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DPH/DWS Updates - Certifications

- **Certifications/licenses not renewed by DPH shall not expire throughout the duration of the COVID-19 emergency;**
- **Certifications/licenses suspended by the Commissioner are to be renewed in the six-month period following the date of the resumption of the license renewal requirements;**

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Remote Sanitary Surveys

- **DWS developed a five page remote sanitary survey template**
 - ❖ **First page completed by DWS**
 - ❖ **Last four pages completed by certified operators including pictures of critical components**
 - ❖ **Submit completed document to DWS within two weeks**
 - ❖ **Follow up as necessary by DWS and issue sanitary survey report**
- **Start pilot program this week with 26 small water systems and 10 certified operators, DWS will be looking for feedback**
- **Roll out to rest of small PWSs late June**
- **Working separately on template for larger PWSs, plan similar pilot program with larger PWSs sometime in late June**

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






Tracking per State Drought Plan

- ❖ Statewide Percent full is 98.54%
- ❖ Statewide Percent of Normal is 102%

- 18 Reservoir Systems are reporting 100% Full (-3 from previous week, 13 trending ↓)
- 31 Systems are reporting capacities greater than or equal to 100% of Normal (-3 from previous week)
- Current Conditions : 30 day % of Normal Precipitation indicates dryness conditions in CT:



- Stream flows also indicate drying conditions.
- June Precipitation outlook looks

WEBEOC & CtWARN

- **WEBEOC Update**

- ❖ 89 entities/managers representing a total of 243 CWSs have logged in to WEBEOC (represents 2.7 million out of 3.1 million served by CWSs or 90%)
- ❖ 27 entities with log in credentials have not reported yet in WEBEOC
- ❖ All reports are for normal operation so far
