


# What are benefits of CT WiZ access?

CT WiZ captures vaccines for all ages!

- Pediatrics - order/report Connecticut Vaccine Program (CVP) supplied vaccines, all in one system.
- Adult - onboard to report doses administered.

All ages - by onboarding now, you'll be ready to order/report COVID-19 vaccine once available.



# What are benefits of CT WiZ access? cnt'd

- Access consolidated immunization records
- View vaccine forecasting due/overdue
- View/print official immunization records
- Generate reports i.e. reminder/recall, immunization coverage rates



# How is CT WiZ preparing for COVID-19?

1

## **ONBOARD** IMMUNIZING PARTNERS

Onboarding all traditional and non-traditional vaccine providers now will save programs valuable time later.

2

## ALIGN WITH **STANDARDS**

Ensuring your IIS aligns with standards facilitates connections with data-sharing partners, such as electronic health records (EHR) systems.

3

## ELIMINATE **DATA EXCHANGE** LIMITATIONS

Changes to local laws or policies may be necessary to ensure timely and complete exchange of data to support routine and pandemic vaccination efforts.

4

## EXPAND **CONSUMER ACCESS**

Providing consumers with access to immunization records and forecasting empowers patients to better manage their healthcare and decreases the record request burden on IIS programs and providers.


