Dear Chief Elected Official,

In accordance with Connecticut Public Act 16-43 Section 1 the following information is being requested by State of Connecticut Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS). Public Act 16-43 Section 1 stipulates:

(e) Not later than October 1, 2016, each municipality shall amend its local emergency medical services plan, as described in section 19a-181b, to ensure that the emergency responder, including, but not limited to, emergency medical services personnel, as defined in section 20-206ji, or a resident state trooper, who is likely to be the first person to arrive on the scene of a medical emergency in the municipality is equipped with an opioid antagonist and such person has received training, approved by the Commissioner of Public Health, in the administration of opioid antagonists.
