STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Ronald Maier, D.V.M.:

1. Ronald Maier, D.V.M. of Waterbury, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut veterinary license number 000797.
2. Respondent provided care to Patient #1 at one or about February 7, 2022. During the course of his care for Patient #1, respondent conducted limited examinations and provided therapeutic injections.
3. Respondent's care for Patient #1 failed to meet the standard of care in one or more of the following ways:
 - a. His records were incomplete and/or inadequate;
 - b. He did not perform and/or document performing a complete physical examination;
 - c. He failed to perform and/or document performing adequate diagnostic testing;
 - d. He failed to make sufficient effort to stabilize Patient #1's condition;
 - e. He failed to refer and/or document referring Patient #1 to a higher level of care; and/or
 - f. He improperly provided Patient #1 with unsupported veterinary treatment.
4. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-202, including an not limited to, §20-202(2).

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut State Board of Veterinary Medicine, as authorized in §§19a-17 and §20-202, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the veterinary license of Ronald Maier as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
