DEEP Draft General Permit

- DEEP Draft *General Permit to Discharge from Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems Serving Existing Facilities*: Overview of draft permit by DEEP staff, and question and answer period.

Legislative Proposals

- DPH legislative proposals concerning subsurface sewage disposal matters: 1. Proposed revisions to the SSDS installer & cleaner definitions in CGS Sec. 20-341a to remove the word "regularly" so that it is clear that persons offering their SSDS services to the public must be licensed regardless of whether they do it regularly. 2. Proposes increase in the maximum fine in CGS Sec. 20-3411 from \$100 to \$10,000 that can be pursued against unlicensed individuals engaging in SSDS work. 3. Proposed new language to be added to CGS Sec. 19a-36 concerning PHC regulations and technical standards for household and small commercial subsurface sewage disposal systems.

Draft Circular Letter Concerning Water Supply Well Separation Distance Exceptions

- Draft Circular Letter distributed as attachment for discussion about limited (septic tank or leaching system only) SSDS repairs, and about submission requirements.
