## How Do I Request A 'No Record of Marriage' Statement

If you are planning to marry outside of the U.S.A., the foreign jurisdiction may require you to provide an 'Affidavit of Eligibility to Marry.' You may execute such an affidavit at a U.S. embassy or consulate. If you are a Connecticut resident, you may also request a 'No Record of Marriage Statement' from the State Vital Records Office. Complete the Application to Request a 'No Record of Marriage Statement' and mail it or submit it in person to the State Vital Records Office. You must also provide a valid Connecticut Driver's License or Connecticut Non-Driver ID card with your request, along with a \$20 fee.

Checklist for Obtaining a No Record of Marriage Statement:

- Application
- Copy of ID (can be Social Security card if desired)
- Include the applicable fee
