Subject: Extension of Groundwater Monitoring Period

In accordance with Public Health Code Section 19-13-B103d(e)(2), this program hereby extends this past wet season groundwater monitoring period. The May 31, 2003 cut-off date has been extended to June 30, 2003 for the 2003 wet season monitoring period. Groundwater levels were near their maximum levels in June in much of the State due to above normal rainfall during last spring. As such, local health departments can take into consideration monitoring data collected between February 1, 2003 and June 30, 2003.

Local Health Departments can request professional engineers prepare reports on groundwater conditions on lots that wet season monitoring was required. These reports should take into account the data available in the Water-Resources Conditions report prepared by the U.S. Geological Survey as discussed in last year's June 12, 2002 DEH Circular Letter #2002-25 on groundwater monitoring/drought issues.
