



# HIV Continuum of Care, Connecticut, 2019



Based on persons receiving HIV care in 2019 among persons ≥13 years old at diagnosis, resided in Connecticut (based on most recent residence) and diagnosed with HIV infection through 2018 and living with HIV on 12/31/2019. A visit is defined as a CD4, viral load, or genotype test result during the evaluation period. The overall HIV population may be overestimated because 2019 deaths are preliminary.
