

Should my Child go to Child Care Today?

May attend child care if:

- ☺ Child has a stuffy nose but no wheezing
- ☺ Child has wheezing which goes away after taking medication
- ☺ Child is able to perform usual activities (such as getting dressed or eating) without using extra effort to breathe



The child should not attend child care if:

- ☹ Wheezing or coughing continues after treatment
- ☹ Child has trouble breathing or is breathing fast
- ☹ Child has fever over 100 degrees
- ☹ Child is too weak or tired to take part in normal activities (such as dressing self or eating)
