PDF pgs 38-183 addresses c) and d) by providing descriptions of health issues and disparities, as well as factors that contribute to our state challenges. Descriptions are highlighted periodically within these pages for your reference and as an example. PDF pgs 172-183 focuses on specific population groups. PDF pgs 244-246 provides a list of State Assets & Resources developed through key informant interviews in 2013 and at a Coalition meeting in March 2014. See cover sheet.
RD2 Ex 1	SHA Community Forums		This document includes 1) a press release advertising public forums held in each of 8 counties in Connecticut, 2) an example of the Agenda from one of the Forums held in Windham County, and 3) the presentation of health status data. The purpose of the forums was to present preliminary findings from the State Health Assessment, receive feedback on health status data presented, and to engage communities in a discussion of the health issues most important to them.
RD2 Ex 2	SHA Webinar in Spanish		This document includes the announcement of the SHA's Spanish-language webinar and the data and information presented on the webinar. The webinar follows the format and presentation of the Community Forums. The webinar was held to discuss health status issues with the Latino community who comprise 13.4% of Connecticut's population and are the largest minority population in the state.
RD3 Ex1	MCH Block Grant Focus Groups		In developing health promotion strategies for the MCH Block (MCHBG), DPH conducted focus groups with specific populations affected by or in need of services and in geographic areas of the state where health inequities exist. The public input process and its relationship to the State Health Assessment and State Health Improvement Plan is on PDF pg 8. A summary of input is on PDF pg 5 that includes identification of assets specific to the population in need of health services. Summary charts are on PDF pages 11, 12, and 13; and a consumer reviewer's input on pg15-16 that provides additional information and assets to inform health assessment and improvement. Maternal, Infant and Child Health is a focus area under the State Health Assessment and Health Improvement Plan (SHIP). The State Coalition to Improve Birth Outcomes noted on PDF pg8 is also the group implementing SHIP objectives in this focus

			area.
RD3 Ex 2	CT HIV Planning Consortium		The SHA includes a section on HIV/HIV disparities and this document shows the ongoing gathering of information and data, community dialogue and identification of community assets to address HIV through the CT HIV Planning Consortium (2015). PDF pgs1-9 is meeting summary of the Consortium. Highlighted and annotated areas address community dialogue and identification of assets. PDF pgs10-15 is a meeting summary of the Consortium's Data and Assessment Committee. Highlighted and annotated areas identify dialogue on additional assessment data/information. PDF pgs16-32 is the disparities data presented at the meeting for review/comment. PDF pg33-82 is the Consortium's update to the Statewide HIV Prevention and Care Plan for CT. PDF pg75 identifies Consortium members and affiliations which is not present on the meeting summaries. Twelve Consortium members are persons living with HIV.
