### **NEW HAVEN**

• Every Thursday in August 9:00am–3:00 pm: at the New Haven Health Department 54 Meadows Street – Immunization Coordinators will be at the educational table in the clinic available to discuss immunizations and assist with school readiness.

# **NORWALK**

- Month of August: Immunization information will be displayed in the Norwalk Health Department lobby near the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) office. The display will be changed each week to follow CDC's National themes of immunizations across the life span (adults, pregnant women, babies and young children, preteens and teens). Immunization schedules for children, teens and adults will be posted. CIRTS will be highlighted. CDC immunization schedule refrigerator magnets for babies and young children will be given out to WIC participants. - August 2<sup>nd</sup> 9:30am: CIRTS/Immunization Record Checks will be performed for children receiving support services from Family and Children's Agency (FCA). Families enrolled in Nurturing Families, Connections, Mom's Program, etc. are being asked to sign releases for their children's immunization records to be evaluated by Norwalk IAP and FCA staff. Children who are late with vaccinations or who do not have a provider identified will be followed up by FCA Program caseworkers. Parents will be offered enrollment if their child is not in CIRTS.

## **STAMFORD**

- Month of August: Stamford WIC office Immunization Coordinators will have an informational table with the CDC Immunization schedule for all ages along with informative handouts and brochures and info about CIRTS.
- Tuesdays in August: An educational table will be set up in the Stamford Well Child Clinics at 137 Henry Street, Stamford, promoting vaccination as a disease fighting tool; vaccines recommended in 2017 for each age group; diseases prevented through vaccination. Handouts for parents, bibs for babies and activity books for children will be offered.
- Wednesdays in August: In collaboration with the Optimus Clinic and Stamford WIC program, the IAP coordinator will
  be meeting with prenatal mothers at the Optimus Clinic on 1351 Washington Blvd, Stamford. In conjunction with the
  prenatal educational classes and early WIC enrollment screenings, the IAP coordinator will meet with the clients to
  introduce the CIRTS program and educate on the importance of immunizations for the health of their new babies.
