## Motion by Aquarion Water Company to Consolidate Exclusive Service Areas in Brookfield

## Whereas:

Aquarion Water Company (AWC) recently acquired the assets of the Brookfield Water Company (BWC) and the Rural Water Company (RWC),

Upon these acquisitions AWC inherited the Exclusive Service Areas (ESA's) assigned to these entities..

The two AWC-owned ESA's in Brookfield are contiguous,

As contiguous ESA's owned by the same entity there is no need to distinguish between them and they are effectively one ESA,

The Housatonic Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) ESA map found on the Department of Public Health (DPH) website

at: <a href="http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking\_water/pdf/hous.pdf">http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking\_water/pdf/hous.pdf</a> should therefore be updated to remove the boundary line between the former BWC and RWC ESAs.

CGS Section 25-33g(b) requires that ESA boundary changes such as a map adjustment involving removal of a boundary line be approved by the appropriate WUCC.

## Now therefore:
