

# IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT



*If you are a SNAP recipient in Connecticut you must report*

- When your household's total monthly gross income exceeds 130% of the federal poverty level (FPL), and
- If you or a member of your household is subject to time-limited SNAP and work fewer than 80 hours in a month, and
- When a household member receives lottery or gambling winnings in excess of **\$3,750**

130% of FPL depends on the number of people in your household

Each additional household member **\$+699**

Gross income is the amount *before* any deduction.

Total household income includes all earned and unearned income of each household member.

## WHEN?

You must report these changes by the 10th day of the month following the change in your household's circumstances.
