Should my Child go to Child Care Today?

May attend child care if:

- © Child has a stuffy nose but no wheezing
- © Child has wheezing which goes away after taking medication
- © Child is able to perform usual activities (such as getting dressed or eating) without using extra effort to breathe





The child should not attend child care if:

- ® Wheezing or coughing continues after treatment
- © Child has trouble breathing or is breathing fast
- ⊗ Child has fever over 100 degrees
- © Child is too weak or tired to take part in normal activities (such as dressing self or eating)
