Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Stephen McCarthy:

- 1. Stephen McCarthy of North Haven, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut barber license 004501.
- On or about September 29, 2021, the respondent was found guilty of a felony, Manslaughter, 1st Degree, in violation of Connecticut General Statutes section 53a-55(a)(1)
- 3. The above-described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the Connecticut General Statutes §19a-17.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Examining Board for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians, as authorized in §19a-11, §19a-17, and §20-238 revoke or order other disciplinary action against the barbering license of Stephen McCarthy as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.

Stephen McCarthy, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

- 1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
- 2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
- 3. I am licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice as a barber. I presently hold license number 004501.
- 4. I hereby voluntarily surrender my license to practice as a barber in the State of Connecticut as provided pursuant to Section 19a-17(d) of the General Statutes.
- 5. I agree and acknowledge that if I seek a new license or to reinstate my license at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 2022-14 shall be deemed true. I further agree and acknowledge that any such application must be made to the Department which shall have discretion as to whether said license shall be issued or reinstated and, if so, whether said license shall be subject to conditions as provided pursuant to Section 19a-14(a)(6) of the General Statutes.
- 6. I hereby waive any right to a hearing I may have regarding any request that my license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that I may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
- 7. I agree and acknowledge that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 2022-14 are public documents, and I am executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
- 8. I agree and acknowledge that, upon execution of this document by the Department, the Department will present this document to the Board and will move to withdraw the Statement of Charges in Petition No. 2022-14. I understand that this document is not effective unless and until the Department has executed it, and the Board either grants the Department's Motion to Withdraw or the charges are dismissed.
- 9. I agree and acknowledge that I have the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.

- 10. I agree and acknowledge that the execution of this document has no bearing on any criminal liability without the written consent of the Director of the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit or the Bureau Chief of the Division of Criminal Justice's Statewide Prosecution Bureau.
- I agree and acknowledge that the purpose of this agreement is to resolve the pending matter 11. against my license and is not intended to affect any claim of civil liability that might be brought against me.
- 12. If applicable, I agree to comply with the provision of Section 19a-14-44 Regulations Connecticut State Agencies.
