If you are a SNAP recipient in Connecticut you must report

- When your household's total monthly gross income exceeds 130% of the federal poverty level (FPL), and
- If you or a member of your household is subject to time-limited SNAP and work fewer than 80 hours in a month, and
- When a household member receives lottery or gambling winnings in excess of **\$4,250**

130% of FPL depends on the number of people in your household

If your household size is	Report if your income is over
1	\$1,473
2	\$1,984
3	\$2,495
4	\$3,007
5	\$3,518
6	\$4,029
7	\$4,541
8	\$5,052

Effective Date
October 1, 2022

Each additional household member **+\$512**

Gross income is the amount *before* any deduction.

Total household income includes all earned and unearned income of each household member.

WHEN?

You must report these changes by the 10th day of the month following the change in your household's circumstances.
