
The South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority (RWA) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments supporting the adoption of the Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) Coordinated System Plan. The RWA is a non-profit corporation that provides our customers with water at a reasonable cost while promoting the preservation of watershed land and aquifers. We provide high-quality water and services to some 430,000 consumers in the Greater New Haven region. The source of this water is a reservoir system that covers about 120 square miles within 24 municipalities.

The RWA supports the WUCC Plan as a critical component for future water planning in Connecticut. I serve as the recording secretary for the Western WUCC section, and several of my RWA colleagues have also served on various committees throughout the process. We've been active participants by providing assistance, data, and comments during the development for the Western and Central section WUCC plans.
