VAMS Enhancement	How the enhancement will assist VAMS users	How does the enhancement work
Recipients – QR Codes are available to display vaccination certificates.	Supports recipient’s access to their vaccination records.	<p>Recipients will click to view their vaccine certificate in VAMS. Then, they will click “generate QR code” and will be prompted to create a PIN for their vaccine certificate. When scanned by an external user, the QR code will generate a link to an external site. The page will prompt the user to enter the VAMS vaccine certificate PIN. Once the PIN is entered the following vaccination details will display:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recipient name • Date of birth • Date administered • Product • Manufacturer • Lot Number • Clinic
Clinic Capacity Report displays the total number of appointments booked for Additional Dose.	Supports access to additional dose data from clinic reports.	The Clinic Capacity Report will now display a new column titled Additional Dose Appointment Booked .
Clinic Administrators and Inventory Managers are able to log Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine inventory for Unit of Sale (UoS) National Drug Codes (NDCs) ending in 02 and 03.	Supports clinic inventory reporting.
