- Cleaner applications must be completed and submitted to the Department of Public Health (DPH) for entry into the CT exam.
- The cleaner exam is offered 4 times a year at the CT DPH in Hartford, CT.
- Exam time allowed is 1 hour; passing grade is 80 or higher.
- The exam is closed book. No notes or electronic devices may be used during the exam.
- Exam consists of 25 true/false questions.
