The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on October 8, 2019 at 9:30 AM, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared.

Shortly before the hearing was convened, the parties informed the undersigned hearing officer that they had reached an agreement settling the complaint. Specifically, the parties agreed on the record as follows:

1. The respondents represented that they conducted an initial search for the emails requested by the complainant and such search resulted in four responsive records, which were provided to the complainant;
2. Subsequently, the respondents realized that not all of the responsive emails had properly loaded on the server and that therefore their initial search had not captured all responsive records;
3. Thereafter, the respondents conducted two additional searches for the requested emails—one from the complainant's former email address and the other from the email address of Ted Janiszewski, the respondent's Principal Human Resources Specialist;
4. On October 8, 2019, the respondents disclosed 116 responsive records to the complainant;
5. The respondents represented that they are confident that all responsive records have now been disclosed to the complainant;

6. The respondents agreed to provide the complainant with an affidavit by October 15, 2019; such affidavit will detail the steps that the respondents took to capture and disclose the 116 responsive records referenced in paragraph 5, above,
7. Based on such agreement, the complainant agreed to withdraw his complaint.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the parties' settlement, the case is hereby dismissed.
