V. NEW BUSINESS

A. Ayyaz Ali, MD – Review of License Application

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Rissi, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a five year probation.
