

What was the patient’s Chief Complaint? Was it an injury or not an injury? What were your Primary /Secondary Impressions (most significant condition(s) that you treated)?

TIP: Do not just write in the patient care narrative. Across the state, we need to collect information in the fields below. The CT CODE LIST for diagnostic elements includes ways to better code “wastebasket” choices such as “Other”. Final coding submitted to OEMS should follow NEMESIS 3.4.0 or the CT CODE list as below. All records should include a Provider’s primary impression

eSituation.01	Required	Date/Time of Symptom Onset	code pattern	Either an estimated date-time (NEMESIS code pattern) or NEMESIS NOT value
eSituation.02	Required	Possible Injury	NEMESIS CODE	Classifies reason for encounter as either injury or non-injury related
eSituation.03	Recommended	Complaint type	NEMESIS CODE	Primary/Secondary/Other complaint type
eSituation.04	Recommended	Complaint (patient or history provider)	\$1-255	Text or NEMESIS NOT value
eSituation.06	Recommended	Time units of duration of complaint	NEMESIS CODE	Must be present if eSituation.06 (Duration) is completed
eSituation.07	Required	Chief Complaint Anatomic Location	NEMESIS CODE	Must enter CODE or NOT value.
eSituation.08	Required	Chief Complaint Organ System	NEMESIS CODE	Must enter CODE or NOT value.
eSituation.09	Mandatory	Primary Symptom	CT CODE LIST	Must have ICD10 code from CT List. Mandatory if there was a patient
eSituation.10	Required	Other Associated Symptoms	CT CODE LIST	Must have ICD10 code from CT List or enter NEMESIS NOT value; multiple entries
eSituation.11	Mandatory	Provider's Primary Impression	CT CODE LIST	Based on ICD-10-CM diagnostic codes. Mandatory if there was a patient
eSituation.12	Required	Provider's Secondary Impression	CT CODE LIST	NEMESIS NOT value or CT Code list value; multiple entries allowed; ICD-10 based.
eSituation.13	Required	Initial Patient Acuity	NEMESIS CODE	Mandatory for trauma.
eSituation.14	Required	Is illness/injury work-related?	NEMESIS CODE	NEMESIS code or NOT value required

Usage: Indication of when the data element is expected to be collected.

- Mandatory** = Must be completed; does not allow for NOT values
- Required** = Must be completed and allows NOT values
- Recommended** = Does not need to be completed; allows NOT values
- Optional** = Does not need to be completed; does not allow for NOT values

Primary Symptom (eSituation.09) is a single selection.
 Other Associated Symptoms (eSituation.10) can be multiple selections

Primary Impression (eSituation.11) is a single selection.
 Secondary Impression (eSituation.12) can be multiple selections
