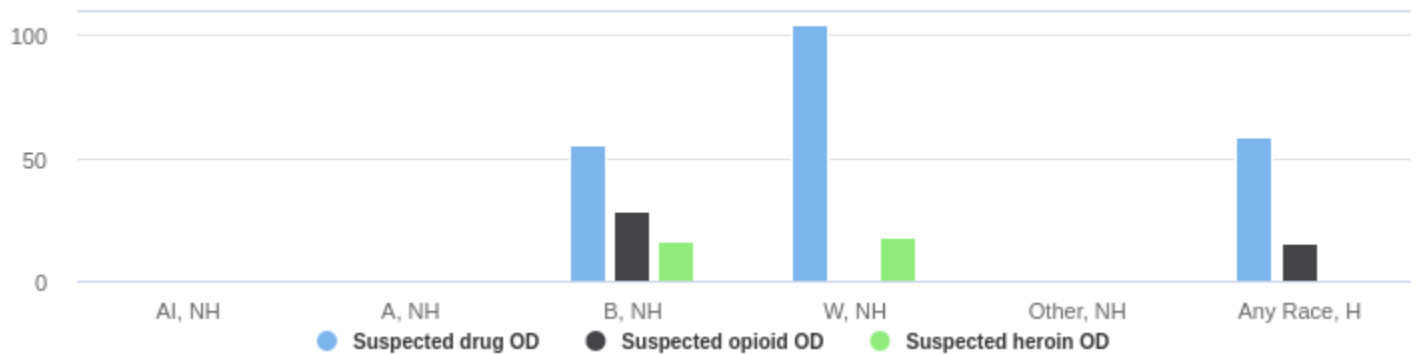

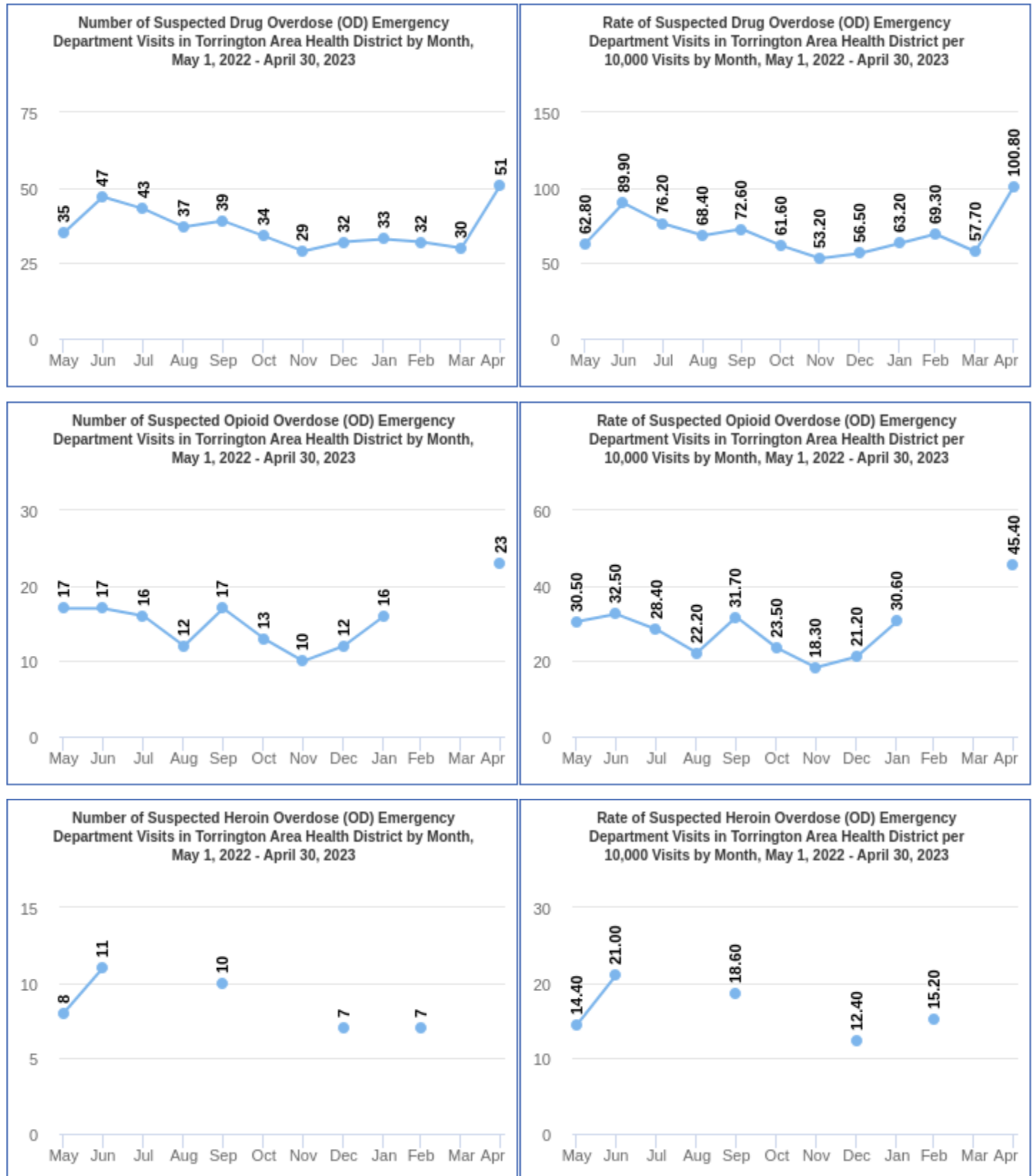

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Torrington Area Health District



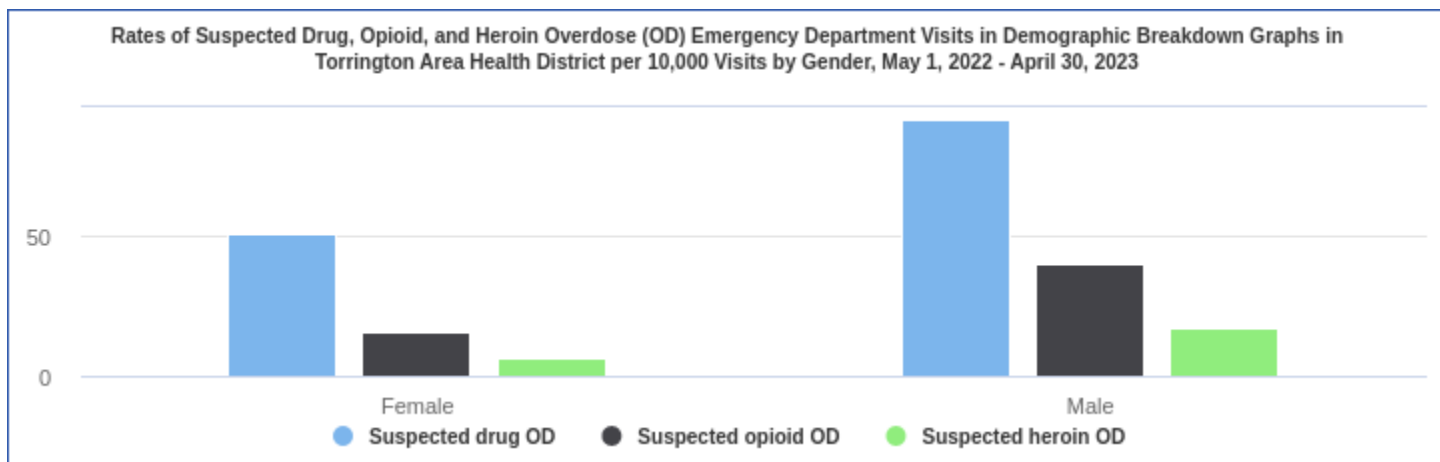

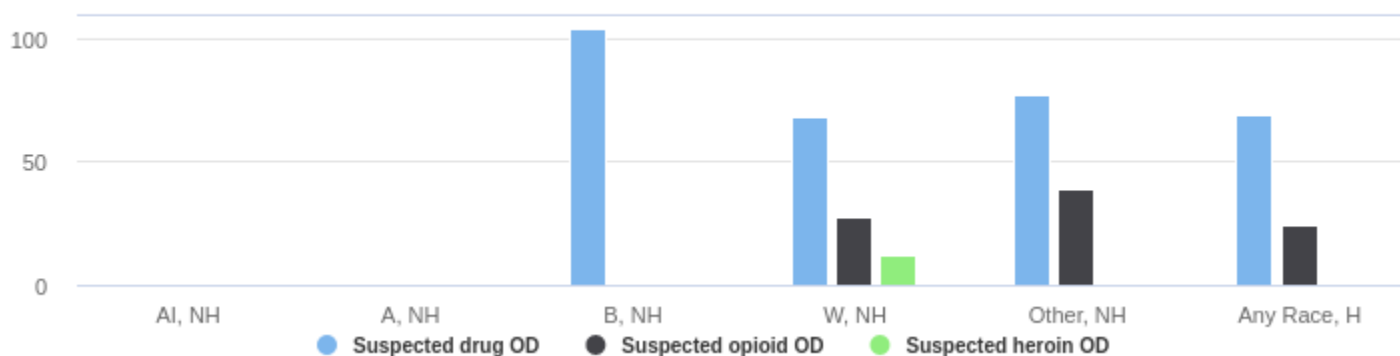

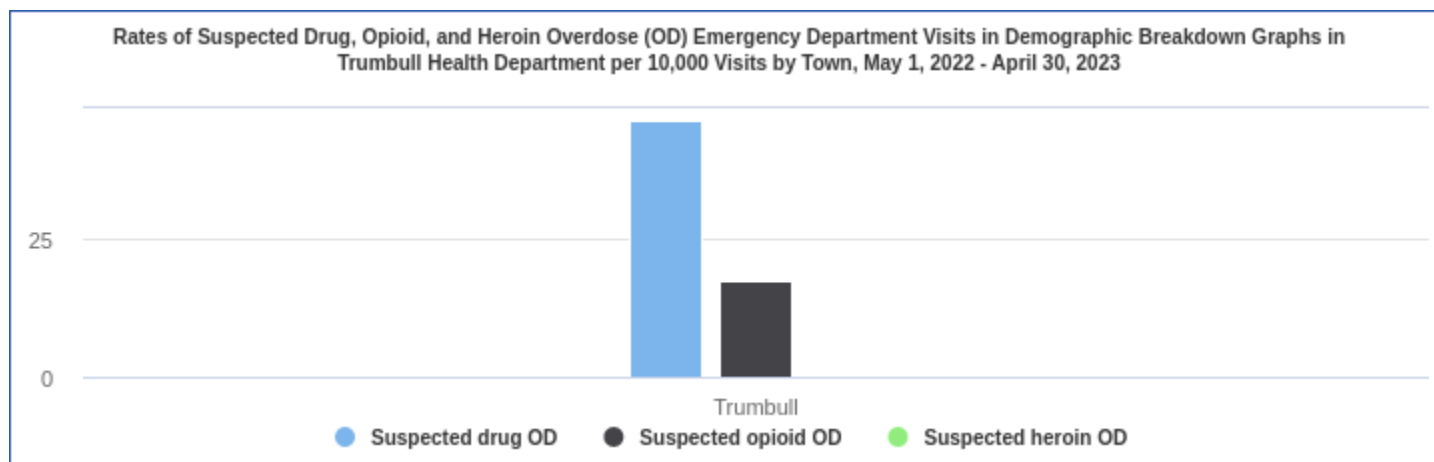

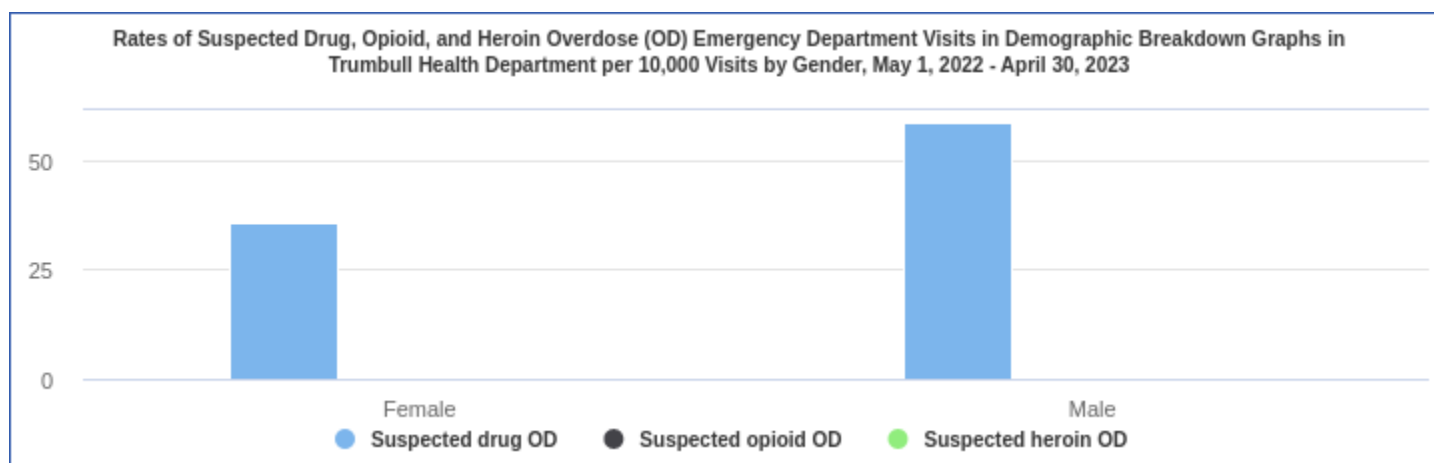

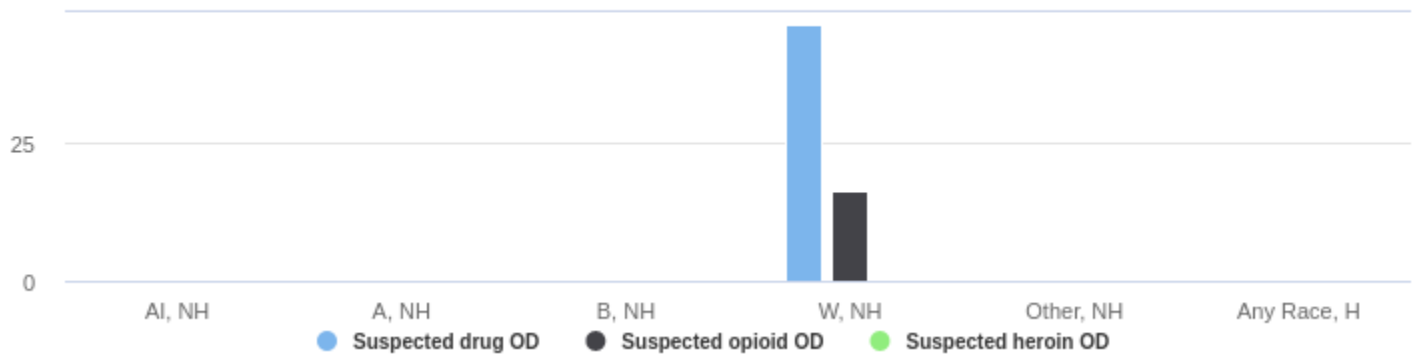

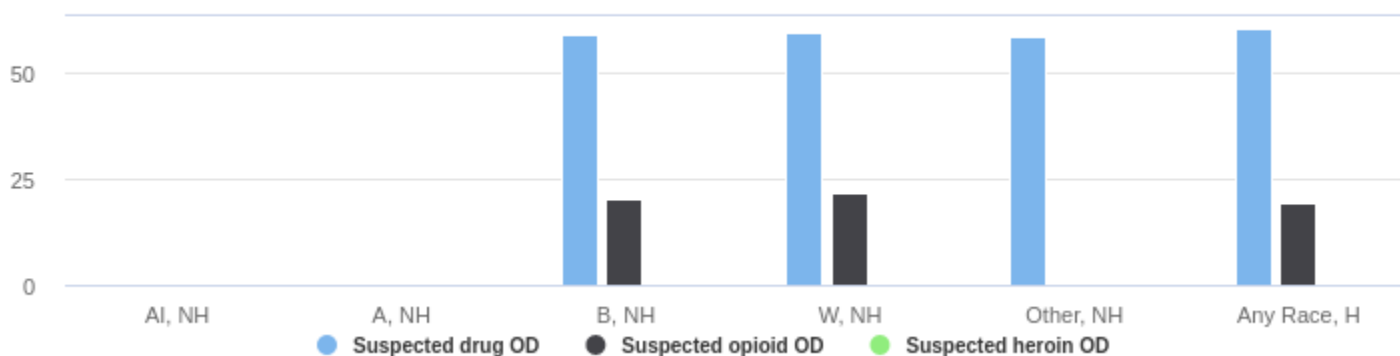

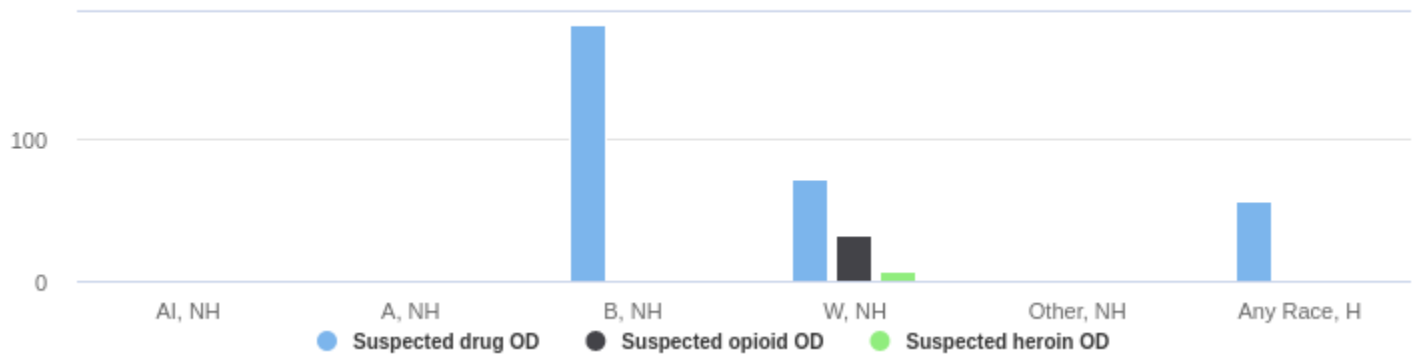

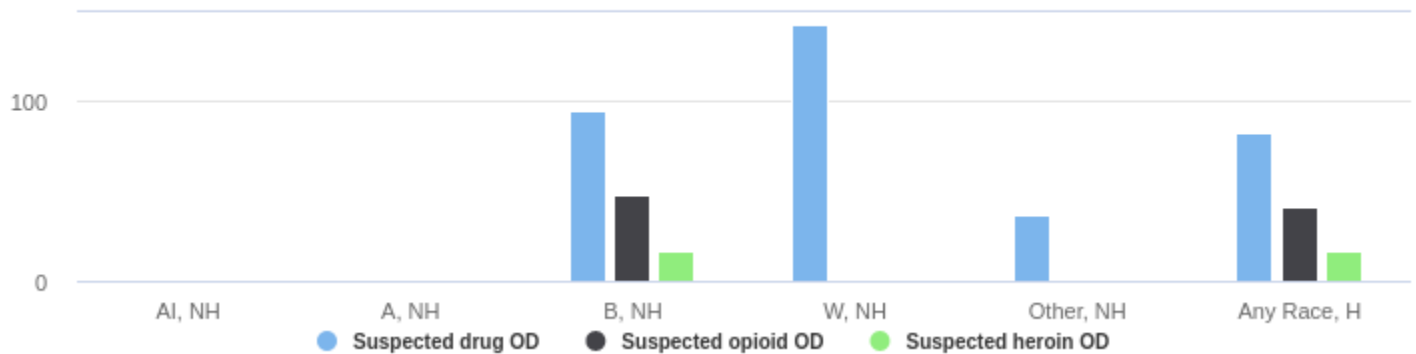

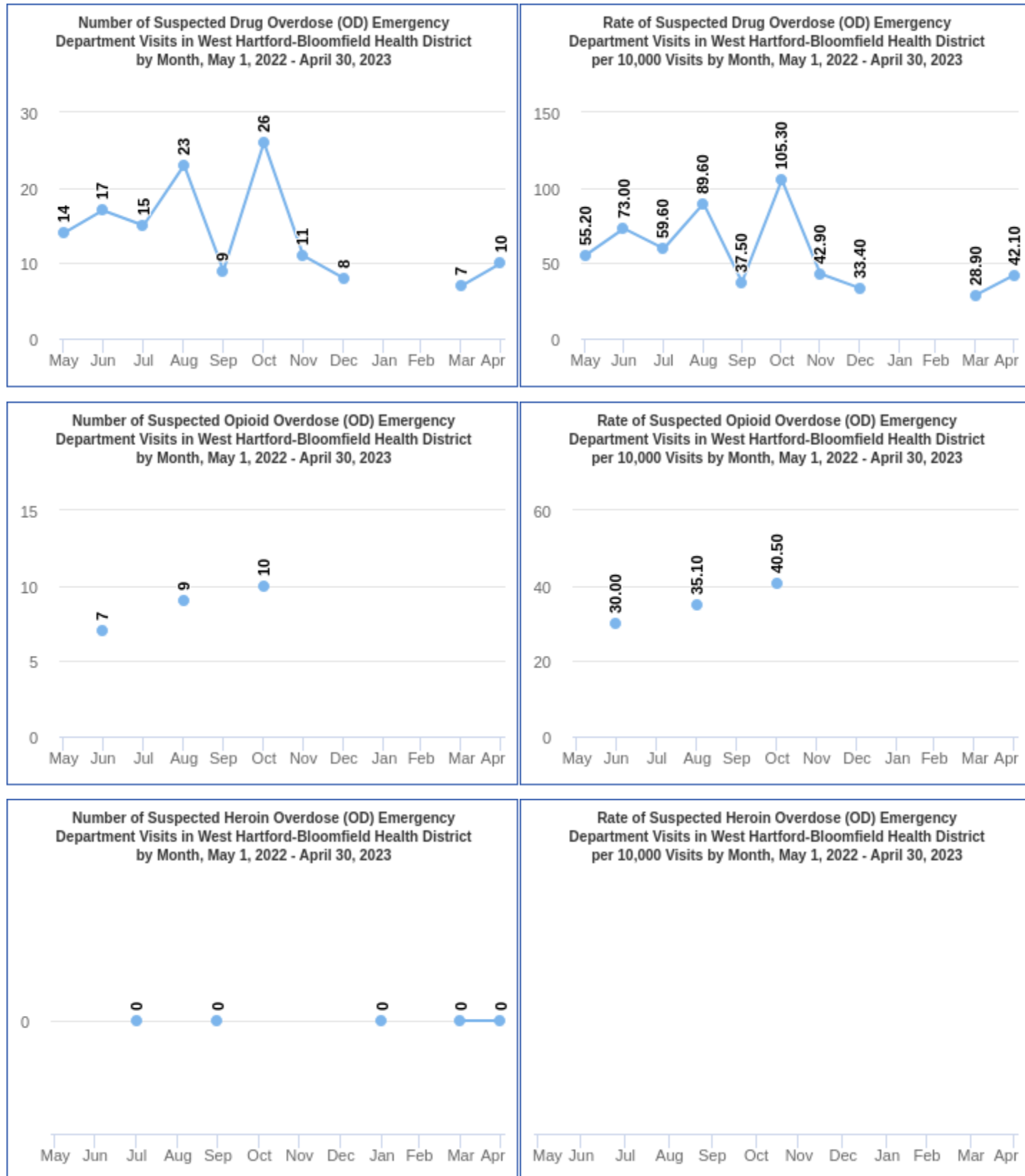

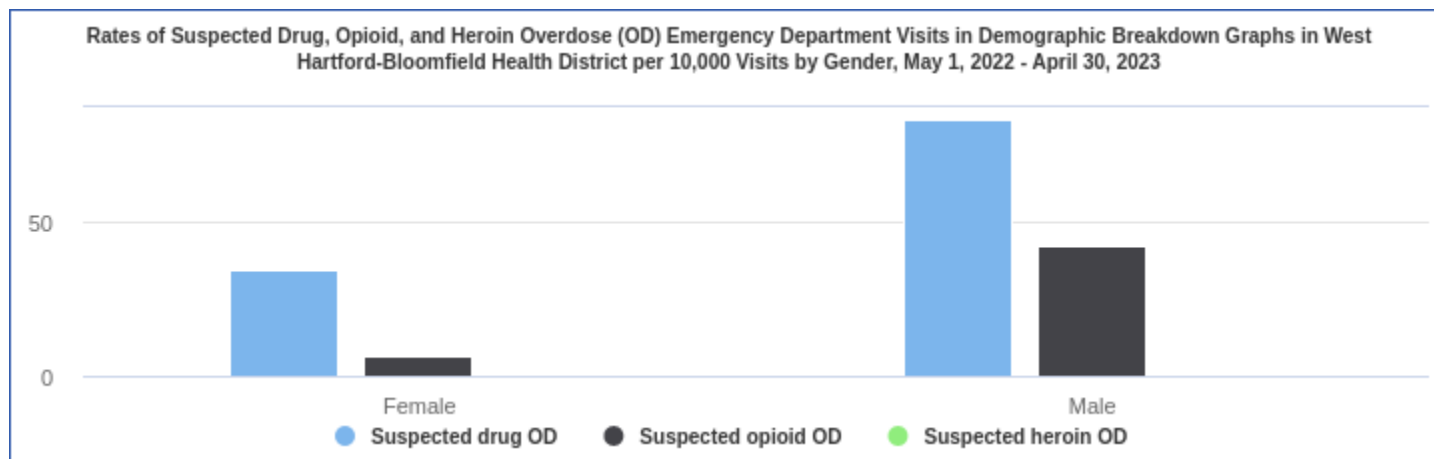

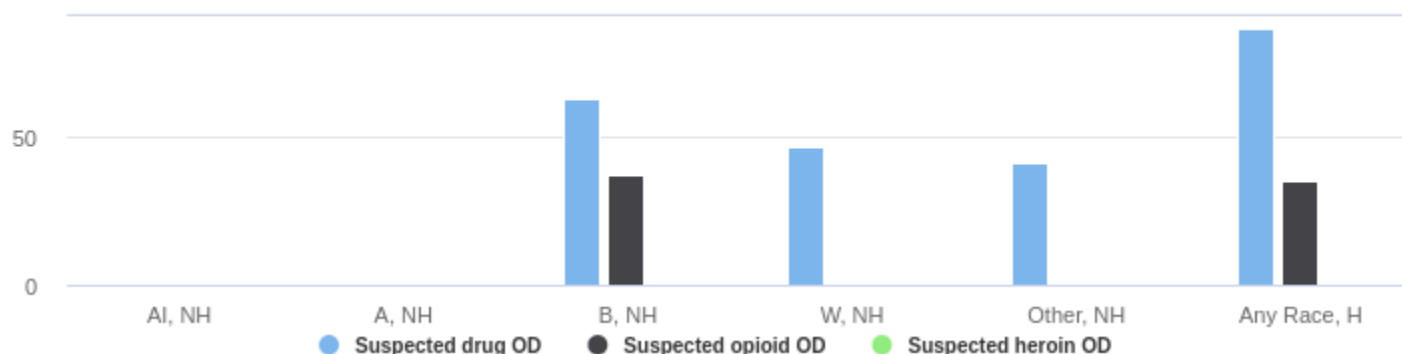

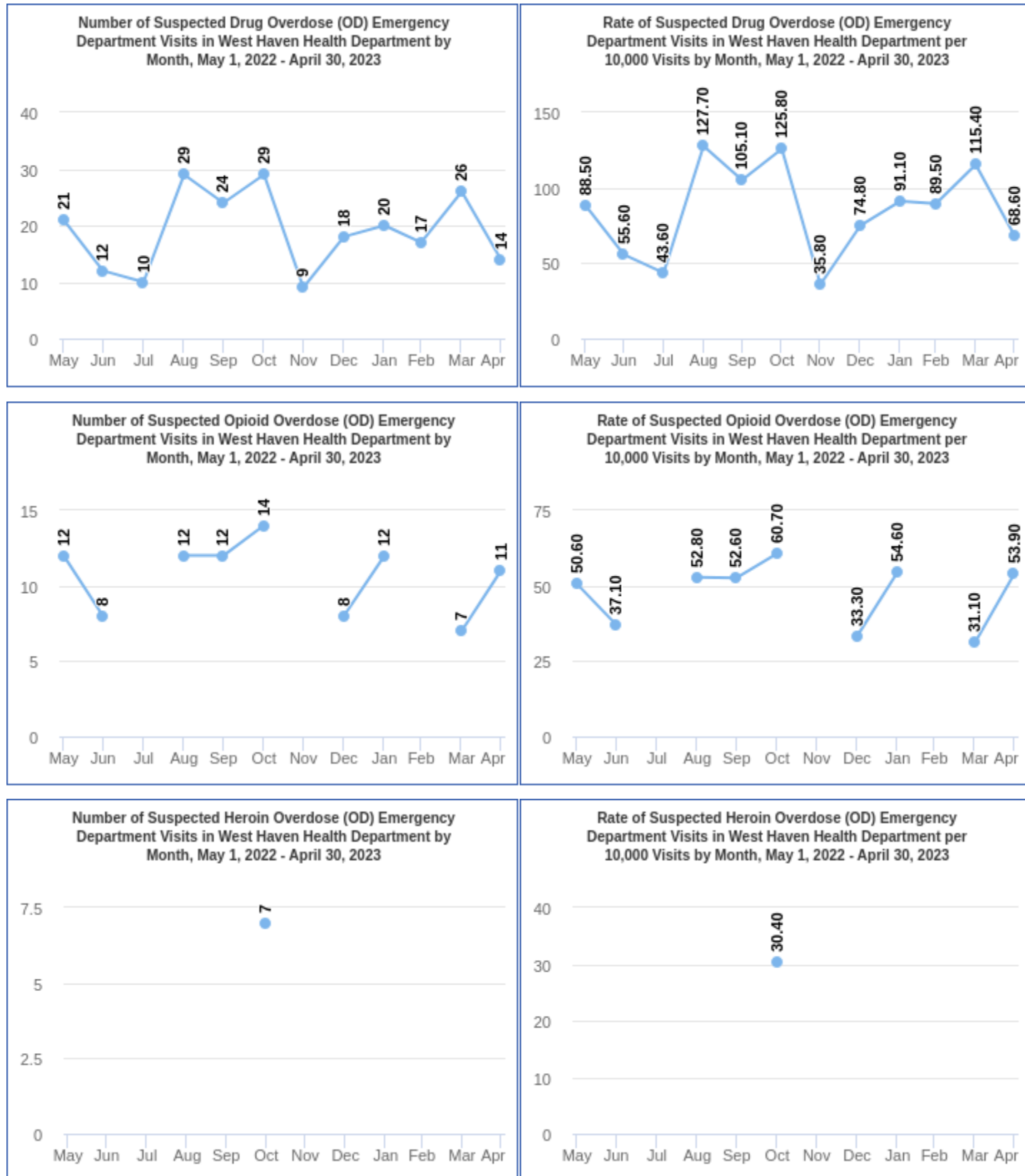

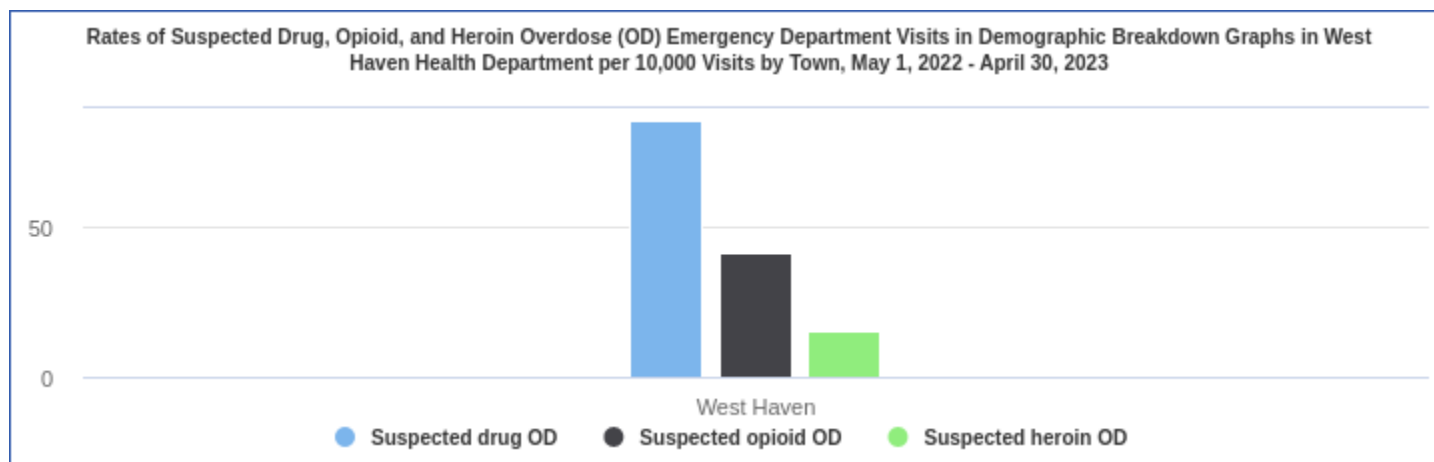

## Suspected Drug Overdose in West Haven Health Department



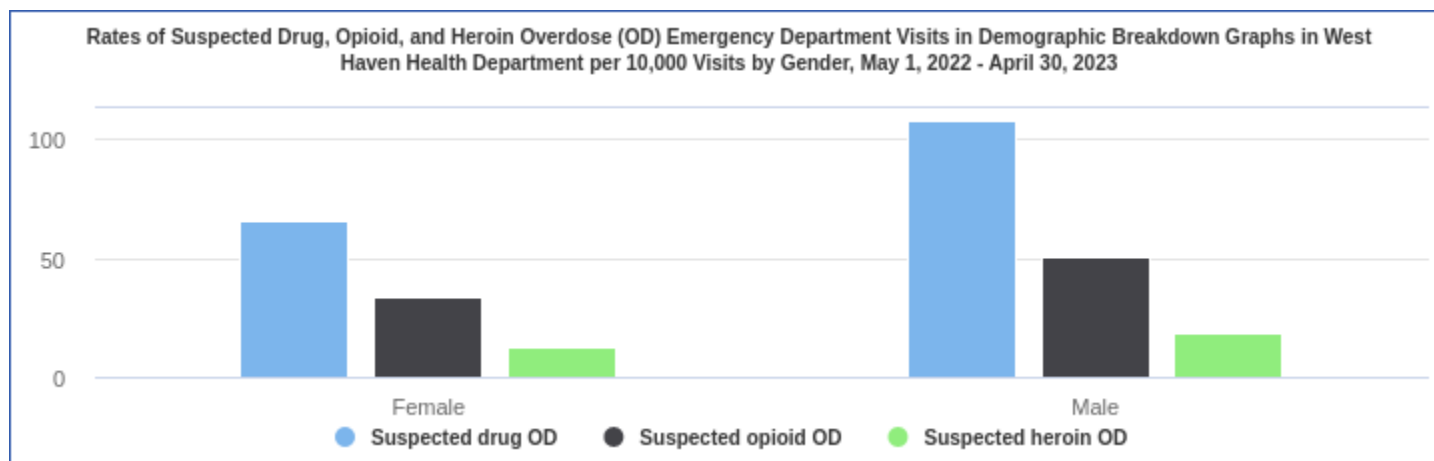

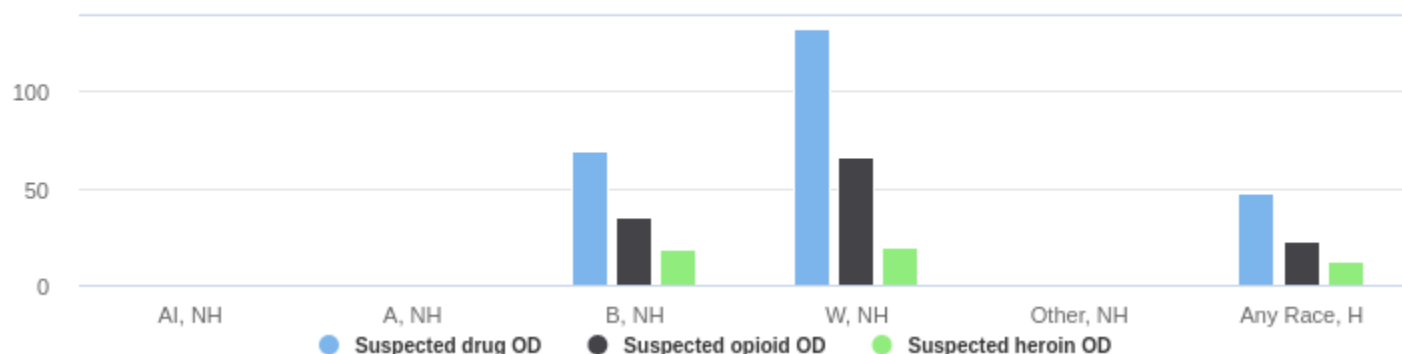

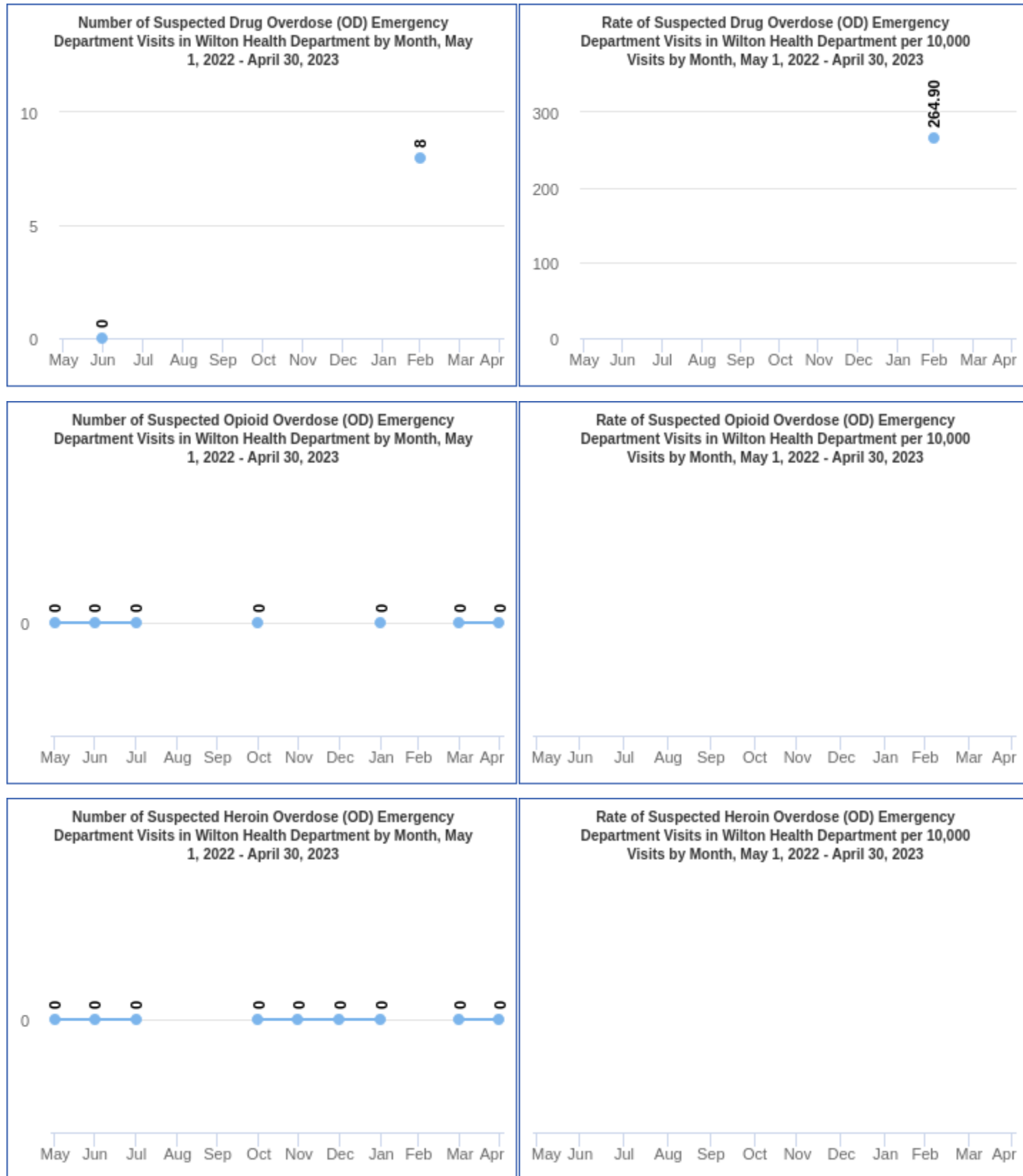

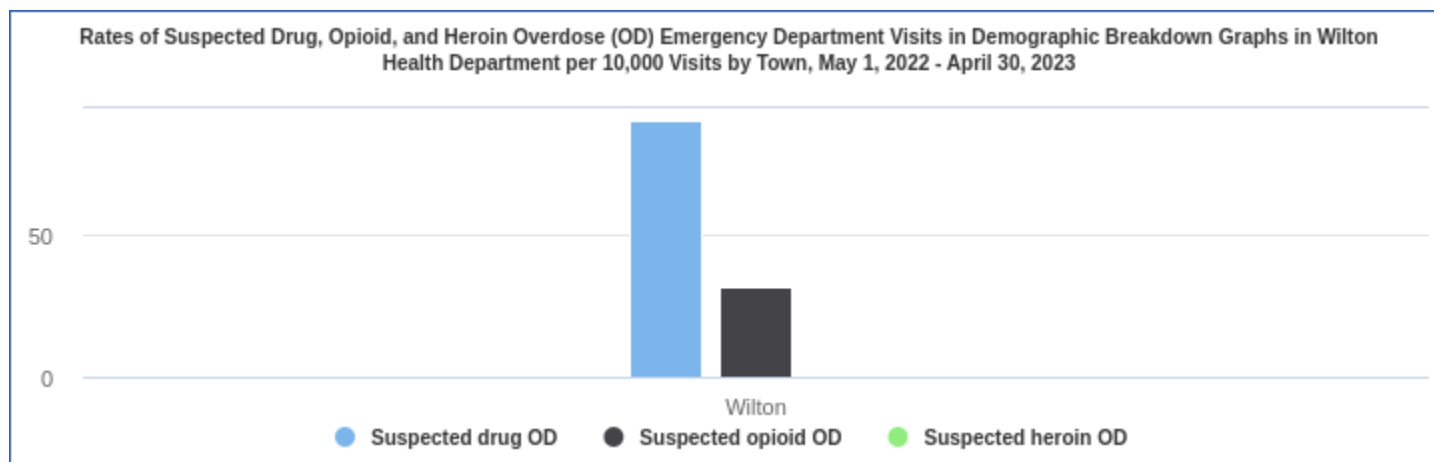

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Wilton Health Department



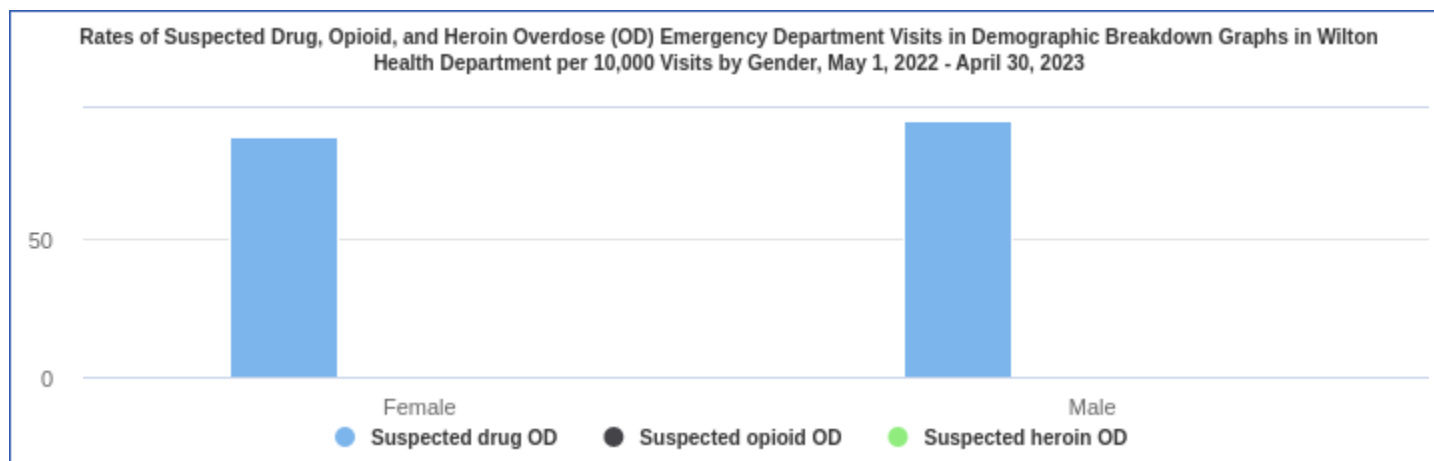

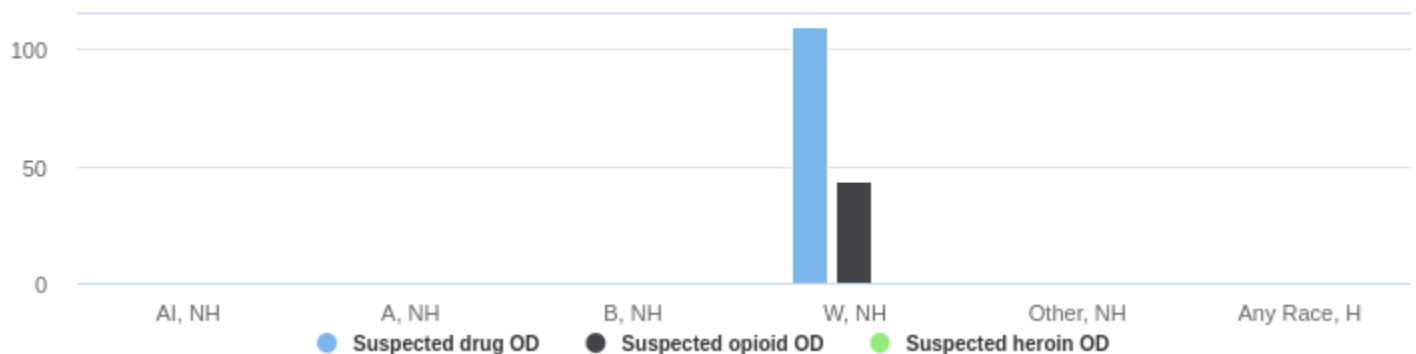

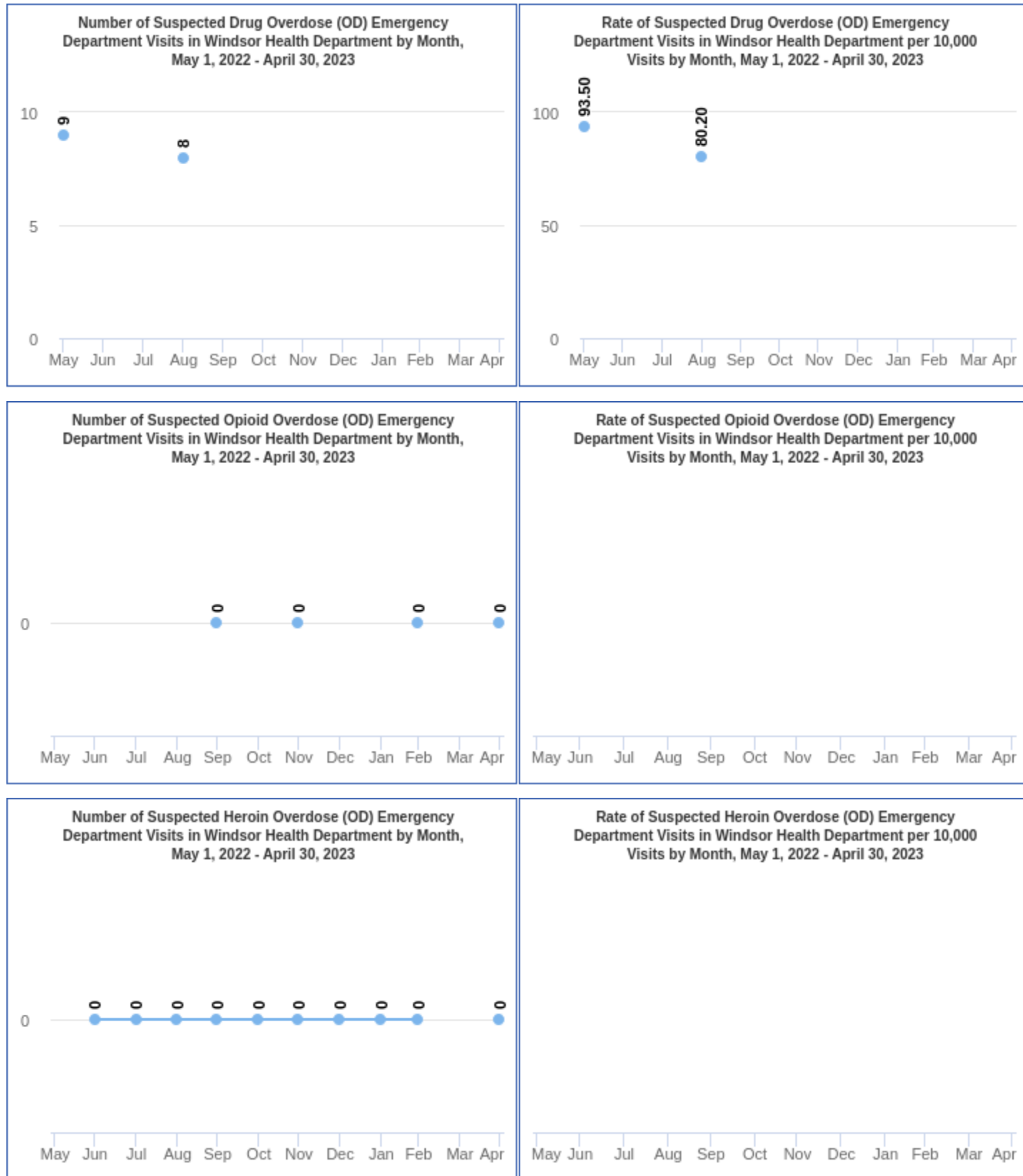

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Windsor Health Department



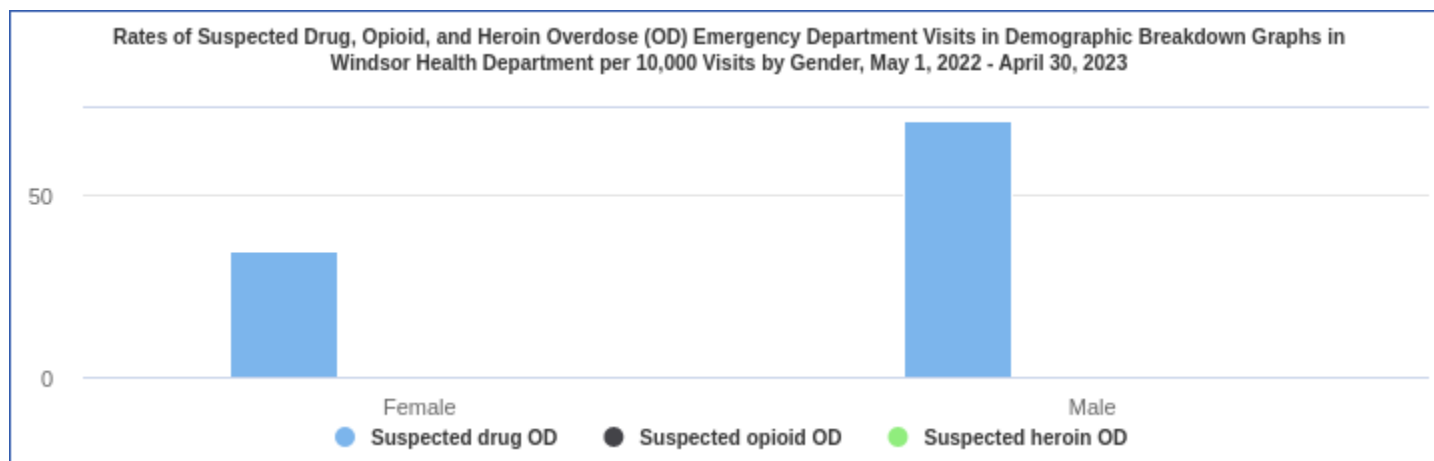

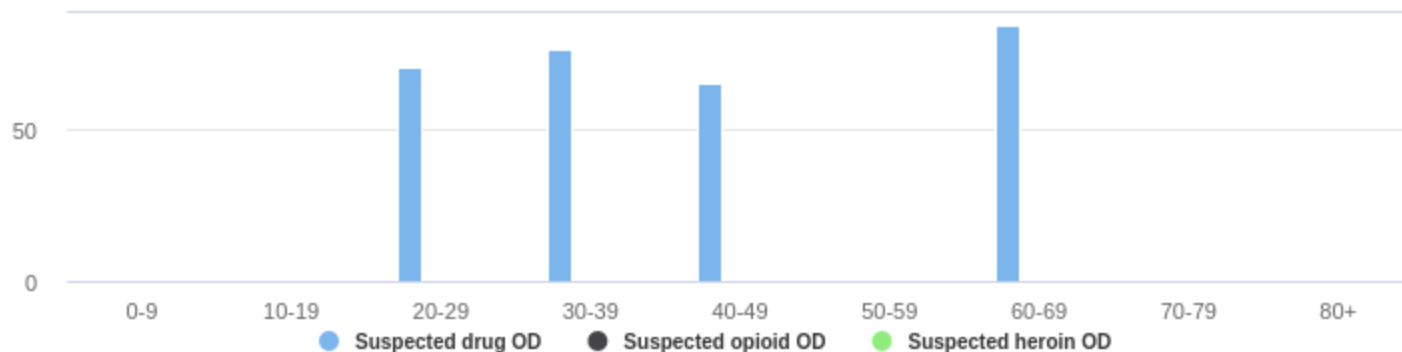

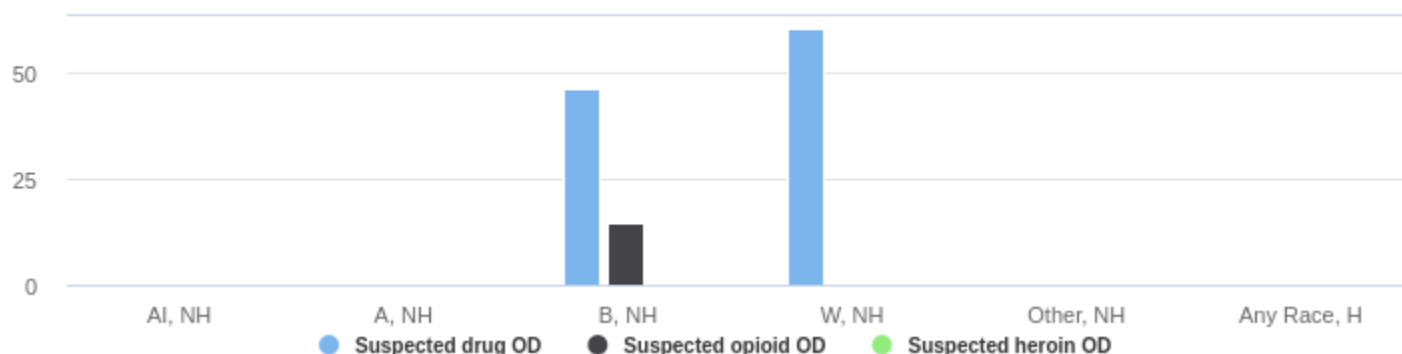
