

## VAMS Enhancements for Clinic Users

VAMS Release 5.3 – Enhancements were made to VAMS on 08/27/2021

VAMS Enhancement	How the enhancement will assist VAMS users	How does the enhancement work
<b>Recipients</b> – QR Codes are available to display vaccination certificates.	<b>Supports recipient's access to their vaccination records.</b>	Recipients will click to view their vaccine certificate in VAMS. Then, they will click “generate QR code” and will be prompted to create a PIN for their vaccine certificate. When scanned by an external user, the <b>QR code</b> will generate a link to an external site. The page will prompt the user to enter the VAMS vaccine certificate <b>PIN</b> . Once the <b>PIN</b> is entered the following vaccination details will display: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recipient name</li> <li>• Date of birth</li> <li>• Date administered</li> <li>• Product</li> <li>• Manufacturer</li> <li>• Lot Number</li> <li>• Clinic</li> </ul>
Clinic Capacity Report displays the total number of appointments booked for Additional Dose.	<b>Supports access to additional dose data from clinic reports.</b>	The <b>Clinic Capacity Report</b> will now display a new column titled <b>Additional Dose Appointment Booked</b> .
Clinic Administrators and Inventory Managers are able to log Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine inventory for Unit of Sale (UoS) National Drug Codes (NDCs) ending in 02 and 03.	<b>Supports clinic inventory reporting.</b>
