SUBJECT: KHS America Recalls Children's Musical Instrument Due to Lead Paint

This recall involves the KHS America product called Monkey Glockenspiel.

The Green Tones 8-note Monkey Glockenspiel is a children's musical instrument with eight metal bars on a wooden base shaped like a monkey. The pink metal note bar on the glockenspiel may contain excessive levels of lead in the paint. Consumers should immediately remove the pink bar from the glockenspiel and contact KHS America for information on getting a free replacement pink bar.
