The Connecticut Department of Energy & Environmental Protection Water Protection & Land Reuse has received the Notice of Hearings regarding the alteration of the boundaries of the public water supply management areas and the priorities for initiation of the Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) planning process established in C.G.S. §§ 25-33f to 25-33h, inclusive.

The Department acknowledges the difficulty of revising established boundaries such as these and all the considerations that go into the revisions. However, we urge a close connection of the public water supply management areas to the major drainage basin divides (Thames River Basin, Connecticut River Basin, and Housatonic River Basin), while respecting town boundaries and public water supply infrastructure.

The Department understands the efficiencies of consolidating down to four areas, however, the issues and concerns between the southern coastal/metropolitan areas of the state and the northwestern and northeastern portions of the state are markedly different. You may wish to consider further dividing the proposed Western Connecticut WUCC into Northwestern and Southwestern, similar to the Northeastern and Southeastern areas.

The Department concurs with the proposed prioritization of the WUCC planning process.
