SUBJECT: Mars Retail Group Recalls M&M'S-Branded Jewelry Due to Violation of Lead Standard

On August 25, 2016 the U.S. Food and Drug Administration issued a recall for M&M-branded jewelry. Recalled items include earrings, rings, bracelets and necklaces sold between May 2015 and July 2016. Jewelry items included in the recall have the M&M'S logo "M" as a charm or other feature.

Jewelry items were sold at M&M'S® World Stores in New York, NY; Orlando, FL; Las Vegas, NV; and Henderson, NV. Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled jewelry and contact M&M'S World or visit an M&M'S World store to return the jewelry for a full refund.
