- SUBJECT: Far East Brokers Recalls Children's Chairs and Swings Due to Violation of Federal Lead Paint Standard

This recall involves the Leisure Ways pink butterfly themed children's camp chairs, moon chairs, and swings. Large red butterfly images and other colorful images are seen on the pink fabric. The screen-printing on the fabric of the chairs and swings contains excessive levels of lead, which is a violation of the federal lead paint standard. Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled chairs and swings and return them to the place of purchase for a full refund.

These products were sold at Weis Markets, wholesale distributors, grocery and drug stores nationwide from January 2016 through April 2016.
