



# How do I navigate in CT WiZ?

## Things You Should Know

- You must have your own username and password to log into CT WiZ.
  - Go here to request an account:  
<https://ctwiz.dph.ct.gov/ctwiz/Login.aspx>. Click "Request New Account".
- Use a web browser to access CT WiZ. It works the best when you use:
  - Google Chrome

  - Mozilla Firefox
    - Download: <https://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/new/>
- You need Adobe Acrobat Reader to view CT WiZ reports.

	<b>Adverse Reaction</b>	Vaccination has an adverse reaction documented for patient.
	<b>Audit Information</b>	Hover over to display user who created the record, user who last updated the record, and dates and times of changes.
	<b>Calendar</b>	Click to display a pop-up calendar.
	<b>Clear</b>	Click to clear text from data entry field.
	<b>Current User</b>	Click to populate current user name into field.
	<b>Deceased</b>	Patient is deceased.
	<b>Deleted</b>	Patient record has been deleted from the registry.

# Important Icons in CT WiZ (continued)

	<p><b>Dose Not Administered</b></p>	<p>Vaccination has been added to patient's record, but has not been administered and remains in on-hand inventory.</p>
	<p><b>Historical Vaccination</b></p>	<p>Vaccination has been entered as a historical record and was not administered by a clinic in the registry.</p>
	<p><b>Immunization Reconciled</b></p>	<p>Dose is included on an inventory reconciliation that has been closed.</p>
	<p><b>Invalid Dose (Manual)</b></p>	<p>Vaccination has been manually invalidated by a user.</p>
	<p><b>Invalid Dose (Recommender)</b></p>	<p>Vaccination has been marked as invalid by the recommender.</p>
	<p><b>Lookup</b></p>	<p>Click to search for a patient record.</p>
	<p><b>Notes</b></p>	<p>Patient record includes notes.</p>

# Important Icons in CT WiZ (continued)

	<b>Online Help</b>	Click to view online help for the page.
	<b>Opted Out</b>	Patient has chosen not to participate in the IIS.
	<b>Outreach</b>	Patient belongs to a patient outreach.
	<b>Precautions / Contraindications</b>	Patient has one or more allergies or risks that may impact recommended immunizations.
	<b>Vaccination Comments</b>	Vaccination has comments.
	<b>Warning</b>	Appears with a warning or other informational message.

# What do the body site codes mean when giving vaccine?

Body Site Code	Body site
LA	Left Arm
LD	Left Deltoid
LG	Left Gluteus Medius
LVL	Left Vastus Lateralis
RA	Right Arm
RD	Right Deltoid
RG	Right Gluteus Medius
RVL	Right Vastus Lateralis
LLFA	Left Lower Forearm
LT	Left Thigh
RLFA	Right Lower Forearm
RT	Right Thigh
N	Nasal



# Tips and Shortcuts


- Fields with a **bold** label followed by a \* are required.
- Dates
  - Enter numbers only, slashes are automatically added.
  - Years must be entered in 4 digit form.
  - Double-click on a date field to enter today's date.
- Keyboard shortcuts
  - **Tab** - Go to the next data entry field
  - **Shift + Tab** - Go to the previous field
  - **Ctrl + C** - Copy text
  - **Ctrl + V** - Paste text
  - **Ctrl + X** - Cut text
