The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

I. MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting of June 13, 2016. Dr. Campagna moved, and Ms. Serrano seconded, that the minutes be approved. The motion passed.

II. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATES

Investigations Update

Gary Griffin, Investigations Supervisor reported that seven new cases have been opened since he last meeting. There are thirteen cases currently being investigated by the Department.

III. OLD BUSINESS

The Board discussed Public Act 16-66 which provides services by a psychology technician. It was noted at the June meeting that the language of the public act does not incorporate several elements proposed by the Connecticut Psychological Association (CPA).

Traci Cipriano, JD, PhD and Tim Belliveau, PhD were present on behalf of the CPA. Christian Andresen and Stephen Carragher were present for the Department of Public Health.

It was discussed that Requirements for on-site direct supervision; a supervision ratio of 3:1 (technicians per licensed psychologist); and a requirement for the supervising psychologist to maintain documentation of training was not include the public act language.

Mr. Andresen commented that the DPH will look into making a change to the statute in the next legislative session.

IV. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 9:16 a.m. on a motion by Dr. Horn, seconded by Dr. Campagna.
