

### **OK** display



Reading the display during measurement

The following information is visible on screen:

- temperatures are **OK**
- Current date: 06. 19.20 IS
- Current time in military format: 13:47
- Current temperature: +5.6°C

#### **ALARM** display




If an alarm occurs the following additional symbols appear on screen:

- ALARM symbols, temperature alert
- = Max higher (HI) temperature ALARM
- = MIN lower (LO) temperature ALARM
- = ALARM sensor disconnected for +15 minutes

The arrow appears under today and / or the day an **ALARM occurs** 

## Read history (record daily checks (2x) in memory and clear an X if alarmed)


### **Recording daily checks**



Press the READ button 3 times to record your check

- 1st press: see UP arrow blink = HI temp. so far today
- 2nd press: see DOWN arrow blink = LO temp. so far ▼
- 3rd press: records in memory the time of your manual check
  - A **Fridge-tag**® **2** records an AM or PM for morning or afternoon checks
  - A Fridge-tag® 2 L records the actual time it is checked in the morning and in the afternoon.


### Clearing the X / **Example of a LO ALARM**

 There will be an UP ▲ or DOWN ▼ arrow under today in the upper right of the screen indicating a HI or


If both arrows are present then it is typically an ALARM for the external sensor being disconnected for more than 15 minutes. Double arrows need 5 presses of READ to clear the X.



1st press: see UP arrow blink = HI temp. so far today 2nd press: see DOWN Arrow blink = date & time of the

3rd press: see DOWN arrow blink & dur = duration of ALARM and the lowest temperature during that alarm 4th press: clears the X and records in memory

### **Downloading the report**




Download the report from the Fridge-tag® device by connecting it to any PC / MAC.

- Fridge-tag<sup>®</sup> 2 = 60 day report
- Fridge-tag<sup>®</sup> 2 L = 56 day report (with 8 weekly graphs)



Click on the Fridge-tag file to open it



Double click on the PDF file to open the report. **Note:** store reports for 3 years to be VFC compliant
